BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- **1.** Referring to the diagrams and quilt image for color pairings, create block piles, each consisting of (2) 2-1/2" **color 1** squares and (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" **color 2** piece.
- 2. Working with the first pile, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) 2-1/2" color 1 squares. Place a marked square right sides together on the left end of (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" color 2 piece. Stitch on the drawn line, trim seam allowance to 1/4", and press corner open. Repeat on the opposite end with the second marked square to make (1) flying geese block.










Flying geese block

3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 using the remaining piles to make a total of (25) assorted flying geese blocks as shown in diagrams.


QUILT ASSEMBLY

- 1. Lay out the flying geese blocks into (5) rows of (5). Sew blocks into rows.
- **2.** Sew block rows together alternating with (6) **B** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces, noting row orientation options (refer to black or white version).
- **3.** Sew **B** 2-1/2" x 26-1/2" pieces to opposite long sides to finish the quilt top.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **B** 2-1/4" strips.
