A		3648Q-X Coral Reef	3/8	(5) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (20) 2" x 8" rectangles for paper piecing section 5 and (4) 2" squares.
B		3649Q-X Coral Reef	3/8	(3) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (16) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for paper piecing section 3. 5 Flower templates.
C		3650Q-X Orange	1/3	(4) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (20) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for paper piecing section 3.
D		3651Q-X Peach	1/3	(1) 4" x WOF strip; subcut (8) 4" squares. Cut squares in half diagonally once to make (16) 4" triangles for paper piecing section 6. (1) 1-3/4" x WOF strip, subcut (4) 1-3/4" x 6-1/2" strips.
E		3652Q-X Peach	3/8	(2) 3-1/2" squares; cut in half diagonally once to make (4) triangles. (3) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (20) 2" x 5-1/4" rectangles for paper piecing section 1.
F		3653Q-X Yellow	1/4	(4) Pineapple templates. (5) Flower center templates, centered over yellow areas.
G		3656Q-X Green	1/4	(3) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (16) 2" x 5-1/4" rectangles for paper piecing section 1.
H		3657Q-X Sea Green	1/4	(20) Leaf templates. (4) Pineapple Leaf templates.
I		3658Q-X Dazzle	3/8	(2) 3-1/2" squares; cut in half diagonally once to make (4) triangles. (3) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (16) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for paper piecing section 4.

K		3660Q-X Blue	1-1/8	(5) 4" x WOF strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (4) 4" x 43-1/2" borders (1) 4" x WOF strip; subcut (10) 4" squares. Cut squares in half diagonally to make triangles for paper piecing section 6. (4) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (16) 2" x 8" strips for paper piecing section 5.
L		100Q-1407 Yolk	5/8	(4) 2" x 40-1/2" borders. (3) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (20) 2" x 5-1/4" rectangles for paper piecing section 2. (4) 1-3/4" x 6-1/2" rectangles. (1) 1-3/4" x WOF strip; (4) 1-3/4" x 6-1/2" rectangles.

N		100Q-1444 Melon	1/4	(3) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (16) 2" x 5-1/4" rectangles for paper piecing section 2.
O		100Q-2048 Persian Blue	7/8	(8) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips, (4) 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips and (6) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips. <b>FOR BINDING:</b> (5) 2-1/4" x WOF strips; sew short ends together.

