| D      |        | 43122-2<br>Brown | 2/3 YD   | (1) 5-1/4" X 42" strip, subcut (7) 5-1/4" squares, crosscut twice to create (28) QST D1<br>(2) 5" X 42" strips, subcut (14) 5" squares, crosscut once to create (28) HST D2<br>(1) 6-1/2" X 42" strip, subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares D3 |

| F      |        | 43124-1<br>Cream | 1 YD     | (2) 5-1/4" X 42" strips, subcut (14) 5-1/4" squares, crosscut twice to create (56) QST F1<br>(4) 5" X 42" strips, subcut (28) 5" squares, crosscut once to create (56) HST F2   |
| G      |        | 43124-2<br>Brown | 1 YD     | (4) 1-1/2" X 42" strips for QUILT CENTER BORDER<br>(6) 1-1/2" X 42" strips * BORDER 1<br>(8) 2-1/4" X 42" strips, BINDING   |
| H      |        | 43124-6<br>Gold  | 1/2 YD   | (1) 5-1/4" X 42" strip, subcut (7) 5-1/4" squares, crosscut twice to create (28) QST H1<br>(2) 5" X 42" strips, subcut (14) 5" squares, crosscut once to create (28) HST H2   |

Backing Fabric: 4-3/4 YD (42" wide)

Batting: 70" X 82"

QST = Quarter Square Triangle HST = Half Square Triangle

@ - Directional Fabric \* = Sew together vis short ends, then go to Border Assembly

## General Instructions:

- All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric unless otherwise noted.

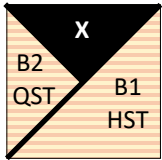


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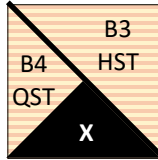
## Cutting Diagrams for B and E squares:

1. Following diagrams below, cross cut B and E squares as shown. Label pieces after cutting, discard X quarter square triangle.

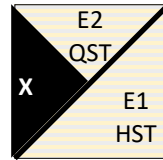
(14) B 5-1/4" squares



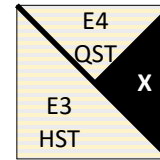

**Piecing Instructions:** (Refer to chart, diagrams and images for proper placement and rotation)

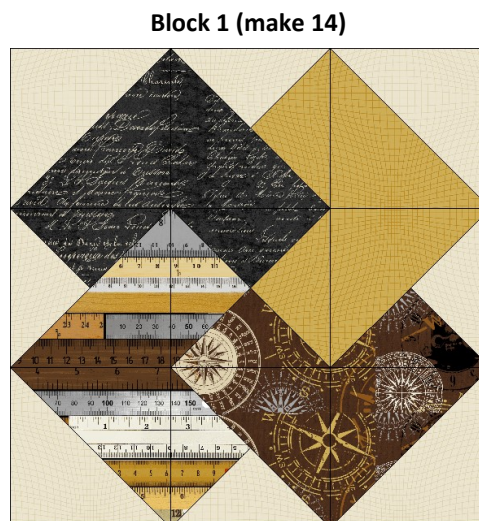
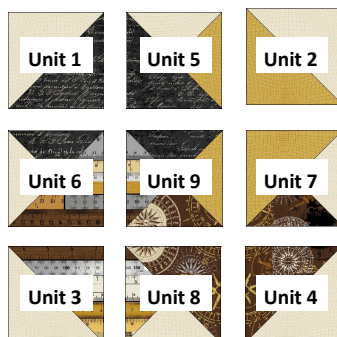
### Make Units:

1. Sew (2) HSTs together to create Units 1, 2, 3, and 4. Square to 4-1/2", make (14) each.
2. Sew (2) QSTs together. Press, then sew to (1) HST to create Units 5, 6, 7 and 8. Square to 4-1/2", make (14) each.
3. Sew (4) QSTs together to create Unit 9. Square to 4-1/2", make (14).

### Make Block:

4. Sew Units together into rows, then sew rows together to create Block 1. Square to 12-1/2", make (14).





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**Assembly Instructions:** (Refer to quilt diagram for proper block placement and rotation)

**Quilt Assembly:**

5. Sew (1) G 1-1/2" X 34-1/2" strip to each side of the A 22-1/2" X 34-1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) G 1-1/2" X 24-1/2" strip to top and bottom to create Quilt Center. Square to 24-1/2" X 36-1/2".
6. Sew (3) Block 1s together to create Side Unit. Make (2), sew to sides of Quilt Center.
7. Sew (4) Block 1s together to create Top/Bottom Unit. Make (2), sew to top and bottom of Quilt Center.

**Border Assembly:**

**Border 1:**

8. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 60-1/2"), cut (2) G 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 50-1/2") cut (2) G 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

**Border 2:**

9. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 50-1/2"), cut (2) C 6-1/2" strips, set aside for step 11.
10. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 62-1/2"), cut (2) C 6-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt.
11. Sew (1) D3 square to each end of C 6-1/2" strip from step 9, then sew to top of quilt. Repeat for bottom.

**Finishing:**

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
