Α		31835-White	5/8	Cut one 6-1/2" square (cactus block) and ten 6-7/8" squares (recut each 6-78" square each into two triangles) for 20 Patch D triangles used in Block 1 and Block 3.
В	or diff	43470-5 Yellow	1/2	Cut eight 6-7/8" squares (recut each into two triangles) for 16 Patch D triangles used in Block 2.
С		43470-4 Red	1/4	Cut one 7-1/4" square (recut into four triangles for Patch B). These are used in Block 2. Also cut four 3-7/8" squares (recut each into two triangles for Patch C). These are used in Blocks 2.
D		43471-2 Blue	1/2	Cut three 7-1/4" squares (recut each into four triangles for Patch B). These are used in Blocks 1 and 3 (discard 3 triangles). Also cut five 3-7/8" squares (recut each into two triangles for Patch C). These are used in Blocks 1 and 3.

Piecing the Blocks:

Each block is constructed using the same size patches and sewn in the same sequence.

- 1. Block 3 Cactus block. Transfer template markings to template material and cut out. Prepare selected red and green fabrics for your favorite applique method. Place patches in center of a 6-1/2" white A square. Stitch in place, adding the cactus spines using black embroidery thread.
- 2. For all blocks, select your pre-cut patches and sew two B triangle patches to each side of the center A patch. Press seams toward the A patch. Diagram 1.
- 3. Next, sew a colored C triangle to the top and bottom of the Diagram 1 units. Press seams toward the C patches. Diagram 2.
- 4. Finally, add the 6-7/8" triangles to the four corners as shown in Diagram 3. Make four of Block 1, four of Block 2 and one of Block 3. Square to $12 \frac{1}{2}$ ".






Piecing the four border corner blocks (Greek Key Log Cabin)

5. Note the cutting information for the four blocks as shown in the block diagram. There are 7 strips of both red and white fabrics. These are sewn in a spiral/log cabin sequence. Make 4 of these. Square to $6 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

Quilt Assembly

- 6. Sew the nine 12" blocks together to form the quilt center. This measures 36-1/2" x 36-1/2". Refer to the color quilt picture for placement.
- 7. Cut four 2-1/2" x wof strips from 43471-2 Blue for the inner borders. Sew to quilt center. This now measures 40-1/2" x 40-1/2".
- 8. Cut four 6-1/2" WOF strips of border stripe (#43472-X Multi). Measure your quilt center and trim these strips to that size. Sew one to each side of the quilt. Stitch a Greek Key Log Cabin (red and white) block to each of the short ends of the remaining two 6-1/2" strips. Join to center to finish.
- 9. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with quilt top.
- 10. Cut 5 strips 2-1/4" x WOF from 43471-4 Red and stitch together into long strip. Use to bind quilt.





Greek Key Log Cabin Blocks - Make 4

A: Cut one red and one white $1-1/4" \times 1-1/4"$

B: Cut one red and one white 1-1/4" x 2"

C: Cut one red and one white 1-1/4" x 2-3/4"


D: Cut one red and one white 1-1/4" x 3-1/2"

E: Cut one red and one white 1-1/4" x 4-1/4"

F: Cut one red and one white 1-1/4" x 5"

G: Cut one red and one white 1-1/4" x 5-3/4"

H: Cut one red and one white 1-1/4" x 6-1/2"