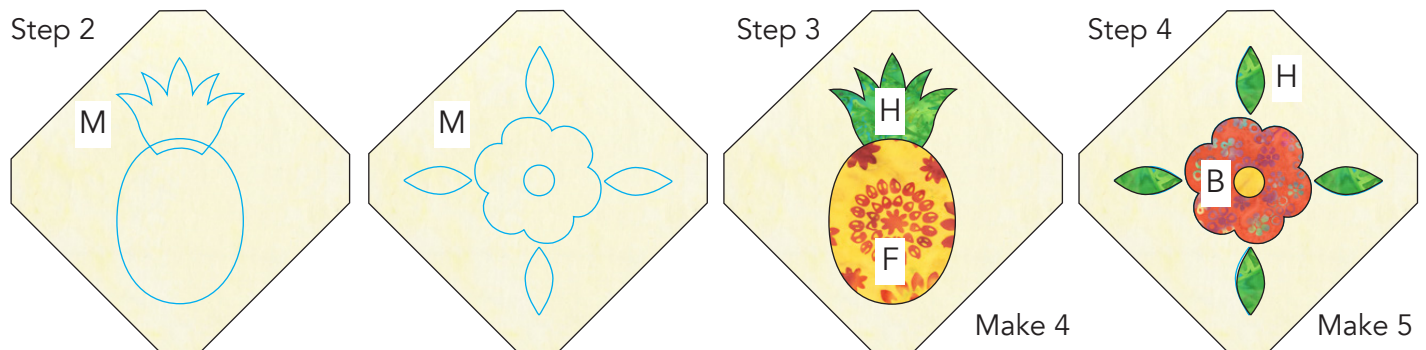

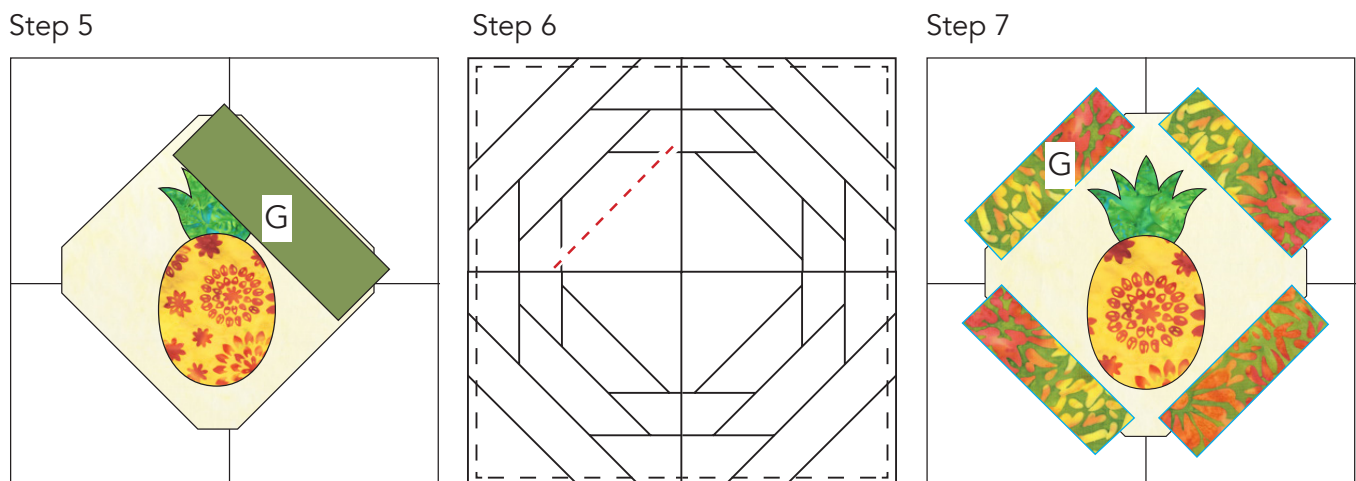
# Pineapple Punch

## BLOCKASSEMBLY

1. Using your favorite appliqué method, prepare the appliqué pieces.
2. Trace the pineapple pattern to the center of (4) **M** block centers. Trace the Flower pattern to the center of (5) **M** block centers.
3. Place (1) **F** Pineapple and (1) **H** Pineapple Leaves on (1) **M** pineapple block center, so Pineapple overlaps the lower edge of Leaves. Sew along the edges of the pieces using matching thread. Make 4.
4. Place (1) **B** Flower and (4) **H** leaves on (1) **M** flower block center. Sew along the edge of the pieces using matching thread. Center (1) **F** Circle on the Flower. Sew along the edge of the Circle. Make 5.



5. Place the Pineapple block centered on the assembled paper piecing template. Pin in place. Place (1) **G** 2" x 5-1/4" strip along the diagonal edge of the Pineapple block and pin in place if necessary.
6. Flip the pattern over and stitch along the line. Stitching is shown in red.
7. Fold the **G** strip over section 1. Repeat on (3) remaining diagonal edges of the Pineapple block center.

8. Continue paper piecing sections 2-6 using (4) **N** 2" x 5-1/4" strips, (4) **B** 2" x 6-1/2" strips, (4) **I** 2" x 6-1/2" strips and (4) **K** 2" x 8" strips and (4) **D** 4" triangles as shown to complete block 1. Trim seam allowances to approximately 1/4" after joining the next strip. Trim the fabric even with the outer edge of the paper pattern to complete the pineapple block. Make 4.

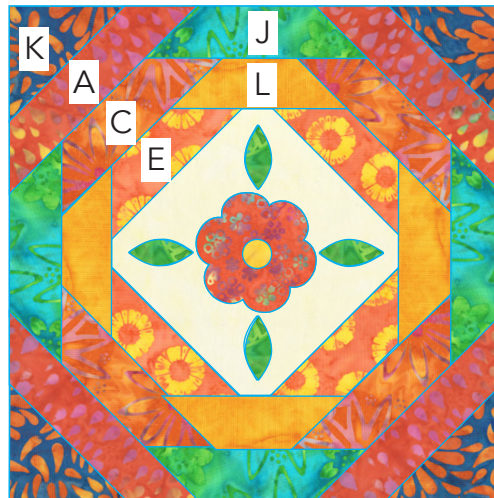
9. Following steps 5-8, paper piece flower blocks, using (4) **E** 2" x 5-1/4" strips, (4) **L** (4) 2" x 5-1/4" strips, (4) **C** 2" x 6-1/2" strips, (4) **J** 2" x 6-1/2" strips, and (4) **A** 2" x 8" strips, and (4) **K** 4" triangles. Make 5

