Subcut $2\left(111 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 111 / 8^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares. <br> Cut squres diagonally twice to yield 8 side setting triangles. |

Subcut $36\left(11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares. <br> Inner border \#2 <br> $6\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}\right)$. Piece strips and subcut $2\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 541 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ and 2 <br> ( $2^{\prime \prime} \times 611 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strips. |

Subcut $148\left(1^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}\right)$ rectangles. <br> 5 (3 1/2" $\times 42^{\prime \prime}$ ). Subcut 74 ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) rectangles. <br> From remaining fabric, 74 orange peel applique pieces using template provided and applique method of choice. |

Subcut $44\left(1^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares and $4\left(1^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}\right)$ rectangles. <br> 2 ( $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ ). Subcut $22\left(21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ rectangles. <br> From remaining fabric, 22 orange peel applique pieces using template provided and applique method of choice. |

Subcut $28\left(1^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}\right)$ rectanges. <br> 1 (3 1/2" $\times 42^{\prime \prime}$ ). Subcut 14 ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) rectangles. <br> From remaining fabric, 14 orange peel applique pieces using template provided and applique method of choice. |

Subcut 8 (2 1/2" $\times 3$ 1/2") rectangles. <br> 7 (2 1/2" $\times 42^{\prime \prime}$ ). Piece strips and subcut 2 ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 58$ <br> $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) and $2\left(21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips. <br> From remaining fabric, 8 orange peel applique pieces using template provided and applique method of choice. |

Subcut 12 ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) rectangles. From remaining fabric, 12 orange peel applique peices using template provided and applique method of choice. |

Subcut $2\left(111 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 111 / 8^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 8 side setting triangles. Will only use 6 . |

Piece strips and subcut $2\left(11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51\right.$ <br> $\left.1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ and $2\left(11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 591 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips. |

## Constructing Block (using A block as example)

1. Block quadrant. Sew 1 ( $1^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{\prime \prime}$ ) A square and 1 ( $1^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ ) I rectangle together to make a row. Repeat to make 2 rows. Sew these rows to either side of 1 (2 1/2" x 3 1/2") A square.


Arrange an $\mathbf{A}$ orange peel applique piece on pieced quadrant, making sure the points of the orange peel touch the diagonal points of $\mathbf{A}$ squares. Sew the orange peel piece in place using your applique method of choice, as shown, to complete 1 block quadrant.


Repeat to make 2 quadrants, and 2 quadrants in reversed fabric placement.

2. Arrange and sew block quadrants together to complete 1 block.


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3. Repeat to make a total number of blocks in the following colorway (ID by letters for clear quilt center assembly later).

7 blocks
D / K (Assembly Letter A)


5 blocks
B / I (Assembly Letter D)


6 blocks
A / M (Assembly Letter G)


5 blocks
C / I (Assembly Letter B)


5 blocks
A / I (Assembly Letter E)


4 Blocks

J / I (Assembly Letter C)


3 blocks
E / I (Assembly Letter F)


4 Blocks

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## Quilt Center Assembly

1. Pieced diagonal rows. Arrange and sew pieced blocks, ( $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) sashing rectangles (SR), and side setting triangles into rows, starting from top left corner.

Row 1: E triangle - SR - Block E-SR - N triangle
Row 2: $\mathbf{G}$ triangle - SR - Block C - SR - Block H -SR - Block D - SR - G triangle
Row 3: $\mathbf{N}$ triangle - SR - Block H-SR - Block A - SR - Block I - SR - Block G - SR - Block C - SR - G triangle
Row 4: G triangle - SR - Block B - SR - Block G - SR - Block C - SR - Block E - SR - Block F - SR - Block C - SR Block B -SR - $\mathbf{N}$ triangle
Row 5: E triangle - SR - Block A - SR - Block E - SR - Block C - SR - Block H - SR - Block B - SR - Block A - SR Block G - SR - Block D - SR - Block A - SR - corner triangle

2. Refer to quilt center diagram, arrange and sew together sashing rectangles and sashing cornerstones to make pieced sashing rows.

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3. Sew pieced diagonal rows and pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center. At this point, some of the pieces will be "sticking out". Trim around quilt center to include 1/4" seam allowance. At this point, the quilt center should measure approximately $491 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 591 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ raw edge to raw edge.


## Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner border \#1. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 59 1/2") O strips to the opposite long sides of the quilt center. Sew 2 ( $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 511 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) $\mathbf{O}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of the quilt center.
2. Inner border \#2. Sew 2 ( $2^{\prime \prime} \times 62^{\prime \prime}$ ) H strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (2" x 54$\left.1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right) \mathbf{H}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
3. Outer border. Sew 2 ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) L strips to the opposite long sides of the quilt center. Sew 2 ( 2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 581 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) $\mathbf{O}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete the quilt top.

## Quilting Instructions:

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
