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## HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST)

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (7) G 3-7/8" squares from lower left to upper right, noting stripe orientation. Place $\mathbf{G}$ square, right sides together, on (1) J 3-7/8" square. Sew 1/4" away from drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) HST units. Make (14) of G/J 1.

2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (9) G $3-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares from upper left to lower right, noting stripe orientation. In the same way, make (18) G/J 2 HST units, measuring 3-1/2" square.

3. Using J squares, repeat to make a total of the following HSTs:

Note: a few will not be used.


## Quilt Center Section 1

NOTE ROTATION AND PLACEMENT OF UNITS.
4. Arrange and sew together (9) HST units to make a pieced row. Make a total of (5) pieced rows and sew rows together, as shown.


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5. Arrange and sew together (8) HST units and (1) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to make a pieced row. Make (5) pieced rows and sew rows together, as shown.
(8) HST UNITS

6. Quilt Center Stars 1 \& 2: Sew (2) J HSTs to the left and bottom of (1) F/J HST unit, and add the sewn unit to (1) E HST piece, noting stripe orientation, for the quilt center star. Make (4) of each as shown.

7. Arrange and sew together (6) HST units and (1) J 3-1/2" square to make a pieced row. Make (2) pieced rows, join, and add to the left of the Quilt Center Star 1 unit.


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8. Sew all the units made in Steps 4,5 and 7 to complete Section 1.
9. Similar to Section 1, construct the remaining Sections as shown.


Section 2

(5) HST units


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10. Sew Sections 3 and 4 to the left and right sides of (1) A 12-1/2" square.


QUILT ASSEMBLY (see page 6)
11. Sew Sections 1 and 2 together, and add to the top of unit made in Step 10.
12. Sew Sections 5 and 6 together, and add to the bottom of Step 11 to complete quilt center.

## BORDERS

13. Inner Border: Sew (2) J 3-1/2" $\times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $\mathbf{J} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
14. Outer Border: Sew (2) G $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 66-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) G $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 59-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

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Quilt Assembly


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using I 2-1/4" strips.