10. **BORDER BLOCKS:** Paper piece Border Blocks using (1) **I** 3-1/2" triangle, (1) **D** 1-3/4" x 6-1/2" strip, (1) **L** 1-3/4" x 6-1/2" strip and (1) **E** 3-1/2" triangle. Make 4 border blocks.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

11. Following the Quilt Layout on page 5, arrange (4) pineapple blocks and (5) flower blocks in (3) rows of (3) blocks each.

12. Sew together (3) blocks alternating with (2) **O** 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips to make the block rows.

13. Sew together (3) block rows alternating with (2) **O** 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips.

14. Sew (2) **O** 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew (2) **O** 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

15. Sew (1) **L** 2" x 40-1/2" borders to each side of the quilt. Sew (2) **A** 2" squares to the ends of (2) **L** 2" x 40-1/2" borders. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

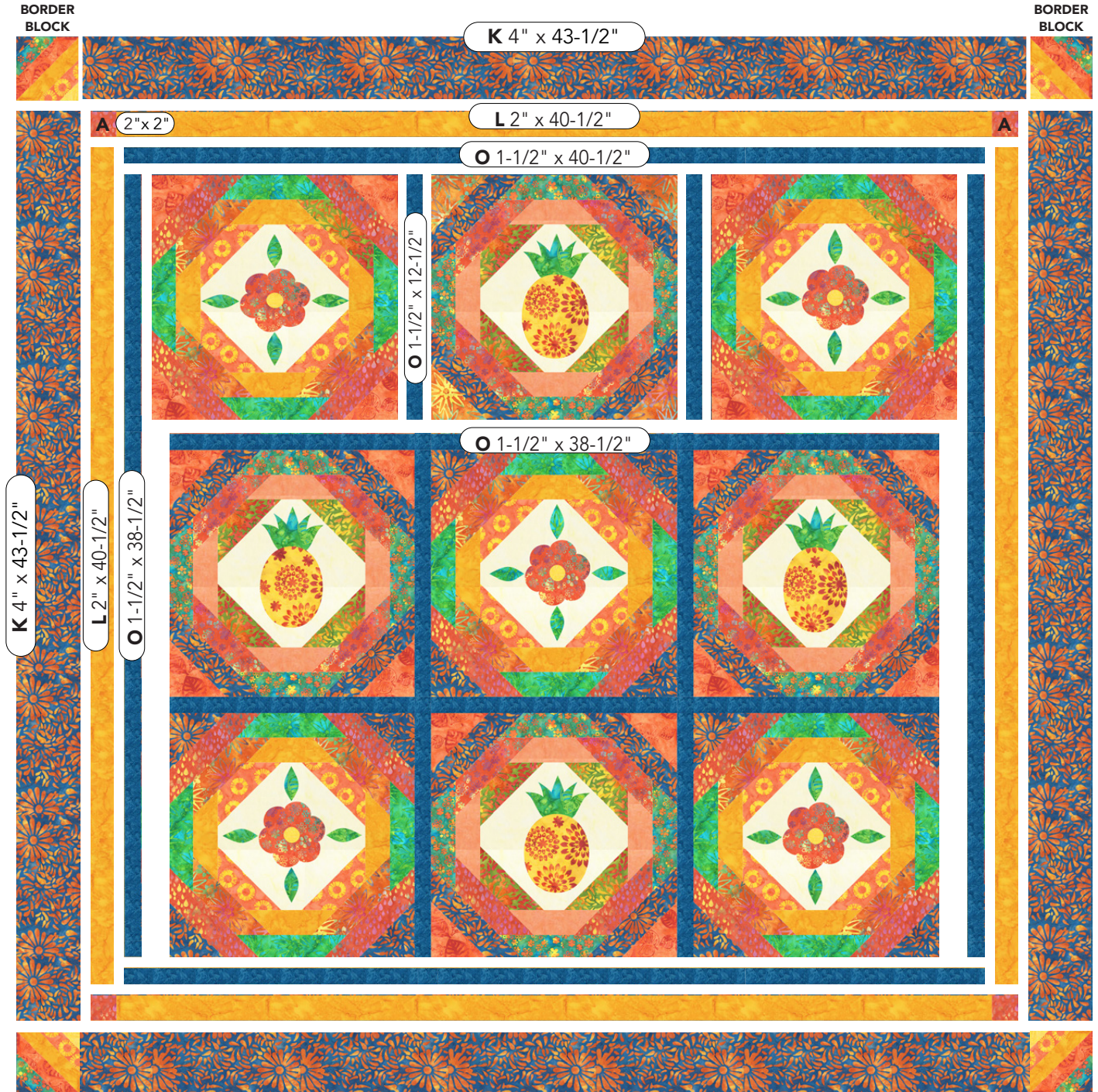
17. Sew (1) **K** 4" x 43-1/2" borders to the sides of the quilt. Sew (2) border blocks to the ends of (2) **K** 4" x 43-1/2" borders. Note orientation of the corner squares. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

