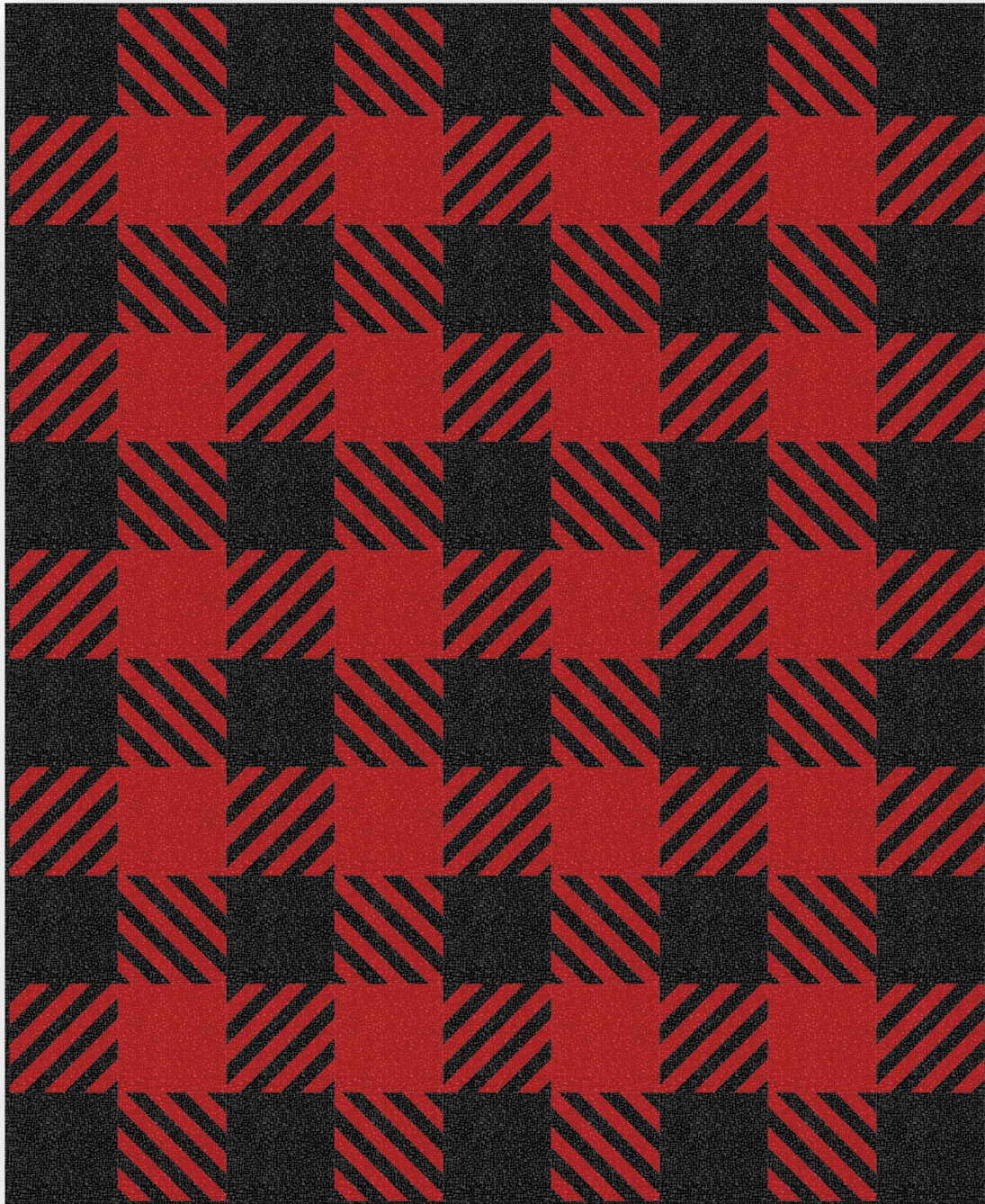

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KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A		50087-5 True Red	2-5/8 YD	(4) 6-1/2" X 42" strips, subcut (20) 6-1/2" squares (50) 1-1/4" X 42" strips
B		50087-37 Peppercorn	3-1/4 YD	(5) 6-1/2" X 42" strips, subcut (30) 6-1/2" squares (50) 1-1/4" X 42" strips (7) 2-1/4" X 42" strips * BINDING

