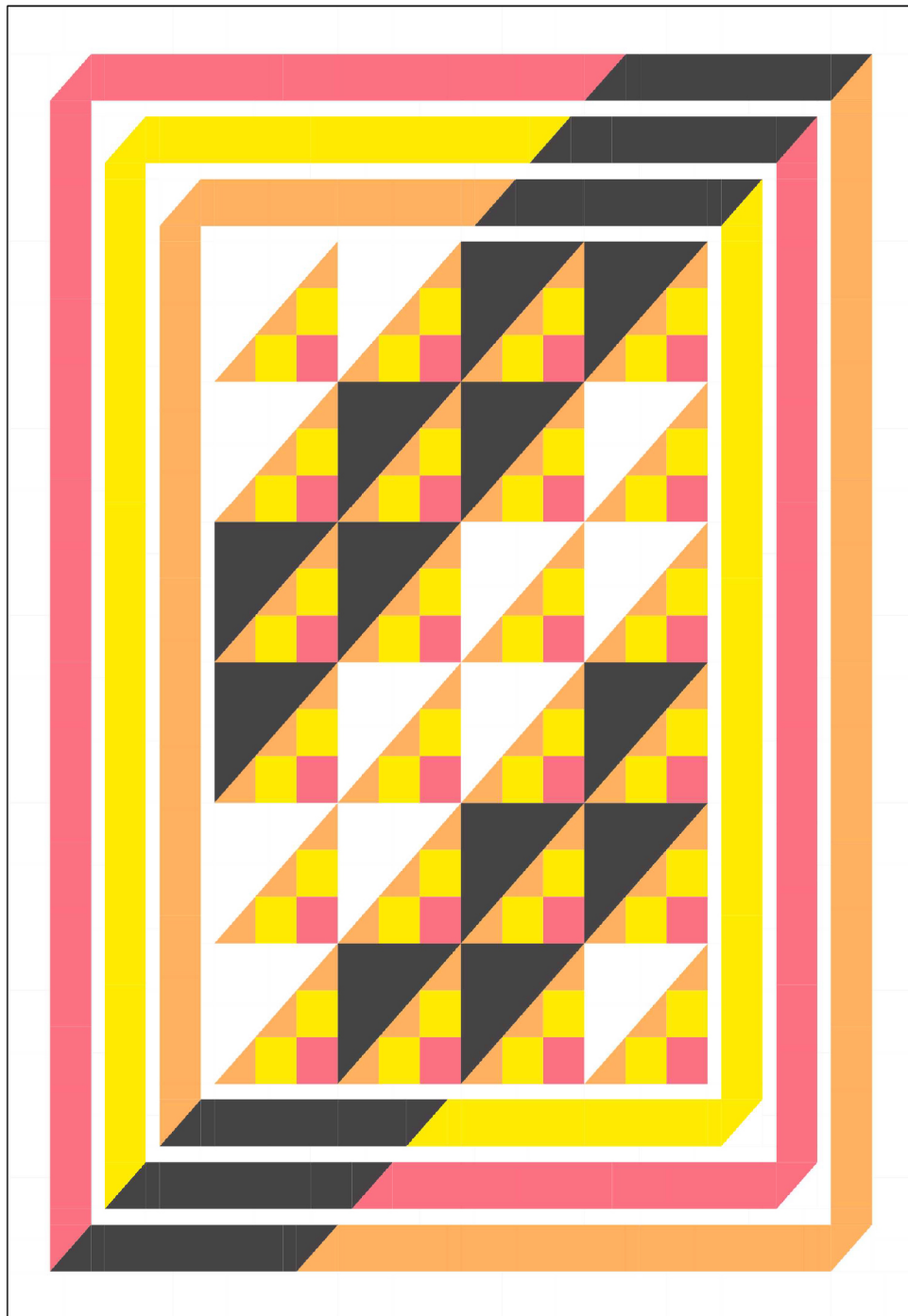

- All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- Press all seams open.

