J		BC11Q-X Morning Melody	1/4	 (4) 1-1/2"x WOF strips; subcut (6) 1-1/2" x 13" strips and (6) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips. (6) Flower Center templates.
к		BC28Q-X Purple	3/8	 (5) 2" x WOF strips, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 2" x 50-3/4" borders and (2) 2" x 39-3/4" borders. Trim ends diagonally.
L		BC33Q-X	7/8	 (2) 1-3/4" x WOF strip; subcut (36) 1-3/4" squares. (1) 2-1/4" x WOF strip; subcut (12) 2-1/4" squares for paper piecing. (12) Background 1 Templates. (12) Background 2 Templates.




For turned under edge appliqué: freezer paper or other template paper. For raw edge appliqué: paper backed fusible webbing.

FLOWER BLOCKS

1. Place (1) L 2-1/4" square right side down and center the paper piecing pattern with printed side facing up. Fold paper back on diagonal line and draw a line along the fold. Trim L fabric to 1/4" past line.

2. Place (1) **B** 1-1/4" x 2-1/4" rectangle right side down on **L** 2-1/4" trimmed square, aligning raw edges. Flip over and sew along the diagonal line on paper side, sewing through the paper.





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3. Fold the **B** rectangle open. Trim the fabric along the edges of the paper template to make (1) **B/L** square unit measuring 1-3/4" square. Carefully remove the paper pattern. Make 1.

4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) B/L square as shown. Also, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (3) L 1-3/4" squares.

Step 5

5. Place (1) **B/L** square unit on the corner of (1) **G** 3-1/2" square. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4" as indicated by the solid line. Fold the **B/L** square unit open to make **G/B/L** square unit.

6. Following step 5, sew (1) marked **L** 1-3/4" square to one corner of (1) **G** 3-1/2" square to make **G/L** square unit. Make 3.

7. Sew (1) **G/B/L** and (1) **G/L** square units together. Note proper rotation and placement of units. Sew (2) **G/L** square units together. Note proper rotation and placement of units. Make 1 each pair.

8. Sew square unit pairs together to make a petal unit measuring 6-1/2" square including seam allowance. Make 1, set aside.


9. Sew (1) **L** Background 1 template and (1) **L** Background 2 template to sides of (1) **B** Stem template to make stem unit.

10. Sew (1) **D** Grass template to stem unit to make lower flower unit measuring 6-1/2"x 7" including seam allowance. Make 1.






11. Prepare (1) **B** Leaf and (1) **J** Flower Center appliqués using your favorite appliqué method. Sew Flower Center to petal square unit. Apply Leaf to lower flower unit template. Make 1 of each.



12. Flower Unit: Sew (1) petal unit to (1) lower flower unit, should measure 6-1/2" x 13" unfinished.

13. G Flower Block: Sew (1) I 1-1/2" x 13" long strip to side of flower unit. Sew (1) I 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" short strip to bottom of flower unit. Block should measure 7-1/2" x 14" including seam allowance.

14. F Flower Block: Similar to **G** Flower Block assembly, make (6) **F** Flower Blocks as shown in diagram. Use **C** 1-1/4" x 2-1/4" rectangles in steps 1-4 and **C** Stem template in step 9.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

15. Following the quilt diagram on page 5, arrange flower blocks in 3 rows of 4 blocks each. Sew together (5) $H 2'' \times 14''$ strips alternating with (4) blocks to make the block rows. Make 3.

16. Sew together (5) **B** 2" squares alternating with (4) **H** 2" \times 7-1/2" strips to make the sashing rows. Make 4.

17. Sew together (4) sashing rows and alternating with (3) block rows.

18. Sew (1) K 2"x 50-3/4" border to each side of the quilt beginning and ending 1/4" from ends of seam. Sew (1) K 2" x 39-3/4" border to each top and bottom of the quilt in the same manner. Sew diagonal ends of adjacent borders together.

19. Sew (1) **E** $3-1/2'' \times 50''$ border to each side of the quilt. Sew (1) **E** $3-1/2'' \times 45''$ border to each top and bottom of the quilt.



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QUILT DIAGRAM



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **I** 2-1/4" strips.