Backing Fabric: 4 YD (42" wide)

Batting: 62" X 74"

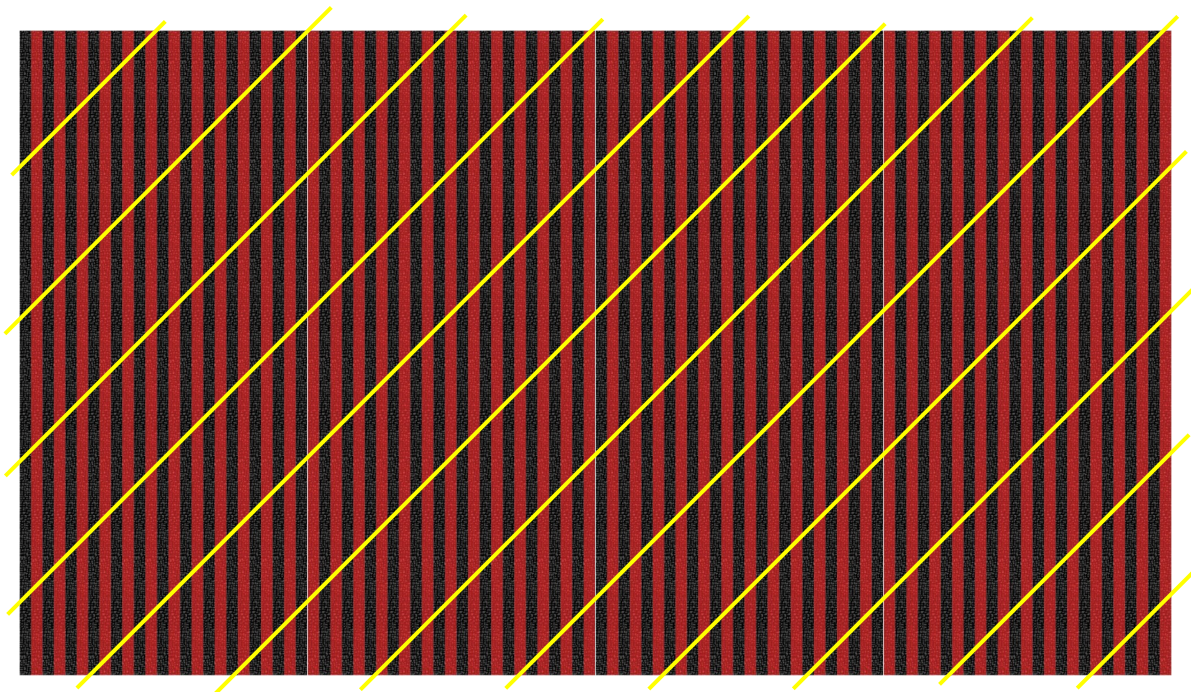
### General Instructions:

- A. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- C. Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric unless otherwise noted.
- D. We recommend using spray starch or sizing on all fabrics before cutting to reduce bias stretch.

### Piecing Instructions:

#### Make AB Blocks:

1. Sew the A and B 1-1/4" X 42" strips together in an alternating pattern to create a 42" X 75-1/2" rectangle.
2. Make 6-1/2" 45 degree diagonal cuts in one direction, then cut strips into 6-1/2" AB Blocks. You need 49 for quilt, save remainder for another project.

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Assembly Instructions: (Refer to quilt diagram for proper block placement and rotation)

Quilt Assembly:

- Sew squares and blocks into rows, then sew rows together.  
 Rows 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11: B - AB - B - AB - B - AB - B - AB - B  
 Row 2, 4, 6, 8, and 10: AB - A - AB - A - AB - A - AB - A - AB

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. ~~~ Note: You may want to staystitch 1/8" from the edge around the perimeter of the quilt top to stabilize bias edges before quilting. ~~~ Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