Oblique (Warm Version)

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Piecing Instructions: (Refer to block diagrams below for proper fabric placement)

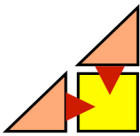
BLOCK 1:

1. Sew (1) **A** 3-7/8" HST to the top of (1) **C** 3-1/2" square, then sew (1) **A** 3-7/8" HST to the left side of **C** square to create **SECTION 1**.
2. Sew (1) **A** 3-7/8" HST to the left side of (1) **C** 3-1/2" square, then sew (1) **B** 3-1/2" square to the right side of **C** square to create **SECTION 2**.
3. Sew **SECTION 1** to the top of **SECTION 2**, then sew to (1) **E** 9-7/8" HST to create **BLOCK 1**. Square to 9-1/2", make (12).

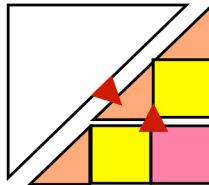
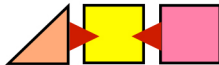
BLOCK 2:

4. Repeat steps (1) and (2). Sew **SECTION 1** to the top of **SECTION 2**, then sew to (1) **D** 9-7/8" HST to create **BLOCK 1**. Square to 9-1/2", make (12).

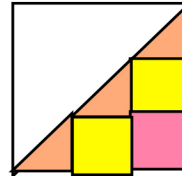

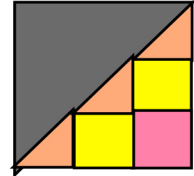

Assembly Instructions (Refer to quilt diagram for proper placement of blocks)

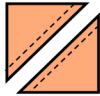
Quilt Assembly:

5. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

Border Assembly:

Border HST Units:

6. Draw diagonal line on wrong side of (1) 4" **A** square. Place right sides together with (1) 4" **E** square, then sew seam 1/4" on both sides of drawn line. Cut on drawn line, then press the (2) **AE** half square triangles (HST) open. Square to 3-1/2".
7. Repeat step 6 using the A, B, C, D and E 4" squares to create the number of HSTs indicated: **BE** (2), **CE** (2), **AD** (4), **BD** (4), and **CD** (4).

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Border #1

8. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 54-1/2"), cut (2) **E** 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 38-1/2") cut (2) **E** 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border #2

9. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 56-1/2"), cut (1) **A** 3-1/2" strip to fit and sew to left side then cut (1) **C** 3-1/2" strip to fit and sew to right side.
10. Sew together (1) **AE** HST, (1) **A** 3-1/2" X 20-1/2" strip, (1) **AD** HST, (1) **D** 3-1/2" X 15-1/2" strip, and (1) **CD** HST, then sew to top of quilt.
11. Sew together (1) **AD** HST, (1) **D** 3-1/2" X 15-1/2" strip, (1) **CD** HST, (1) **C** 3-1/2" X 20-1/2" strip, and (1) **CE** HST, then sew to bottom of quilt.

Border #3

12. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 62-1/2"), cut (2) **E** 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 46-1/2") cut (2) **E** 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border #4

13. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 64-1/2"), cut (1) **C** 3-1/2" strip to fit and sew to left side, then cut (1) **B** 3-1/2" strip to fit and sew to right side.
14. Sew together (1) **CE** HST, (1) **C** 3-1/2" X 28-1/2" strip, (1) **CD** HST, (1) **D** 3-1/2" X 15-1/2" strip, and (1) **BD** HST, then sew to top of quilt.
15. Sew together (1) **CD** HST, (1) **D** 3-1/2" X 15-1/2" strip, (1) **BD** HST, (1) **B** 3-1/2" X 28-1/2" strip, and (1) **BE** HST, then sew to bottom of quilt.

Border #5

16. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 70-1/2"), cut (2) **E** 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 54-1/2") cut (2) **E** 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border #6

17. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 72-1/2"), cut (1) **B** 3-1/2" strip to fit and sew to left side, then cut (1) **A** 3-1/2" strip to fit and sew to right side.
18. Sew together (1) **BE** HST, (1) **B** 3-1/2" X 36-1/2" strip, (1) **BD** HST, (1) **D** 3-1/2" X 15-1/2" strip, and (1) **AD** HST, then sew to top of quilt.
19. Sew together (1) **BD** HST, (1) **D** 3-1/2" X 15-1/2" strip, (1) **AD** HST, (1) **A** 3-1/2" X 36-1/2" strip, and (1) **AE** HST, then sew to bottom of quilt.

Border #7

20. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 78-1/2"), cut (2) **E** 3-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 66-1/2") cut (2) **E** 3-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!

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
