
### SMALL TREE BLOCKS

#### FLYING GEESE UNITS

- Unit 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 2-1/2" square. Place square right sides together, at a corner of (1) C 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press. Repeat for opposite corner as shown.
- 2. Sew (1) A 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle to short sides of A/C Flying Geese unit to make Unit 1.

Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" and open to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat on opposite corner.




- Unit 2: Repeat step 1 (Flying Geese) using (2) A 2-1/2" squares and (1) C 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle. Add (1) A 1" x 2-1/2" to short sides to complete Unit 2.
- 4. Unit 3: Sew (2) A 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) I 1-1/2" square.






- Sew Units 1-3 together, as shown, then add (1) A 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the top of sewn unit, trim to 6-1/2" x 8-1/2". Make (5) A/C Small Tree Blocks.
- 6. Repeat Steps 1-5 to make following A/D and A/H Small Tree Blocks:






#### **BIG TREE BLOCKS**

- 7. Similar to Small Tree Block assembly make A/F and A/G Big Tree Blocks.
- Unit 1: Use (2) A 2-1/2" squares and (1) G 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to make a flying geese unit. Then add (2) A 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles to the short sides to complete Unit 1.
- Unit 2: Use (2) A 2-1/2" squares and (1) G 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle to make a flying geese unit. Then add (2) A 1" x 2-1/2" rectangles to the short sides to complete Unit 2. Make (2).
- Unit 3: Use (2) A 2-1/2" x 3" rectangles and (1) I 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle.





- Sew Units 1-3 together, as shown to complete A/G Big Tree Block, trim to 6-1/2" x 8-1/2". Make (8).
- Repeat Steps 7 and 8 to make
   (8) A/F Big Tree Block.



#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY** Refer to Quilt Diagram on page 5 for following steps.

**10. INNER BORDER #1:** Sew (1) **J**  $2'' \times 39-1/2''$  strip to long sides of **B**  $33-1/2'' \times 39-1/2''$  rectangle, followed by (1) **J**  $2'' \times 36-1/2''$  strip to top and bottom of quilt center.

**11. SIDE PINE TREE BORDERS:** Arrange and sew together (7) Tree Blocks as shown. Make (2) border units. *Note proper placement of blocks.* Sew border units to long sides of quilt center. *Note proper rotation and placement of borders units.* 

12. TOP/BOTTOM PINE TREE BORDERS: Arrange and sew together (6) Tree Blocks and (2)
A 8-1/2" squares as shown. Make (2) border units. Note proper placement of blocks. Sew border units to top and bottom of quilt center. Note proper rotation and placement of border units.

**13. INNER BORDER #2:** Sew (1) **A**  $1-1/2'' \times 58-1/2''$  strip to long sides of quilt center, followed by (1) **A**  $1-1/2'' \times 54-1/2''$  strip to top and bottom of quilt center.

**14. INNER BORDER #3:** Sew (1) **J**  $1-1/2'' \ge 60-1/2''$  strip to long sides of quilt center, followed by (1) **J**  $1-1/2'' \ge 56-1/2''$  strip to top and bottom of quilt center.

**15. OUTER BORDER:** Sew (1) **E** 5-1/2" x 62-1/2" strip to long sides of quilt center, followed by (1) **E** 5-1/2" x 66-1/2" strip to top and bottom to complete quilt top.

**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **J** 2-1/4" strips.