## QUILT LAYOUT

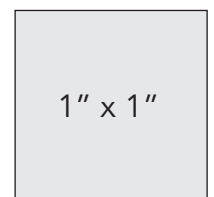
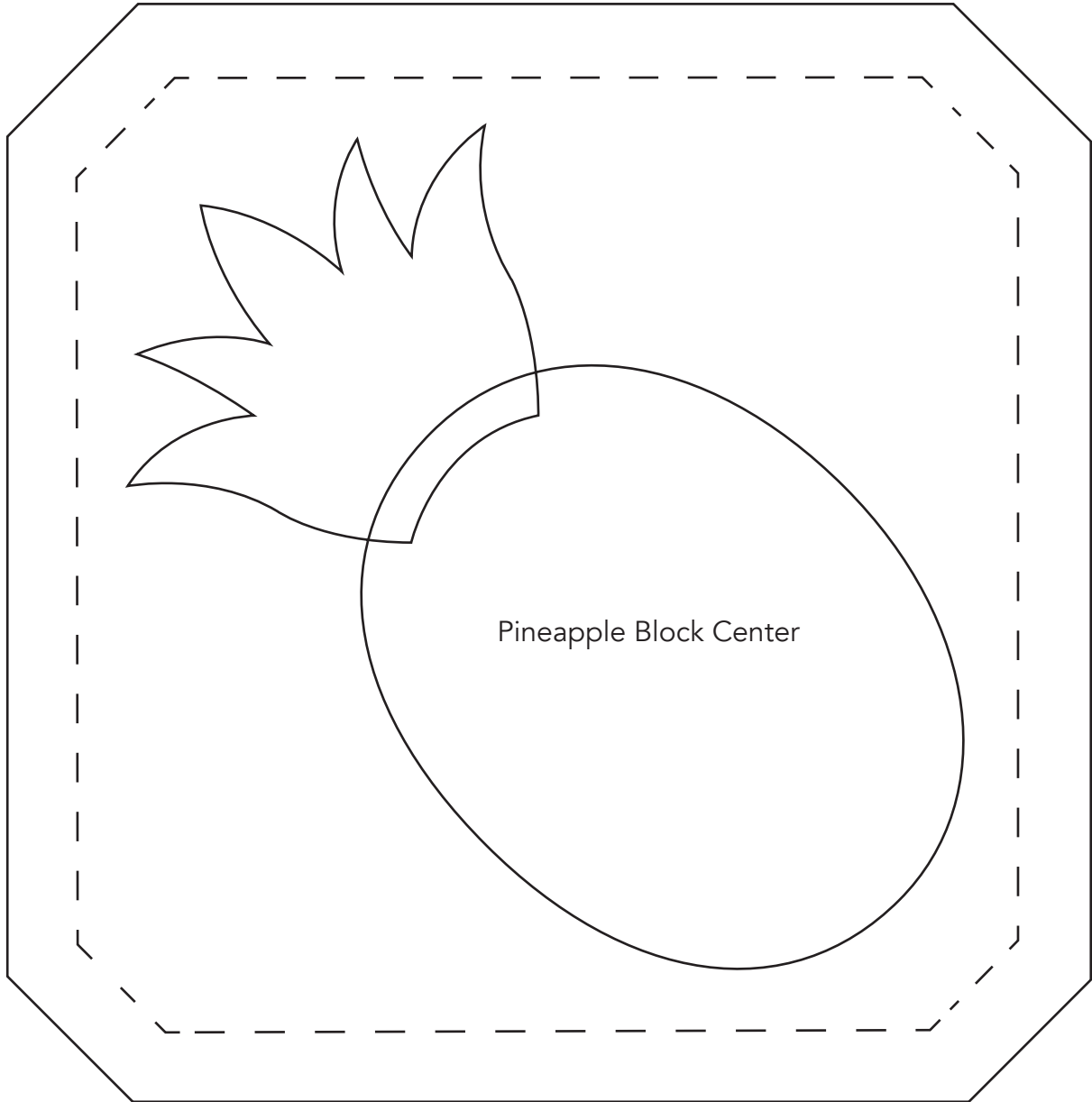


