

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
General Instructions:

- A. All seam allowances are ¼" unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- C. Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric.

<u>Piecing Instructions:</u> (Refer to block images below for proper placement)


Center Block: Square to 16-1/2", make (1)

1. Draw diagonal lines on backs of (4) P 4-1/2" squares. Place (1) P square right sides together on the top left corner of (1) A 16-1/2" square and sew on diagonal line. Press, then trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on remaining 3 corners to complete Center Block.



Half Square Triangle (HST) Blocks: Square to 4-1/2", make (2) of each

- 2. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) B 5" square. Place B square right sides together with (1) P 5" square and sew 1/4" on either side of the diagonal line. Cut on drawn line, then press the (2) HST blocks open.
- 3. Repeat step 2 to create all HSTs needed for quilt.



Quilt Assembly Instructions: (Refer to diagram for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

4. Sew pairs of HSTs into rows, then sew rows together to create side border units. Sew side border units to Center Block.

Left Side Border Unit: GP - GK, DP - DQ, LP - LQ, JP - FJ Right Side Border Unit: FJ - JP, LQ - LP, DQ - DP, GK - GP

5. Sew rows of QSTs and HSTs into rows, then sew rows together to create top/bottom border units. Sew top/bottom border units to Center Block.

Top Border Unit Row 1: P QST - BP - MP - HP - EP - P QST

Top Border Unit Row 2: P QST - KN - BN - MQ - HQ - CE - CF - P QST

Bottom Border Unit Row 3: P QST - CF - CE - HQ - MQ - BN - KN - P QST

Bottom Border Unit Row 4: P QST - EP - HP - MP - BP - P QST

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 6" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
