## PINEAPPLE BLOCK

1. Half-Square Triangle (HST): Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) I $3^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place I square, right sides together, on (1) F 3" square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on both sides of the drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Square measures 2-1/2".

2. Sew together (1) QST each of $\mathbf{F}$ and $\mathbf{H}$ and (1) $\mathbf{A}$ HST. Position the intersection of fabrics at $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and trim unit to $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make (1) A-F-H unit and (1) A-F-H unit reversed.

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3. Sew together units made in Steps 1-2 (note rotation). Make a mirror-image unit, and sew units together. Unit measures 4-1/2" square.

4. Corner Triangles: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) I 1-1/2" square. Place I square, RST, at a corner of (1) H 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal I corner triangle. Repeat with another I square at the opposite corner of the same $\mathbf{H}$ rectangle, as shown. Make (1) $\mathbf{H} / \mathbf{I}$ unit and (1) $\mathbf{H} / \mathbf{I}$ unit in reverse.


Draw diagonal line on wrong side of I square.


Open and press to reveal I corner triangle.

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5. Add (1) $\mathbf{I} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to the top of the $\mathbf{H} / \mathbf{I}$ unit. Repeat to make a mirror-image unit.
6. Pineapple Top: Sew Step 5 units to the left and right sides of unit made in Step 3, as shown. Make (33). Unit measures 4-1/2" x 6-1/2".

7. Similar to Step 4, create corner triangles using (2) marked I $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (1) $\mathbf{K} 6$ - $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Place squares, RST, at the top left and right corners of the $\mathbf{K}$ rectangles, as shown. Repeat sewing (2) I 1-1/2" squares at the bottom left and right corners of the same $\mathbf{K}$ rectangle. Unit measures 6-1/2" $\times 8$-1/2".
8. Sew together units made in Steps 6 and 7 to complete (1) Pineapple Block, measuring $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make (4).


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9. Make a total of number of Pineapple Blocks using the following fabrics:


## QUILT ASSEMBLY

REFER TO QUILT DIAGRAM ON PAGE 6 FOR PROPER PLACEMENT OF BLOCKS AND ROWS
10. Arrange and sew together Pineapple Blocks, using I $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2, I 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and I 5-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips as follows:

Row 1, 3, 5: (7) Pineapple Blocks, (6) I 2-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (INNER) and (2) I 1-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (ENDS)
Row 2, 4: (6) Pineapple Blocks, (5) I 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" (INNER) and (2) I 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" (ENDS)

11. Sew together pieced rows and (4) I $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips to complete quilt center.
12. OUTER BORDER: Sew (2) $\boldsymbol{I} 3^{\prime \prime} \times 68-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) I $3^{\prime \prime} \times 61-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

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QUILT DIAGRAM


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using D 2-1/4" strips.
