

Batting: 76" x 84"

General Instructions:

- A. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- B. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- C. Press all seams open.




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Piecing Instructions: (Refer to block diagrams below for proper fabric placement and rotation)

1. Draw diagonal line on the back of all \mathbf{J} 8-1/2" squares and \mathbf{H} 4-1/2" squares.


BLOCKS1A, 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E, 1F and 1G:

- 2. Place (1) **J** 8-1/2" square right sides together on left side of (1) **A** 8-1/2" X 12-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line, then press open. Trim excess fabric on back to ½".
- 3. Place (1) **H** 4-1/2" square right sides together on right bottom corner of (1) **A** 8-1/2" X 12-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line, then press open. Trim excess fabric on back to ½". Square to 8-1/2" X 12-1/2". Make (3).
- 4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 using B, C, D, E, F and G 8-1/2" X 12-1/2" rectangles. Make (3) each.



BLOCK 2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, 2E, 2F and 2G:

- 5. Place (1) **J** 8-1/2" square right sides together on left side of (1) **A** 8-1/2" X 12-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line, then press open. Trim excess fabric on back to $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- 6. Place (1) **H** 4-1/2" square right sides together on right top corner of (1) **A** 8-1/2" X 12-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line, then press open. Trim excess fabric on back to ½". Square to 8-1/2" X 12-1/2". Make (3).
- 7. Repeat steps 2 and 3 using B, C, D, E, F and G 8-1/2" X 12-1/2" rectangles. Make (2) each.

BLOCKS 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D, 3E, 3F and 3G:

- 8. Sew (1) **H** 2-1/2" X 8-1/2" rectangle to (1) **A** 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" rectangle to make **BLOCK 3A**. Square to 2-1/2" X 12-1/2", make (5).
- 9. Repeat step 8 using **B**, **C**, **D**, **E**, **F**, and **G** 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" rectangles. Make (5) each.



Assembly Instructions (Refer to quilt diagram for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

Quilt Assembly:

10. Following chart below, sew blocks into vertical rows, then sew rows together.

Border Assembly:

Border #1

11. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 72-1/2"), cut (2) **H** 2-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt.

Border #2

12. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 72-1/2"), cut (2) \ \ 2-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 68-1/2") cut (2) **J** 2-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
