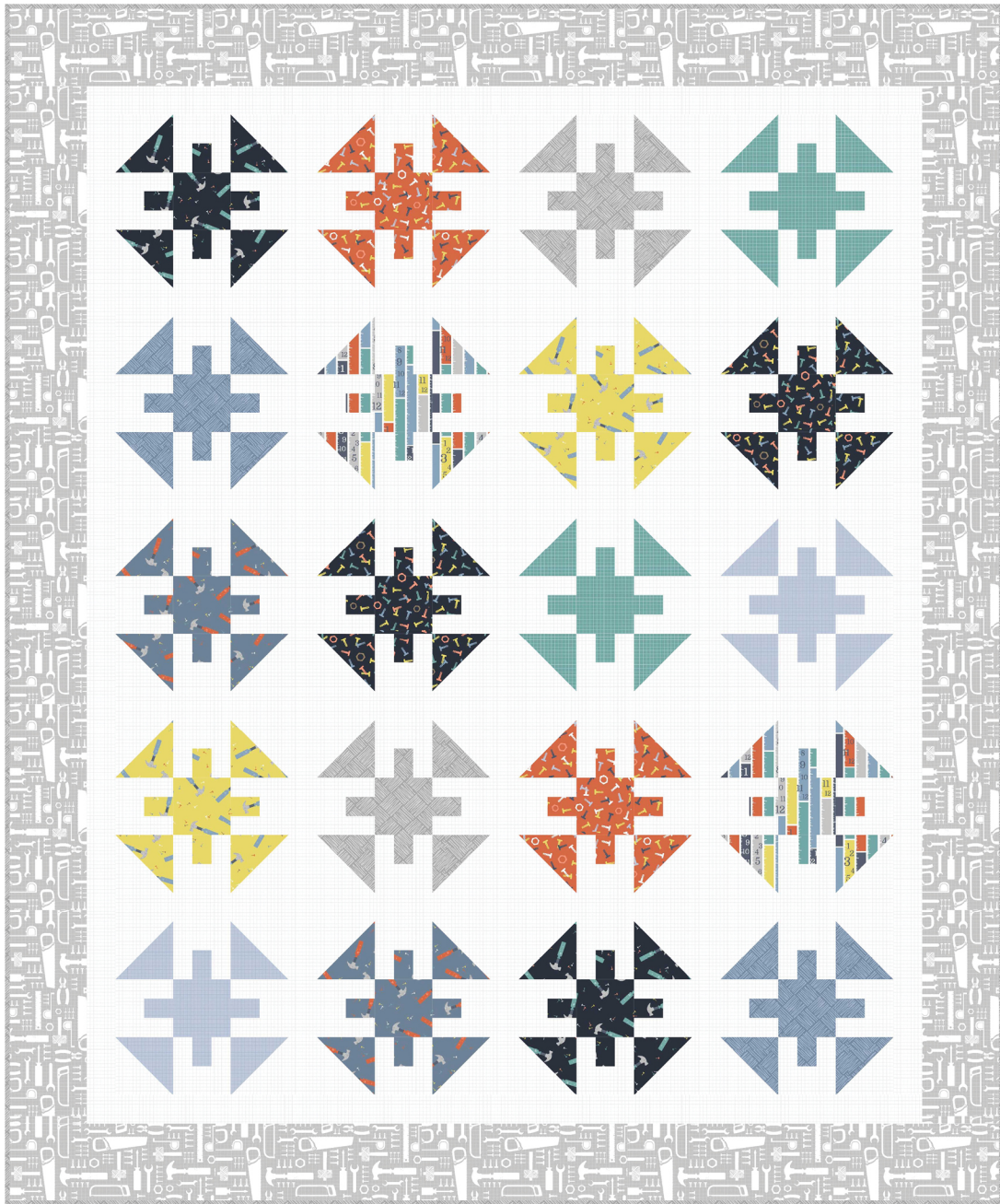

# Measure Once, Cut Twice

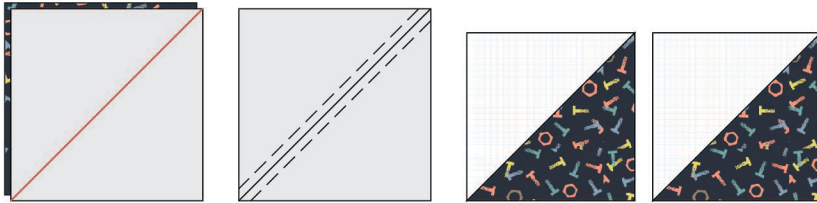
KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A		50283-1 Navy	1/4	(1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4" squares, (2) 3 1/2" squares, and (8) 1 1/2" x 2" pieces.
B		50282-4 Grey	7/8	(6) 4 1/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 4 1/4" x 51 1/2" strips and (2) 4 1/4" x 54 1/2" strips.
C		50281-X Multi	1/4	(1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4" squares, (2) 3 1/2" squares, and (8) 1 1/2" x 2" pieces.
D		50283-5 Orange	1/4	(1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4" squares, (2) 3 1/2" squares, and (8) 1 1/2" x 2" pieces.
E		50284-1 Navy	1/4	(1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4" squares, (2) 3 1/2" squares, and (8) 1 1/2" x 2" pieces.
F		50284-6 Yellow	1/4	(1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4" squares, (2) 3 1/2" squares, and (8) 1 1/2" x 2" pieces.
G		50284-7 Slate	1/4	(1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4" squares, (2) 3 1/2" squares, and (8) 1 1/2" x 2" pieces.
H		50285-3 Teal	1/4	(1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4" squares, (2) 3 1/2" squares, and (8) 1 1/2" x 2" pieces.
I		50285-7 Slate	1/4	(1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4" squares, (2) 3 1/2" squares, and (8) 1 1/2" x 2" pieces.
J		50286-4 Grey	1/4	(1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4" squares, (2) 3 1/2" squares, and (8) 1 1/2" x 2" pieces.
K		50286-7 Slate	5/8	(1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4" squares, (2) 3 1/2" squares, and (8) 1 1/2" x 2" pieces. (6) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.
L		50285-8 White on White	2 1/8	(4) 4" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 4" squares. (26) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut (4) 2" x 41" strips, (15) 2" x 9-1/2" pieces, (160) 1 1/2" x 2" pieces and (80) 2" x 3 1/2" pieces. Piece remaining (5) strips and cut (2) 51-1/2" lengths and (2) 44" lengths.

