

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Piecing Instructions:


Note: All seam allowances are 1/4"

BLOCK 1:


- 1. Sew (1) **E** 5-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to the top of (1) **F** 5-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to create **EF Unit**. Square to 5-1/2" X 12-1/2", make (7).
- 2. Sew (1) I 2" X 12-1/2" strip to each side of **EF Unit**, then sew (1) I 2" X 8-1/2" strip to top and bottom to complete **BLOCK 1**. Square to 8-1/2" X 15-1/2", make (7).

BLOCK 2:

- 3. Sew (1) **G** 5-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to the top of (1) **D** 5-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to create **GD Unit**. Square to 5-1/2" X 12-1/2", make (7).
- 4. Sew (1) I 2" X 12-1/2" strip to each side of **GD Unit**, then sew (1) I 2" X 8-1/2" strip to top and bottom to complete **BLOCK 2**. Square to 8-1/2" X 15-1/2", make (7).









Assembly Instructions: (Refer to cover image for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

Quilt Assembly:

5. Sew the following together into horizontal rows, then sew rows together.

Row 1: BLOCK 1 – B1 rectangle – BLOCK 2 – C1 rectangle – BLOCK 1 – B1 rectangle – BLOCK 2

Row 2: C2 rectangle - BLOCK 1 - B2 rectangle - BLOCK 2 - C2 rectangle - BLOCK 1 - B2 rectangle

Row 3: BLOCK 2 - C1 rectangle - BLOCK 1 - B1 rectangle - BLOCK 2 - C1 rectangle - BLOCK 1

Row 4: B2 rectangle – BLOCK 2 – C2 rectangle – BLOCK 1 – B2 rectangle – BLOCK 2 – C2 rectangle

Border Assembly:

Border #1

6. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 60-1/2"), cut (2) **H** 2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 47-1/2") cut (2) **H** 2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.



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Border #2:

7. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 63-1/2"), cut (2) **A** 5-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 57-1/2") cut (2) **A** 5-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border #3:

8. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 73-1/2"), cut (2) I 2-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 61-1/2") cut (2) I 2-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
