Estimated Fabric Requirements:

Blue Version

- 1/3 yard – 42943M-1 Blue
- 1/2 yard – 42941M-3 Teal
- 1/3 yard – 42942M-1 Blue
- 1/4 yard – 42945M-4 Black
- 3/4 yard – 72942M-1 Blue

Cutting Instructions:

Note: The Grey Version fabrics are listed second in () where they differ from the Blue Version.

Fabric A: Weave – Blue (Weave – Grey)

- Cut one 10" square.

Fabric B: Main Stripe – Teal (Main Stripe – Grey)

- Fussy cut four 4 ½" x 14" strips.

Fabric C: Tossed Medallions – Blue (Tossed Medallions – Grey)

- Cut one 2 ¾" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 2 ¾" x 18" strips.
- Cut two 2 ¾" x 22 ½" WOF strips.

Fabric D: Swirls – Black

- Cut two 1 ½" x 22 ½" WOF strips.
- Cut two 1 ½" x 24 ½" WOF strips.

Backing: Tossed Medallions – Blue (Tossed Medallions – Grey)

- Cut two 15 ½" x 24 ½" WOF strips.

Block Assembly:

1. Starting at the top left corner of the 10" Fabric A square, sew one 4 ½" x 14" Fabric B strip to the left side. Stop halfway down (Fig. 1)
2. Sew another 4 ½" x 14" Fabric B strip to the top of the sewn unit (Fig. 2).
3. Sew a third 4 ½" x 14" Fabric B strip to the right side of the sewn unit (Fig. 3).
4. Sew a fourth 4 ½" x 14" Fabric B strip to the bottom of the sewn unit (Fig. 4).

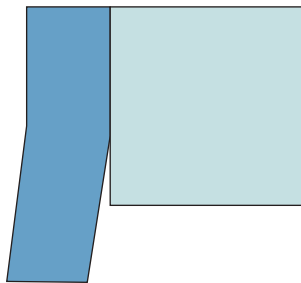

5. Finish sewing the seam of the first 4 ½" x 14" Fabric B strip from Step 1 to make one 18" Unit 1 square (Fig. 5).

Pillow Assembly – Refer to Figures 6 & 7 while assembling the pillow top:

6. Sew one 2 ¾" x 18" Fabric C strip to each side of the Unit 1 square. Sew one 2 ¾" x 22 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make the Center Block.
7. Sew one 1 ½" x 22 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 1 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to complete the pillow front.

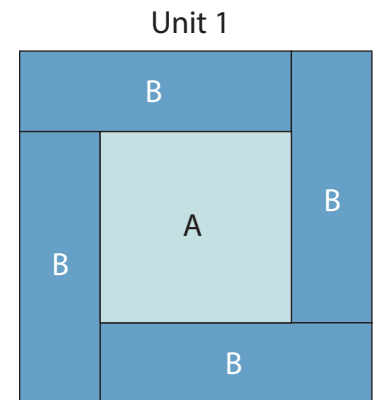

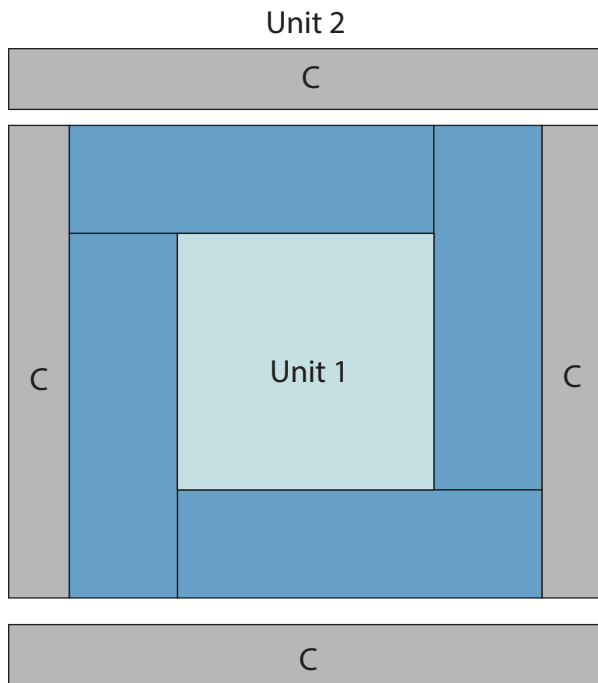

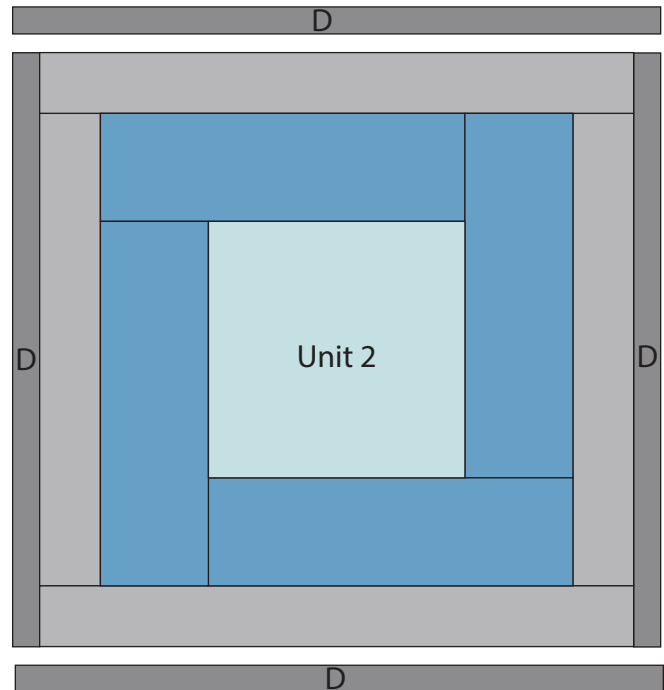

8. To make the back envelope flaps, turn under the 24 ½" edge on one 15 ½" x 24 ½" Back strip, approximately ¼", press and repeat. Top stitch the folded fabric in place to make one flap. Repeat with the second 15 ½" x 24 ½" Back strip to make another flap.
9. Position and pin the each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front. Stitch around the pillow front and turn the pillow right side out.