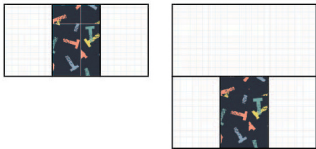
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## Making the Blocks

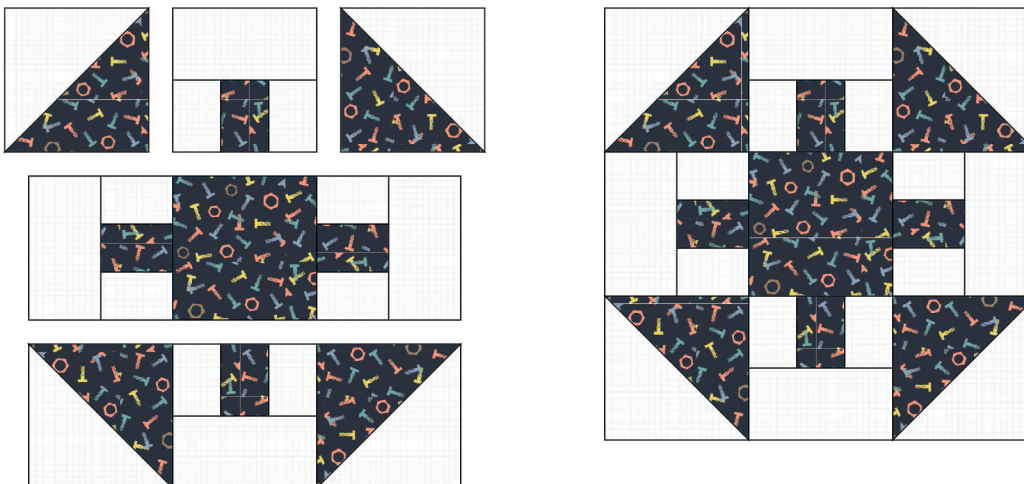
1. HST units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 4" **A** square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 4" **L** square. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) HST units. Trim HST units to measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make a total of (4) **A/L** HST units.



2. Middle Units. Sew  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" **L** pieces to opposite sides of (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" **A** piece. Add (1) 2" x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " **L** piece to the top to make a middle unit. Make a total of (4) middle units.



3. Lay out (4) HST units, (4) middle units, and (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** square into (3) rows of (3) units each as shown. Sew the units into rows and join the rows to complete a block. Block should measure  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



4. In the same way, make a total of (2) blocks each using the following fabrics:  
**A/L, C/L, D/L, E/L, F/L, G/L, H/L, I/L, J/L, K/L**



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## Assembly

5. Lay out (4) blocks and (3) 2" x 9-1/2" **L** strips to make a piece rows. Join the pieces together. Repeat to make a total of (5) pieced rows.
6. Sew the rows together alternating with (4) 2" x 41" **L** strips to complete the quilt center.
7. Inner border. Sew 2" x 51-1/2" **L** strips to opposite long sides of the quilt center. Sew 2" x 44" **L** strips to the top and bottom.
8. Outer border. Sew 4-1/4" x 54-1/2" **B** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 4-1/4" x 51-1/2" **B** strips to the top and bottom to complete quilt top.

## Finishing

9. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich and quilt as desired.
10. Bind the quilt using the (6) 2-1/4" x WOF **K** strips.
