

1/3 yard 40714-2 Teal for blocks

1/4 yard 40714-4 Soft Grey

5 1/8 yard 40715-5 Charcoal for blocks and backing

3/8 yard 40715-6 Pumpkin for blocks

3/4 yard 40716-2 Teal for blocks

1/4 yard 40716-7 Red Multi for blocks

2/3 yard 40716-8 Teal Multi for blocks

3/4 yard 40716-10 Red for binding



5/8 yards 40717-10 Red for blocks 1/2 yard 40717-11 Gold for blocks 1/4 yards 40718-2 Teal for blocks 2 yards 40718-5 Charcoal for background 1/3 yard 40718-12 Coral for blocks 85"x85" piece of batting

Cutting

From the 40714-1 Midnight Grey cut:

5 squares, 5 1/2" 4 Strips, 5 1/4"x 40" 2 strips, 5 1/4"x 34"

2 strips, 5 1/4"x 24"

From the 40714-2 Teal cut:

16 squares, 4 1/2"

From the 40714-4 Soft Grey cut:

4 squares, 5 1/2"

From the 40715-5 Charcoal cut:

8 squares, 4 1/2"

From the 40715-6 Pumpkin cut:

36 pieces from Template B

From the 40716-2 Teal cut:

32 diamonds from Template A

4 strips, 2"x 40"

2 strips, 2"x 21"

2 strips, 2"x 24"

From the 40716-7 Red Multi cut:

4 squares, 4 1/2"

From the 40716-8 Teal Multi cut:

8 strips, 2 1/2"x 40"

From the 40716-10 Red cut:

2 1/4" bias strips for scalloped binding, enough to make 370" of bias binding. Make more as

needed.

From the 40717-10 Red cut:

32 squares, 4 1/2"

From the 40717-11 Gold cut:

36 Rectangles, 2 1/2"x 5 1/2"

From the 40718-2 Teal cut:

40 diamonds from Template A

From the 40718-5 Charcoal cut:

164 squares, 2 1/2"

8 strips, 2 1/2"x 40"

4 squares, 4 1/2"

72 squares, 2 3/8"; cut on both diagonals to

make 144 half square triangles (HST)

From the 40718-12 Coral cut:

16 squares, 4 1/2"

Instructions

1. Take the 40716-8 Teal Multi and 40718-5 Charcoal 2 1/2"x 40" strips and sew them together into pairs. Press towards the charcoal, and then cut the strip sets into 128 two-patch units 2 1/2" wide. Sew the two patch units together in pairs as shown to make 64 four-patch units. Trim and square to 4 1/2" and set aside.








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2. Take a 40718-12 Coral 4 1/2" square and place a 40718-5 Charcoal 2 1/2" square in one corner. Sew across the square on the diagonal as show. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4" and press towards the Charcoal. Repeat for the opposite corner. Trim and square the block to 4 1/2". Repeat for the remaining 40718-12 Coral squares to make 16 Coral A Units, 40717-10 Red squares to make 32 Red A Units, and 40714-2 Teal squares to make 16 Teal A Units.



3. Take 16 of the four-patch units, 16 Teal A units, and 4 40718-5 Charcoal 4 1/2" squares and sew them together as shown to make 4 Teal A Blocks. Repeat with 16 four-patch units, 16 Coral A Units, and 4 40716-7 Red Multi 4 1/2" squares to make 4 Coral A Blocks, and then repeat with the remaining 32 four-patch units, 32 Red A Units, and 8 40715-5 Charcoal 4 1/2" squares to make 8 Red A Blocks. Set all aside for now.




4. Take the 40715-6 Pumpkin Template B units and sew a 40718-5 Charcoal 2 3/8" HST to either side as shown. Press towards the Charcoal. Sew a 40717-11 Gold 2 1/2"x 5 1/2" rectangle to the bottom of each unit to make 36 Gold C Units. Trim and square to 4"x 5 1/2" and set aside.



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






x 36 Gold C Units

5. Take a 40718-5 Charcoal 2 1/2" and mark the seam allowance in one corner. Using a Y-seam technique, sew a pair of 40716-2 Teal Template A units to adjacent corners of the Charcoal square. Press towards the charcoal, and the center seam open, and then sew a pair of Charcoal 2 3/8" HST to the remaining sides of the Teal diamonds. Repeat with 15 of the remaining 40718-5 Charcoal 2 1/2" squares and all of the 40716-2 Teal Template A units to make 16 Teal D Units.



6. Repeat the above step with the 20 remaining 40718-5 Charcoal 2 1/2" squares, 2 3/8" Charcoal HST and all of the 40718-2 Teal Template A Units to make 20 Solid Teal D Units.









x 20 Solid Teal D Units


7. Take 20 of the Gold C Units, 5 40714-1 Midnight Grey 5 1/2" squares, and the 20 Solid Teal D Units, and sew them together as shown to make 5 Gold C Blocks. Repeat with the 16 remaining Gold C Units, 4 40714-1 Soft Grey 5 1/2" squares, and the 16 Teal D Units to make 4 Gold D Blocks. Trim and square to 12 1/2" and set aside.

Making the Quilt Top

- 8. Referring to the layout diagram, sew the blocks together into rows, and then sew the rows together into the quilt top.
- 9. Sew 2 of the 40716-2 Teal 2"x40" strips with the 2"x 21" strips to make 2 short inside border strips 60 1/2" long. Sew them to the sides of the quilt top, matching ends and centers. Sew the 2 remaining Teal 2"x40" strips with the 2"x 24" strips to make 2 long inside border strips 63 1/2" long. Sew them to the top and bottom of the quilt top, matching ends and centers.
- 10.Sew 2 of the 40714-1 Midnight Grey 5 1/2"x 40" strips to the 5 1/2"x 24" strips to make the two side borders 63 1/2" long and sew them to the side of the quilt top, matching ends and centers. Sew the 2 remaining 40714-1 Midnight Grey 5 1/2"x 40" strips to the 5 1/2"x 34" strips to make the top and bottom borders 73 1/2", and sew them to the top and bottom, matching ends and centers.
- 11. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired and then trim and square the quilt. Place the Corner Scallop template in the top left corner of the quilt as shown and trace the curve using a marking pen.






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
12. Place the Scallop Template beside the Corner Scallop Template and trace the curve. Lift the Scallop Template and move it to the right to make the next scallop. Continue tracing the scallops across the width of the border from corner to corner (12 should fit across, adjust as needed). Cut out the scallops and discard the trimmings. Using the 40716-10 Red 2 1/4" wide bias binding strips, sew around the quilt top, mitering at the point of each scallop. Turn the binding to the back and secure. For an excellent tutorial on how to sew a scallop border/binding watch the Fons and Porter Easy Scallop Border video.
