

3/4 yard - 50688-1 Ocean

³/₄ yard – 37098-58 Poppyseed

⅓ yard – 50689-2 Earth

1/4 yard - 50691-1 Ocean

3/8 yard - 50690-X Multi

1 % yards – 50693-3 Sand

1 ½ yards – 50693-1 Ocean

1 ½ yards – 50689-3 Sand

5 yards - 50691-3 Sand

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A: Map - Ocean

• Cut one 37 ½" x 19 ½" strip.

Fabric B: Solid – Poppyseed

- \bullet Cut one 3" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 3" x 19 ½" strips.
- Cut three 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 3" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut one 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 2 ½" x 3 ½" strips, four 2 ½" x 5 ½" strips and two 2 ½" squares.
- \bullet Cut two 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- \bullet Cut one 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

Fabric C: Travel Accessories – Earth

- Cut one 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut one 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 12 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

Fabric D: Visas – Ocean

• Cut one 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into six 6 ½" squares.



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Cutting Instructions - Continued:

Fabric E: Passports – Multi

• Cut one 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strips into four 8 ½" squares.

Fabric F: Compass - Sand

- Cut two 1 ¼" x 23" WOF strips.
- Cut three 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and two 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and two 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut one 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3" x 3 ½" strips.
- Cut one 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- Cut two 3 ½" x 24 ½" WOF strips.
- Cut one 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- Cut two 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- Cut two 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 4 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric G: Compass – Ocean

- Cut one 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 2" x 8 ½" strips.
- Cut six 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut four 2" x 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut seven 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric H: Travel Accessories - Sand

• Cut three 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching the pattern, and cut two 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Backing: Vistas – Sand

• Cut two 87" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 69" x 87" for the pieced back.




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
Block Assembly:

Note: The arrows used in the figures represent the direction of the fabric.

- 1. Sew one 3" x 19 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of one 37 ½" x 19 ½" Fabric A strip. Sew one 3" x 42 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make one Unit 1 strip (Fig. 1). Trim block to measure 23" x 41".
- 2. Sew one 1 ¼" x 23" Fabric F strip to each side of the Unit 1 strip. Sew one 1 ¼" x 42 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 strip to make the Center Block (Fig. 2).



3. Sew one 2" x 8 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of one 58 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric H strip. Sew one 2" x 61 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric H strip to make one Block One strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block One strip.



- 4. Sew one 1 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric F strip to the left side of one 2 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric B strip to make one Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make four Unit 1 strips total.
- 5. Sew one 2 ½" Fabric B square to the lower right side of one Unit 1 strip. Start at the bottom end of the seam, but **DO NOT** sew the seam entirely closed, stopping half-way to make one Unit 2 (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Unit 2.





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- 6. Sew one 3 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric F strip to the bottom of one Unit 2 to make one Unit 3 (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Unit 3.
- 7. Sew one Unit 1 strip to the right side of one Unit 3 to make one Unit 4 (Fig. 7). Pay attention to the orientation of the Unit 1 strip. Repeat to make a second Unit 4.
- 8. Sew one 3 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric F strip to one Unit 4. Complete the seam from Step 5 to make one Unit 5 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Unit 5 square.
- 9. Sew one 8 ½" Fabric E square to the top and to the bottom of one Unit 5 square to make one Block Two strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second Block Two strip.
- 10. Sew one 3" x 3 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of one 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric B strip to make one FBF strip. Repeat to make a four FBF strips total. Sew one FBF strip to the bottom of one 12 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric C strip to make one Block Three strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Block Three strip.
- 11. Sew one FBF strip to the top of one 12 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric C strip to make one Block Four strip (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Block Four strip.





- 12. Sew one 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of one 6 ½" Fabric D square to make one Unit 6 strip (Fig. 12). Repeat to make a second Unit 6 strip.
- 13. Sew one 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip to the top of one Unit 6 strip. Sew one 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to the top of the 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip. Sew one 3 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip to the top of the 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to make one Unit 7 strip (Fig. 13).




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- 15. Sew one 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip to the bottom of one Unit 6 strip. Sew one 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to the bottom of the 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip. Sew one 3 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip to the bottom of the 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to make one Unit 8 strip (Fig. 15).
- 16. Sew one 12 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of one Unit 8 strip. Sew one 3 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric F strip to the top of the Unit 8 strip to make one Block Six strip (Fig. 16).










- 17. Sew one 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of one 6 ½" Fabric D square. Sew one 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric F strip to the top of the Fabric D square to make one Unit 9 strip (Fig. 17). Repeat to make four Unit 9 strips total.
- 18. Sew one 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip to bottom of one 4 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric F strip to make one FB strip. Sew the FB strip to the left side of one 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip. Sew one 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip to the top of one 4 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric F strip to make one BF strip. Sew the BF strip to the right of the 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to make one Unit 10 strip (Fig. 18). Repeat to make a second Unit 10 strip.
- 19. Sew one 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip to top of one 4 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric F strip to make one BF strip. Sew the BF strip to the left side of one 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip. Sew one 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip to the bottom of one 4 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric F strip to make one FB strip. Sew the FB strip to the right side of the 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to make one Unit 11 strip (Fig. 19). Repeat to make a second Unit 11 strip.










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- 20. Sew one Unit 10 strip to the top of one Unit 9 strip to make one Block Seven strip (Fig. 20). Repeat to make a second Block Seven strip.
- 21. Sew one Unit 11 strip to the top of one Unit 9 strip to make one Block Eight strip (Fig. 21). Repeat to make Block Eight strip.




Quilt Assembly – Refer to the Quilt Layout below while assembling the quilt top:

- 22. Sew one Block Two strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 23. Sew together two Block Three strips, one Block Seven strip, one Block Five strip and one Block Eight strip. Sew the resulting strip to the top of the Center Block.
- 24. Sew together two Block Four strips, one Block Eight strip, one Block Six strip and one Block Seven strip. Sew the resulting strip to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 25. Sew one 2" x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 2" x 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 26. Sew one Block One strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 27. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 28. Sew the seven 2 ½" x WOF Fabric G strips together end-to-end with 45-degree seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 29. Bind as desired.
