		Dark Navy-Blue		(8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2-1/2" x 69-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" strips.




CENTER BLOCK

Sew (1) B 4" x 52-1/2" strip to the long sides of the A rectangle, followed by (1) B 3-1/2" x 49-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the same A rectangle to make the Center Block. Trim to measure 48-1/2" x 57-1/2".

CORNER SQUARE

2. Corner Triangles: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) F 3-1/2" square. Place F square, right sides together (RST), at a corner of (1) D 6-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal F corner triangle. Repeat with additional (3) F squares on the remaining corners of the same D square, as shown, to complete Corner Square. Make (4).



Trim to measure 48-1/2" x 57-1/2"



Draw diagonal line on wrong side of **F** square.



Sew on drawn line and trim 1/4" away from sewn line.




Open and press to reveal **F** corner triangle.



Add three more corner triangles. Make (4).

3. Flying Geese Units: Repeat Step 2, using (2) C 3-1/2" squares and (1) D 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle. Make (16). NOTE FABRIC PRINT ORIENTATION FOR DIRECTIONAL PRINTS IF DESIRED.



Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" and open to reveal **C** corner triangle. Repeat on opposite corner.



Make (16) of **C/D**.



4. Repeat **Step 3** to make the indicated number of **Flying Geese Units** in the different fabric combinations:

Make (16) of each.









PIECED BORDERS

NOTE UNIT ARRANGEMENT AND ROTATION.

5. Sew together (18) Flying Geese Units and (1) **G** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to make (1) Pieced Side Border. Make (2).



6. Sew together (16) Flying Geese Units and (2) Corner Squares to make (1) Pieced Top/Bottom Border. Make (2).



QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

REFER TO QUILT IMAGE ON THE NEXT PAGE.

- 7. Sew (2) Pieced Side Borders and (2) Pieced Top/Bottom Borders to the Center Block.
- 8. Sew (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 69-1/2" strip to the left and right sides of the quilt center, followed by (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" strip to the top and bottom to complete quilt top.



QUILT ASSEMBLY



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **D** 2-1/2" strips.
