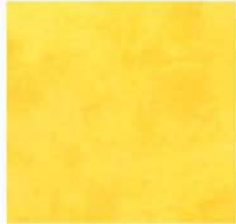

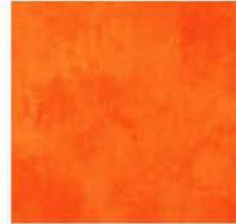

Finishes at: 64" wide X 96" long

Materials requirements:

Various Prints: 3/4 yard of each of 8 prints for blocks

Solid or near solid: 3 3/4 yards for blocks (*models shows 37098-14 Duckling; 37098-24 Pink, 37098-31 Caribbean, and white*)

Additional print fabric(s): 5 1/2 yards for pieced backing

Additional fabric: 1 yard for bias binding

Batting: 72" X 104"

Cutting instructions:

1. From each print fabric, cut (6) 8 1/2" squares (48 print squares total). Trace the Blocks A and B template onto *one* corner of each square and cut along traced lines to form (48) Block A units.

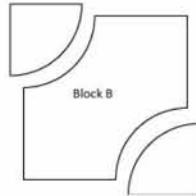


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2. From each print fabric, cut (12) 4 1/2" squares (96 squares total). Trace the Wedge template onto each square and cut along traced lines to form (96) print Wedge units.

3. From the solid fabric, cut (48) 8 1/2" squares. Trace the Blocks A and B template onto *two opposing* corners of each square and cut along traced lines to form (48) white Block B units.



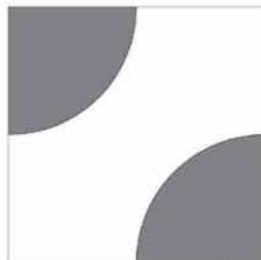
4. From the solid fabric, cut (48) 4 1/2" squares. Trace the Wedge template onto each square and cut along traced lines to form (48) white Wedge units.

Piece Blocks A and B:

5. Match each Block A unit (print fabric) with a solid Wedge unit; align curved raw edges and pin together with right sides together. Stitch along curved edges using a 1/4" seam allowance to make (48) A Blocks. If needed, trim each block to measure 8 1/2" square. (*Diagram 1*)



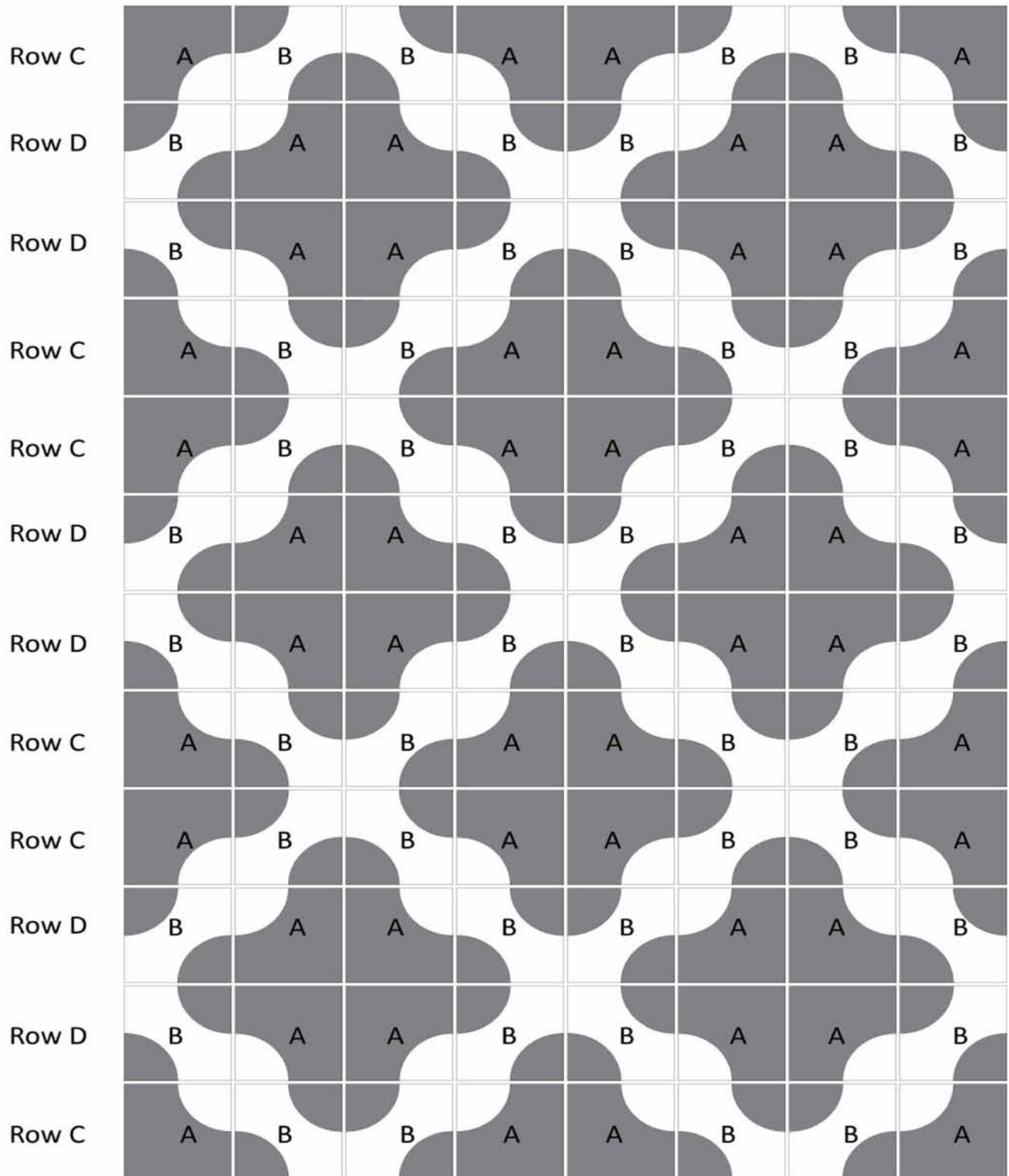
6. Match each Block B unit (solid fabric) with (2) print Wedge units (for a scrappy look, vary the prints within each block). Align curved raw edges and pin together with right sides together. Stitch along curved edges using a 1/4" seam allowance to make (48) B Blocks. If needed, trim each block to measure 8 1/2" square. (*Diagram 2*)



