

1/8 yard - 42853-5 Grey

1/4 yard – 42852-1 Black

⅓ yard – 42853-3 Red

3/4 yard - 35370S-1 Optic White

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A: Clapboards – Grey

- Cut two 4 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
- Cut two 4 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-two 2" squares.

Fabric B: Dashes - Red

- Cut two 1 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips.
- Cut two 1 ½" x 32 ½" WOF strips.
- Cut one 2" x WOF strip.
- Cut five 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric C: Lines – Black

- Cut one 2" x WOF strip.
- See instructions to cut one tripod center leg.
- See instructions to cut one tripod right leg and one tripod left leg.

Fabric D: Cameras – Black

- Cut one 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 ½" squares.
- Cut one 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 ½" x 9 ½" strips.
- Press a 5" x 9 ½" strip of fusible web onto the wrong side of a 5" x 9 ½" Fabric D strip. Cut (1) 4" x 8 ½" strip from the segment with fusible web.

Fabric E: Dashes – Black

• See instructions to cut one camera lens.

Fabric F: Dashes – White

• Press a 2 ½" x 5" strip of fusible web on the wrong side of a 2 ½' x 5" Fabric D strip. Cut (1) 1 ¼" x 4" strip from the segment with fusible web.

Fabric G: Film – Grey

• See instructions to cut two inner reels.

Fabric H: Words – Black

• See instructions to cut two outer reels.

Fabric I: Film - Red

- Cut two 2 ½" x 28" WOF strips.
- Cut two 2 ½" x 22" WOF strips.

Fabric J: Optic White

- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-two 2" x 3 ½" strips.
- Cut one 14 ½" x 20 ½" strip.

Back- Cameras – White

• Cut two 48" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 48" x 54" for the pieced back.

Block Assembly:

- 1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 3. Refer to Figure 1 to arrange and press the camera components onto the 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip.
- 4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the camera block.
- 5. Center one 2 ½" x 28" Fabric I strip on one side of the camera block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¼" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- 6. Repeat Step 5 to sew one 2 ½" x 22" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the camera block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 2).
- 7. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 2), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the Center Block (Fig. 3).



- 8. Sew one 2" x WOF Fabric C strip and one 2" x WOF Fabric B strip together lengthwise to make one CB strip set (Fig. 4).
- 9. Cut the CB strip set into sixteen 2" x 3 1/2" CB strips (Fig. 5).
- 10. Sew two CB strips together lengthwise to make one Unit 1 block (Fig. 6). Repeat to make eight Unit 1 blocks total.
- 11. Sew one 2" x 3 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of one Unit 1 block. Sew one 2" Fabric A square to each end of one 2" x 3 ½" Fabric J strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make one Block One (Fig. 7). Repeat to make eight Block Ones total.




Quilt Assembly - Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top:

- 12. Sew one 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of one Block One. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew one strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 13. Sew three Block Ones and two 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D squares together, alternating them. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 14. Sew one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 15. Sew one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

- 16. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 17. Sew the five 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
- 18. Bind as desired.