**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **O** 2-1/4" strips.

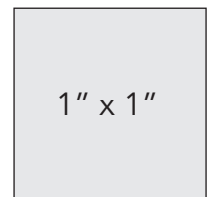
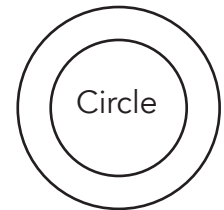
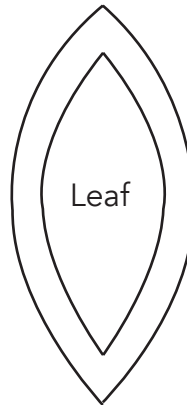
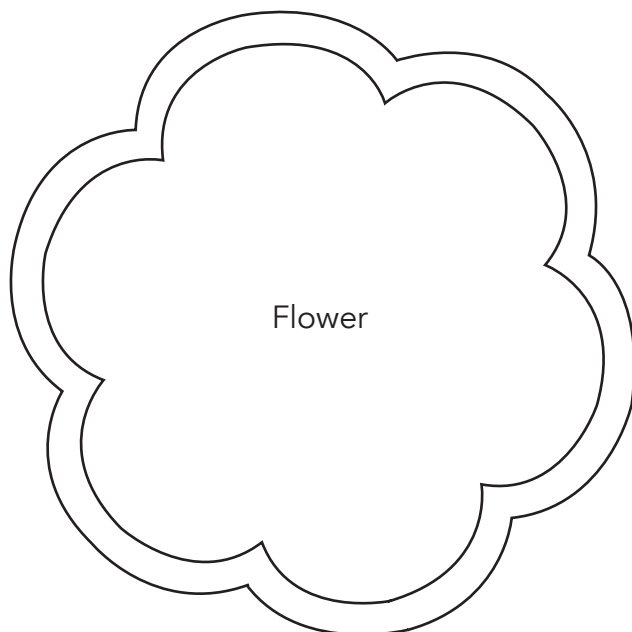
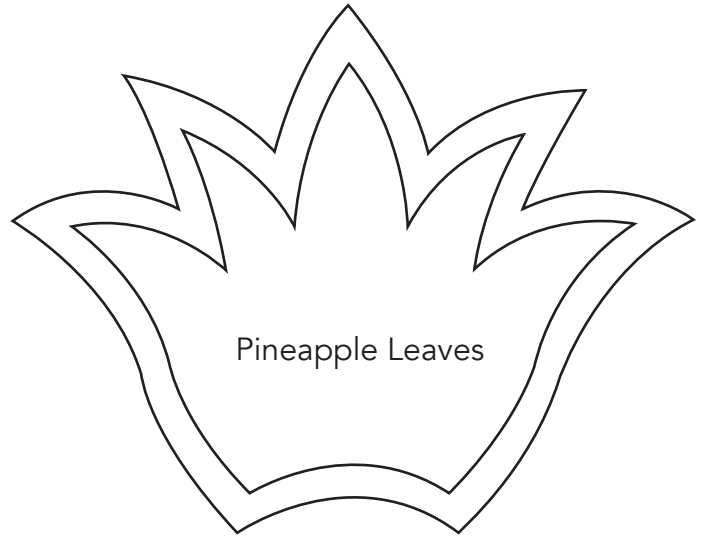
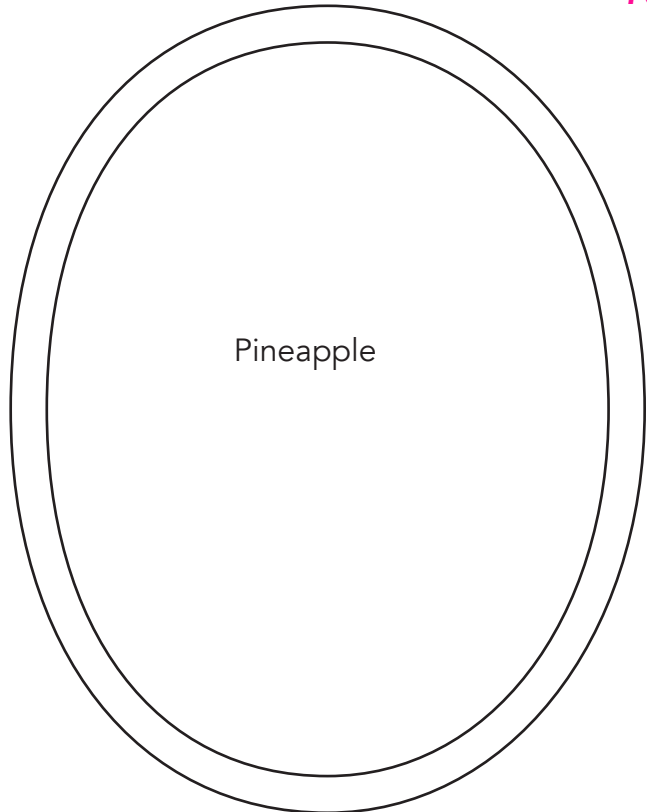