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10. Lay out the Rows as follows and stitch together: C-D-D-C-C-D-D-C-C-D-D-C



11. Layer, baste, and quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.

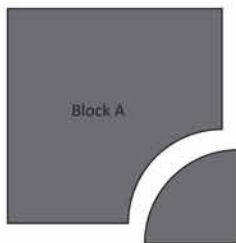
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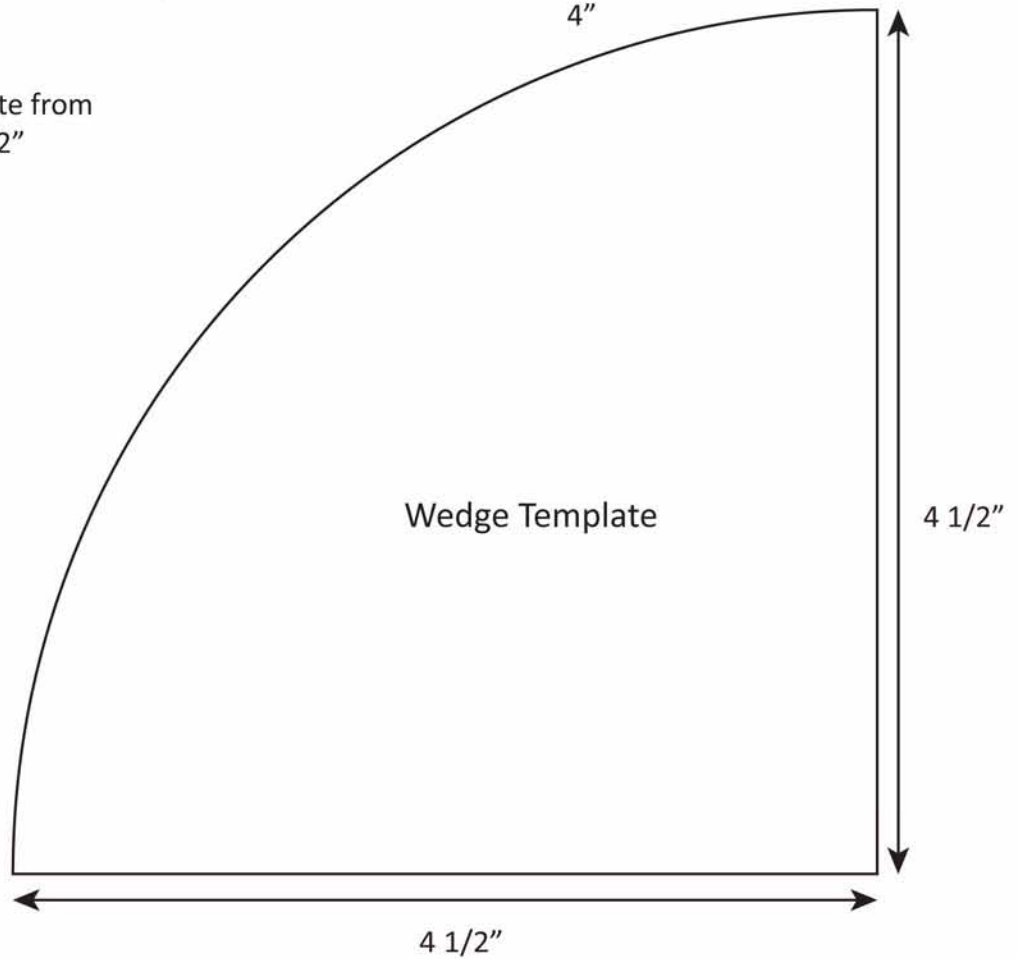
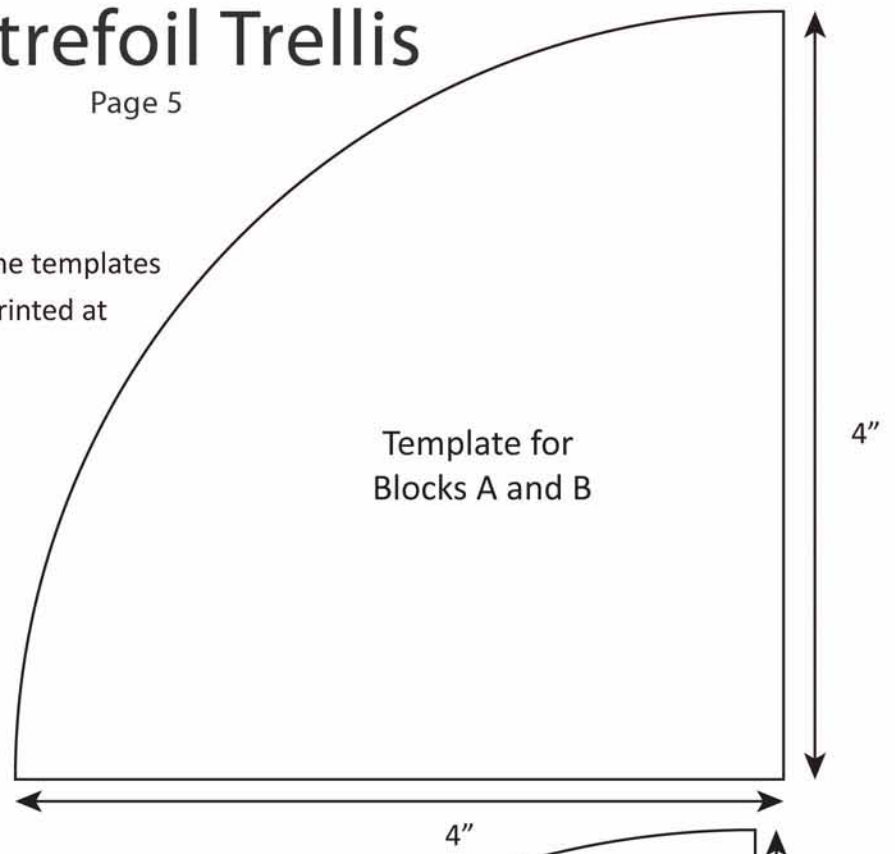
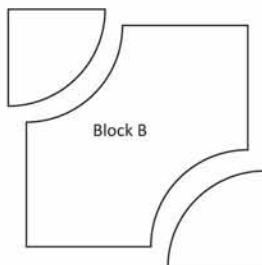
Templates:

Note: double check the measurements on the templates when you print them to ensure they have printed at the correct size.

To make Block A, cut out template from *one* corner of an 8 1/2" square.



To make Block B, cut out template from *two* opposing corners of an 8 1/2" square.



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
