| A |  | 52025P-X Multi | (2) Panels | Center design and fussy cut: <br> (2) Panel Piece 1; 20-1/2" squares. <br> (2) Panel Piece 2; 14-1/2" $\times 20-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. |
| B |  | 52026-1 White | 1/4 | (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut (20) 2-1/2" squares. |
| C |  | 52026-2 Fuchsia | 3/4 | (9) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Set aside (7) strips for binding. From remaining strips, subcut (20) 2-1/2" squares. |
| D |  | 52027-1 White | 1-1/2 | (3) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut (44) 2-1/2" squares and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square. <br> (12) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew strips end-to-end using diagonal seams. Subcut (2) 3-1/2" $\times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Border 2 and (2) 3-1/2" $\times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Border 4. |
| E |  | 52027-3 Pink | 5/8 | (3) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut (22) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ 4-1/2" rectangles. <br> (6) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew strips end-to-end using diagonal seams. Subcut (2) 1-1/2" $\times 50-$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) 1-1/2" $\times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Border 3. |
| F |  | 52028-1 White | 1/4 | (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip; subcut (20) 2-1/2" squares. |
| G |  | 52028-2 Fuchsia | 1/4 | (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip; subcut (20) 2-1/2" squares. |
| H |  | 52028-4 Pale Pink | 1/4 | (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip; subcut (20) 2-1/2" squares. |
|  |  | Backing | 4 | Batting: 68" $\times 68{ }^{\prime \prime}$ |

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Place fabric right sides together and use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout pattern.

## FLYING GEESE UNITS

1. Place (1) D $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ marked square onto the end of (1) E $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, as shown. Stitch together on drawn line. Trim corner leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance; press seam toward $\mathbf{D}$. Repeat on the other end of the rectangle. Press toward E to make a Flying Geese Unit. Make (22).


Please Note: Refer to Quilt Assembly, Page 4, for pressing arrows for Steps 2-9.
2. Sew (11) Flying Geese Units together along short ends into a strip measuring 2-1/2" $\times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make (2).


## SASHING STRIPS

3. Using (2) EACH, B, C, F, G, and $\mathbf{H} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, sew together in the order shown to make a Sashing Strip-Left measuring 2-1/2" $\times 20-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make (1). Paying attention to square placement, repeat to make a Sashing Strip-Right. Make (1).


## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Refer to Quilt Assembly on Page 4. Note arrows for pressing.
4. Quilt Center: Using the (2) Sashing Strips from Step 3 and the (2) EACH, A, Panel Pieces 1 \& 2, sew into (2) vertical rows and press as shown. Sew rows together to make quilt center.
5. Border 1: Sew (18) assorted B, C, F, G, and H 2-1/2" squares into a strip measuring 2-1/2" $\times 36$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make (2), as shown. Sew pieced strips to sides of quilt center. Repeat using (22) assorted B, C, F, G, and H 2-1/2" squares and sew into a strip measuring 2-1/2" $\times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make (2), as shown. Sew strips to the top and bottom edges of quilt center.

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6. Using the (2) Flying Geese strips made in Step 2, sew (1) EACH to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center, as shown.
7. Border 2: Sew (2) D 3-1/2" $\times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the sides of the quilt top and sew (2) D $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the top and bottom edges of the quilt top.
8. Border 3: Sew (2) E 1-1/2" $\times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the sides of the quilt top and sew (2) $\mathbf{E} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ $\times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the top and bottom edges of the quilt top.
9. Border 4: Sew (2) D $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the sides of the quilt top and sew (2) $\mathbf{D}$ $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the top and bottom edges to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using C 2-1/2" strips.