# Pineapple Punch

TEMPLATE

**For turned edge appliqué,** trace along the outer line to cut fabric. Trace along the inner line to make paper templates.

**For raw edge appliqué,** trace along the inner line.

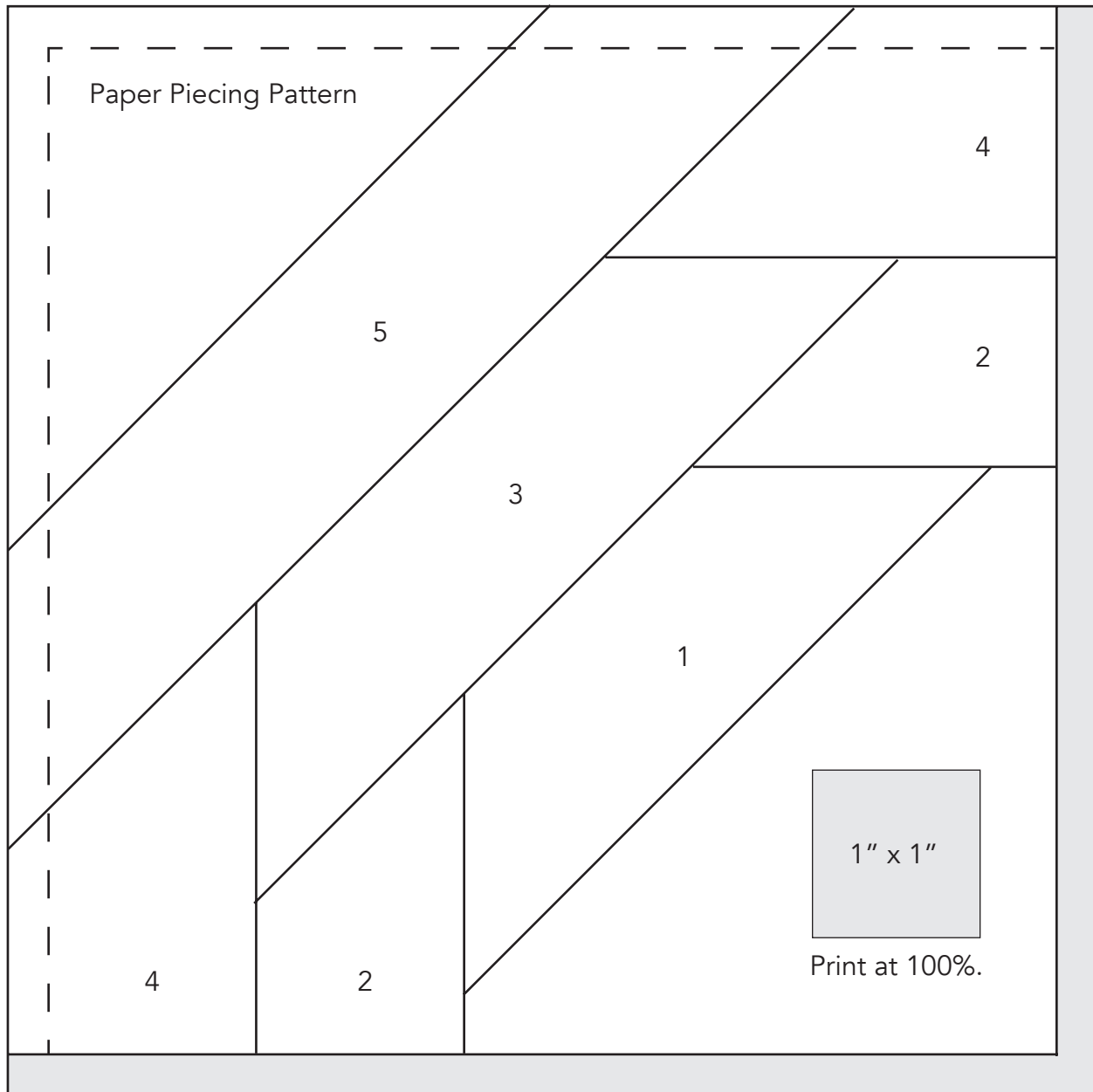

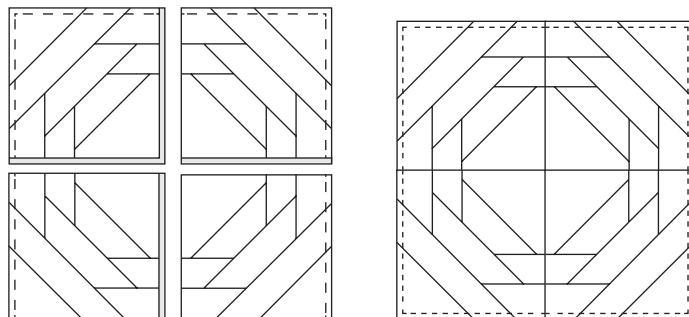
## PAPER PIECING PATTERN ASSEMBLY

Make 36 copies of the pattern.

