Fabric Requirements:

- 1 7/8 yds white solid
- 1/2 yd 39983-7 for binding
- 1/3 yd each of 39981-7 & 39985-7
- 1/8 yd each of 39980-1,2,3,4 for block centers
- 1/4 yard each of 39987-2,3,4,6 for star points
- Fat 1/8 of remaining 25 pieces for pieced sashing
- 3 1/2" yds backing

Cutting Instructions

From the white solid, cut:

- 12 – 3 ½" strips; cut into 128 – 3 ½" squares for blocks
- 6 – 3" strips for outer border

From 39983-7 cut 6 – 2 ½" strips for binding

From 39981-7 & 39985-7 cut:

- 13 – 4 ¼" squares from EACH to make hourglass blocks

From 39980-1,2,3 & 4, cut 4 – 3 ½" squares from EACH color for a total of 16 squares for block centers

From 39987-2,3,4 & 6, cut from EACH color for star points:

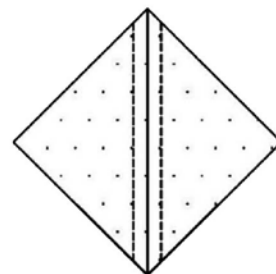
- 16 --- 2" squares
- 8 --- 2 1/2" squares
- 8 --- 3" squares

From the remaining Fat 1/8's, cut a total of 72 – 1 ½" x 21" strips for pieced sashing

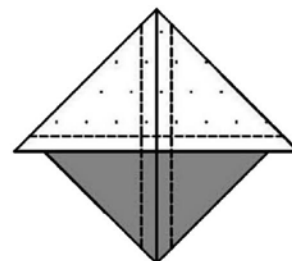
Piecing Instructions

To make hourglass blocks:

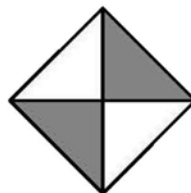
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light gray squares (39985-7). Pair each of these squares with a dark gray square (39981-7). Sew, right sides together, ¼" on both sides of the drawn lines. Cut on drawn line and press toward the dark gray triangle.



On half of these units (13), draw a diagonal line on the wrong side, perpendicular to your stitching line. Pair with the remaining units, putting fabrics opposite each other. Sew ¼" on both sides of the drawn lines. Cut on line and press seam to one side.



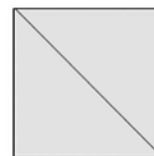
You should now have 26 Hourglass blocks.
Trim to 3 ½" if needed.



To make star blocks:

Begin by marking the sewing lines on the wrong side of the tonal print squares (39987-2,3,4 & 6). You will treat them all like connector corners, but some will not be sewn the traditional way.

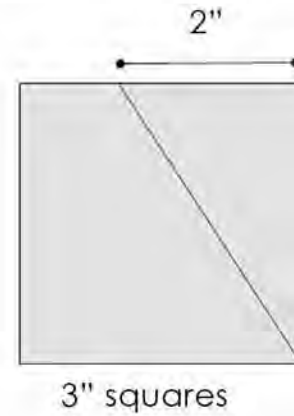
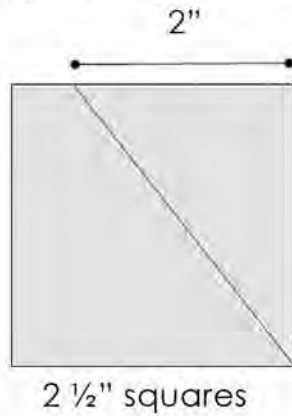
Mark your 64 - 2" squares diagonally from corner to corner.



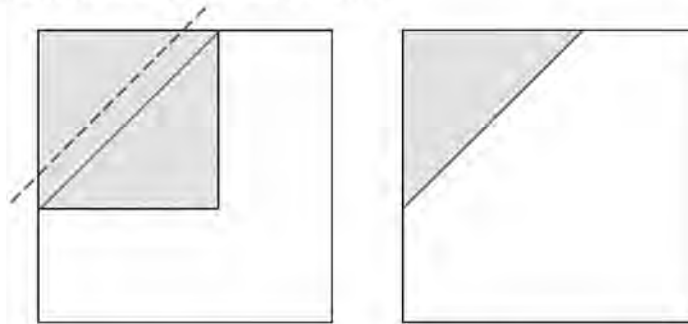

Mark the 32 - 2 ½" and 3" squares from one corner to the measured place as diagrammed below.



Sew a 2" square to the left top corner of 64 white 3 ½" squares. Sew on the drawn line. Trim excess off making a ¼" seam allowance (dotted line). Press corner away from the white.

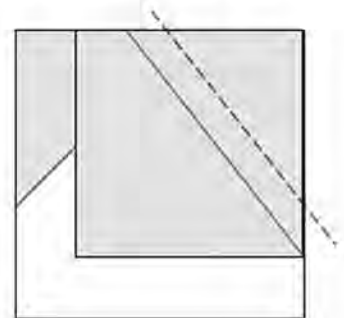


Now sew the remaining squares to the top right corner of the white squares. Sew the 2 ½" squares to half and the 3" squares to the other half.

Sew on drawn line. Trim off excess at ¼" seam allowance and press triangles away from center. Your unit will no longer be square, but you will trim it down.

Using the 3 ½" white squares as a guide, trim triangles down so that the unit once again measures 3 ½".

Arrange block centers, star points and white squares together to make the star blocks. Alternate the star point blocks so that the lengths of the points vary. Sew into rows and press toward the corner and center squares. Sew rows together and press seams to one side. You will make 16 blocks.

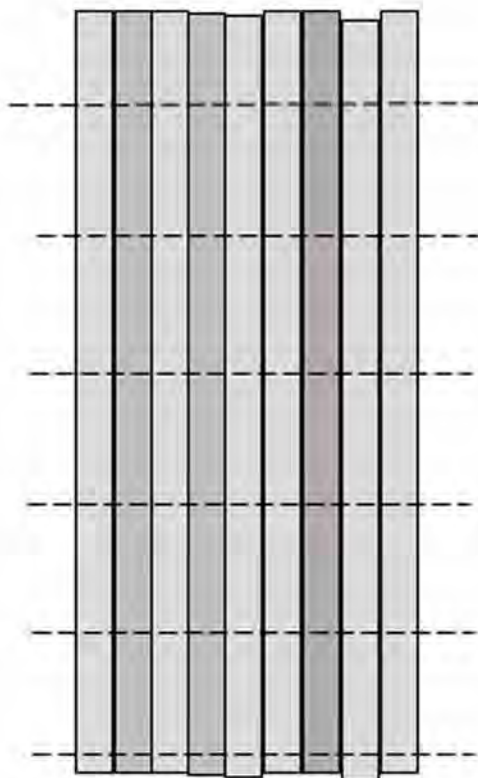

To make pieced sashing:

Make 8 strip sets of 9 -1 ½" strips each. Press seams to one side. Cut into 3 ½" segments for a total of 40 - 3 ½" x 9 ½" pieced sashings.



Assemble quilt:

Lay blocks out in desired order, with pieced sashing and hourglasses. Sew together into rows, pressing seams away from the sashing strips. Sew rows together and press seams to one side.

Measure your quilt center well. Piece 3" white border strips together with mitered seams and cut borders to size. Sew to quilt and press seams away from center.

Quilt as desired and bind.

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
