4-1/2 yards backing fabric
Thread to match fabrics
Basic sewing supplies

77" x 87" batting<br>Sewing machine<br>Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

Template plastic

## BLOCKS

1. Sew (1) O 1" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to side of (1) F 2-1/2" square, noting orientation of stripes. Sew
(1) O 1" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ strip to adjacent side.
2. Sew (1) J $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ strip to side with $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{O}$ strip. Sew (1) J $2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to adjacent side.
3. Sew (1) $\mathbf{O} 1^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to side with $3^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{J}$ strip. Sew (1) $\mathbf{O} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ strip to adjacent side.
4. Sew (1) G 5" $\times 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to side with 4-1/2" $\mathbf{O}$ strip noting orientation of stripes. Sew (1) G 2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to adjacent side to complete corner unit 1 . Corner unit should measure $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square including seam allowance. Make 2.
5. Following steps 1-4, make corner unit 2 using the fabrics indicated to make corner unit 2 . Make 2.

6. Sew (2) O 6-1/2" x 1-3/4" to opposite sides of one M 1-3/4" square to make block center unit. Make 1.

7. Sew (1) corner unit 1 and (1) corner unit 2 to opposite sides of (1) O 6-1/2" $\times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strip to make half block units. Make 2.


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8. Sew half block units to sides of block center unit to make block 1 . Block should measure $13-3 / 4$ " square including seam allowance.Make 4.
9. Following steps 1-8, make blocks 2-6 using the fabrics shown. Make the number of blocks indicated.

10. Following steps 1-4, make the (2) corner unit 1 and (1) corner unit 2.
11. Sew (1) corner unit 1 and (1) A Large Triangle to opposite sides of (1) $\mathbf{O}$ 6-1/2" $\times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strip to make a half block unit. Make 1.

12. Sew (1) corner unit 1 and (1) corner unit 2 to opposite sides of (1) $06-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strip to make a half block unit. Make 1.

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13. Sew (1) $\mathbf{O} 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ to opposite sides of one $\mathbf{K} 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square to make block center unit. Make 1.
14. Sew half block units to opposite sides of center unit to make Block 7. Make 2
15. Following steps 10-14, to make Block 8 using the fabrics shown. Make 2.


## Side Triangles

16. Sew (1) J 2-1/8" triangle to end of (1) O 6-1/2" $\times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strip make a triangle/strip unit. Note orientation of triangle.
17. Sew (1) A Large Triangle and (1) $\mathbf{O}$ 6-1/2" square to opposite side of (1) $\mathbf{O} 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strip to make a triangle/square unit. Make 1.

19. Sew ends of (1) $\mathbf{O}$ 6-1/2" $\times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strip to opposite sides of (1) $\mathbf{K}$ or $\mathbf{N} 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make 8 each.


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Top and Bottom Triangles
20. Following step 16, make a triangle/strip unit. Make 1.
21. Sew triangle/strip unit to side of (1) A Large Triangle to make top triangle. Make 1.
22. Following steps 20-21, make bottom triangle using (1) $\mathbf{N} 2-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ triangle.


## Corner Triangles

23. Following step 16, make (2) triangle/strip units using (1) J 2-1/8" triangle and (1) K 2-1/8" triangle. Note color and orientation of triangles.
24. Sew (1) O 6-1/2" $\times 1-3 / 4$ " strip to (1) $\mathbf{O}$ 6-1/2" square to make a square/strip unit. Make 1.
25. Sew triangle/strip units to sides of triangle square unit.
26. Sew (1) A Large Triangle to sides of triangle/strip units. Sew (1) A Small Triangle to $\mathbf{O} 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ $1-3 / 4$ " square to make a triangle. Make 1.

27. Following steps $23-26$, make (3) corners using the $2-1 / 8$ " triangles shown. Make 1 of each.

## ASSEMBLY CENTER

28. Following the Quilt Center Layout on page 8, arrange the blocks, sashing strips, side triangles and top and bottom triangles in diagonal rows as shown. Sew together the blocks and triangles alternating with sashing strips to make each row.
29. Sew together the $\mathbf{O} 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips alternating with $1-3 / 4$ " squares to make the sashing rows. Sew (1) $2-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to the ends of each row noting the orientation of the triangles.
30. Sew the block rows and the sashing rows together matching seams. Sew the corner sashing units on last. Sew the corners to the corner sashing rows matching seams. Trim quilt edges $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ past sashing triangle points. Quilt center should measure approximately 61-1/2" x 71-3/4".

## BORDERS

31. Sew short side of (1) G $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 75-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of quilt beginning and ending stitching $1 / 4$ " from edges of quilt center. Sew short side of (2) G 1-3/4" $\times 65-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of quilt beginning and ending stitching $1 / 4$ " from edges of quilt center. Sew diagonal ends of borders together at corners.
32. Sew (1) $\mathbf{K} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 75^{\prime \prime}$ borders to each side of quilt. Sew (2) $\mathbf{K} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 68-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using G 2-1/4" strips.