Trim the shaded areas of 4 patterns as shown. Overlap the lower edge of the upper pattern with the top edge of the lower pattern matching the lines. Glue the pieces together.

Lap the right half over the shaded area of the left half matching the lines.

Make 9.

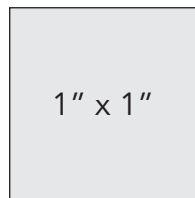
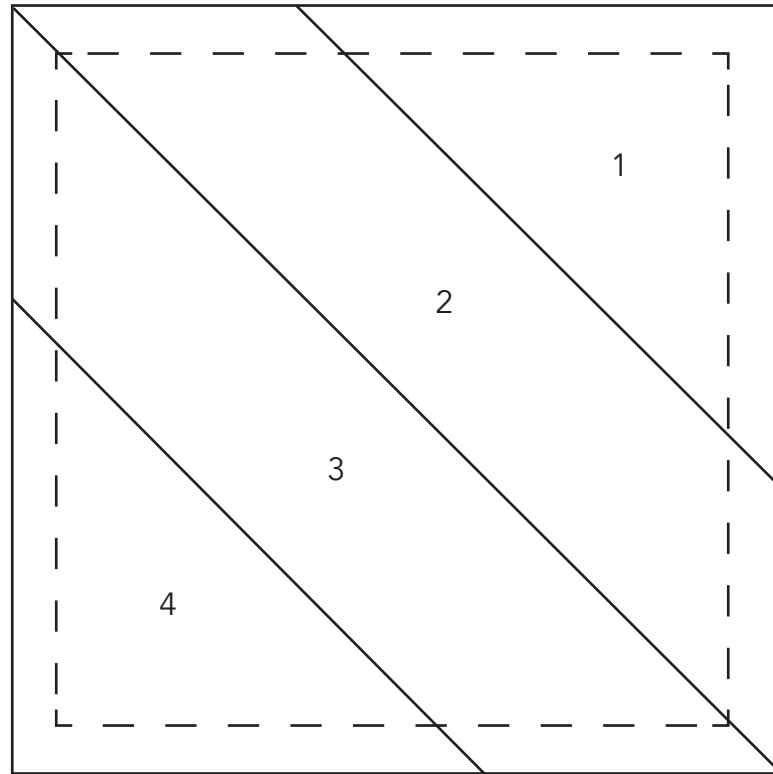
