Be sure to read the entire pattern before you begin.





A		53609-1 Tan	1-1/3	PATCH BLOCKS: (1) 15-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 5-1/2" x 15-1/2" and (1) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles. OUTER BORDER: (6) 4" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 4" x 53-1/2" and (2) 4" x 46-1/2" strips.
B		53611-6 Matcha	5/8	PATCH BLOCKS: (1) 15-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 5-1/2" x 15-1/2" and (2) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
C		53610-2 Dusty Pink	1/4	PATCH BLOCKS: (1) 5-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 5-1/2" x 15-1/2" and (1) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
D		53611-3 Ivory	5/8	INNER BORDER 3: (4) 4-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 41-1/2" and (2) 4-1/2" x 35-1/2" strips.
E		31835S White	7/8	SASHING: (4) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 23-1/2", (3) 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" and (6) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips. INNER BORDER 1: (4) 1-3/4" x WOF strips; subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 37-1/2" and (2) 1-3/4" x 26" strips. INNER BORDER 5: (5) 1-3/4" x WOF strips; subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 39-1/2" strips from (2) WOF strips; piece remaining (3) WOF strips and subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 51" strips.

F		53613-1 Tan	1/2	INNER BORDER 2: (4) 1-1/4" x WOF strips; subcut (2) 1-1/4" x 40" and (2) 1-1/4" x 27-1/2" strips. INNER BORDER 4: (5) 1-1/4" x WOF strips; subcut (2) 1-1/4" x 37" strips from (2) WOF strips; piece remaining (3) WOF strips and subcut (2) 1-1/4" x 49-1/2" strips.
G		53607-10 Sage FOR BINDING	1/2	BINDING: (6) 2-1/4" x WOF strips.
		Backing	3-7/8	56" x 72" piece of batting.

Quilt Center Assembly

- Pieced Rows 1 & 3:** Arrange and sew together (2) **A** 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles, (1) **B** 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle, (1) **C** 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle, and (3) **E** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" sashing rectangles to make a pieced row. Make (2) pieced rows.



MAKE (2) FOR PIECED ROWS 1 and 3

- Pieced Row 2:** Arrange and sew together (2) **B** 5-1/2" x 15-1/2" rectangle, (1) **A** 5-1/2" x 15-1/2" rectangle, (1) **C** 5-1/2" x 15-1/2" rectangle, and (3) **E** 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" sashing rectangles to make a pieced row.



MAKE (1) FOR PIECED ROW 2

3. Sew together pieced rows and (2) **E** 1-1/2" x 23-1/2" sashing strips to complete quilt center.



Quilt Top Assembly

Refer to Quilt Assembly Diagram on Page 4 for the following instructions.

4. Inner Border 1: Sew (2) **E** 1-3/4" x 37-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **E** 1-3/4" x 26" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
5. Inner Border 2: Sew (2) **F** 1-1/4" x 40" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **F** 1-1/4" x 27-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
6. Inner Border 3: Sew (2) **D** 4-1/2" x 41-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **D** 4-1/2" x 35-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
7. Inner Border 4: Sew (2) **F** 1-1/4" x 49-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **F** 1-1/4" x 37" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
8. Inner Border 5: Sew (2) **E** 1-3/4" x 51" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **E** 1-3/4" x 39-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
9. Outer Border: Sew (2) **A** 4" x 53-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **A** 4" x 46-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

QUILT ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **G** 2-1/4" strips.
