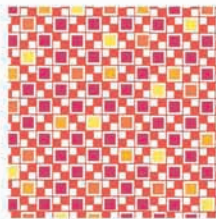

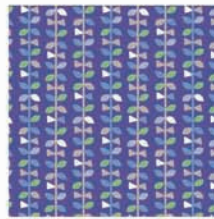

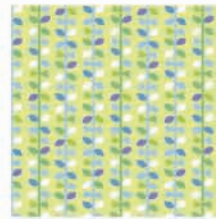

Fabric Requirements:

- 31835 White (1930's Solids) -- 1 yard
- 39947-1 Green -- 1/2 yard
- 39951-2 Blue -- 1 1/3 yards (includes binding)
- 39947-2 Light Blue -- 1/4 yard
- 39951-1 Green -- 1/4 yard
- 39948-4 Red -- 5/8 yard
- 39945-X Multi -- 1 yard
- 39946-X Multi -- 1/4 yard
- Backing -- 3 1/3 yards

Cutting Directions:

31835 White from 1930's Solids

- Cut (48) 2 3/4" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to make (96) position A.
- Cut (24) 4 3/4" squares. Cut each square twice diagonally to make (96) position B.
- Cut (4) 2" X 10 1/2" strips for second border.

39947-1 Green

- Cut (8) 4" squares for position C.
- Cut (48) 2 3/4" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to make (96) position A

39951-2 Blue

- Cut (8) 4" squares for position C.
- Cut (48) 2 3/4" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to make (96) position A
- Cut (4) 2" X 2" squares for corner blocks of first border.
- Cut (2) 10 1/2" X 2" strips for top and bottom of center block.
- Cut (2) 8" X 2" strips for sides of center block.
- Cut (3) 2 1/2" X width of fabric (WOF) strips for sides of seventh border. Join to make (2) 49 1/2" X 2 1/2" strips.
- Cut (3) 2 1/2" X WOF strips for top and bottom of seventh border. Join to make (2) 53 1/2" X 2 1/2" strips.
- Cut (6) 2 1/4" X WOF strips and join to make approximately 216" for binding.

39947-2 Light Blue

Cut (4) 4" squares for position C.

Cut (24) 2 ¾" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to make (48) position A

Cut (4) 2" X 2" squares for corner blocks of fourth border.

39951-1 Green

Cut (4) 29 ½" X 2" strips for fourth border.

39948-4 Red

Cut (24) 2 ¾" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to make (48) position A

Cut (2) 13 ½" X 2" strips for sides of second border.

Cut (2) 16 ½" X 2" strips for top and bottom of second border.

Cut (4) 32 ½" X 2" strips for fifth border.

39946-X Multi

Cut (4) 4" squares for position C.

Cut (4) 2" squares for corner blocks of fifth border.

Cut (1) 8" X 8" square for center of quilt

39945-X Multi

Cut (2) 7" X 16 1/2" strips for sides of third border.

Cut (2) 29 ½" X 7" strips for top and bottom of third border.

Instructions:

1. Center Block



Sew (1) 8" X 2" blue strip to each side of the 8" x 8" 39946-X Multi square.

Sew (1) 10 ½" X 2" blue strip to top of rectangle and (1) to the bottom.

Center should measure 10 ½" X 10 ½".

2. First Border



Sew (1) 2" X 10 ½" white strip to each side of center block.

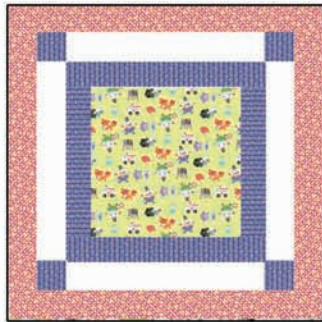
Sew (1) 2" blue corner block to each end of remaining 2" X 10 ½" white strips.

Attach strips to top and bottom of the center block.

3. Second Border



Sew (1) $13\frac{1}{2}$ " X 2" red strip to each side to make quilt center.
Sew (1) $16\frac{1}{2}$ " X 2" red strip to top and (1) to bottom of quilt center.

4. Third Border - humpty dumpty story

Sew (1) 7" X $16\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to each side of quilt center.
Sew (1) $29\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" strip to top and (1) strip to bottom of quilt center.

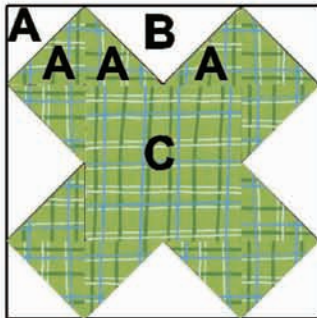
5. Fourth Border


Sew (1) $29\frac{1}{2}$ " X 2" green strip to each side of quilt center.
Sew (1) 2" blue square to each end of each of remaining $29\frac{1}{2}$ " X 2" green strips. Attach to quilt center.

6. Fifth Border

Sew (1) $32\frac{1}{2}$ " X 2" red strips to each side of quilt center.
Sew (1) 2" green square to each end of each of remaining $32\frac{1}{2}$ " X 2" red strips. Attach to quilt center.

7. Sixth Border - Pieced Blocks



Sew (1) white triangle position A to (1) print triangle A and trim unit to $2\frac{1}{4}$ " X $2\frac{1}{4}$ ". Repeat for each similar unit. 

Sew (1) print triangle A to each side of (1) white triangle B and trim to $2\frac{1}{4}$ " X 4". Repeat for each similar unit.
Press

Referring to block diagram for placement, make (8) green blocks, (8) blue blocks and (4) light blue blocks and (4) red corner blocks with cream centers.

8. Seventh Border

Sew (1) $49\frac{1}{2}$ " X $2\frac{1}{2}$ " blue strip to each side of quilt center.
Sew (1) $53\frac{1}{2}$ " X $2\frac{1}{2}$ " blue strip to top and (1) to bottom of quilt center.
Quilt should now measure $53\frac{1}{2}$ " X $53\frac{1}{2}$ ".
Quilt and bind, as desired.
