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## SPOOL BLOCK

Note: There are (3) variations of Spool Blocks. See diagrams for correct fabric placement.

1. Sew the longest edge of (1) A and I $3^{\prime \prime}$ HST, right sides together. Press seams toward $\mathbf{I}$. Repeat to make (52) HST units.
2. Sew (1) HST unit made in Step 1 onto each side of (1) I 8-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.

Press seams toward I rectangle. Make (26).

## SPOOL BLOCK VARIATION 1

3. Sew (4) F 5" HST onto each side of (1) C 6-1/8" square. Press seams outward and trim to measure 8-1/2".
4. Sew (2) A 8-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles onto each side of the square unit made in Step 3.
5. Sew (2) units made in Step 2 to complete Spool Block Variation 1. Repeat to create (4) blocks. Spool Blocks should measure 12-1/2" unfinished.

## SPOOL BLOCK VARIATION 2

6. Sew (1) D 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle onto the sides of (1) G 8-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Make (5) strip units.
7. Sew (2) A $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles onto each side of the strip unit made in Step 6. Press seams toward $\mathbf{A}$.
8. Use (2) units made in Step 2 to complete Spool Block Variation 2. Make (5) Spool Blocks. Unfinished size is $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.


## SPOOL BLOCK VARIATION 3

9. Use (2) $9-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ QST C and $\mathbf{E}$ to create the center of Spool Block Variation 3 as shown.
10. Sew (2) A $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles onto the sides of the unit made in Step 9. Press seams toward $\mathbf{A}$.
11. Use (2) units made in Step 2 to complete Spool Block Variation 3. Make (4) Spool Blocks. Unfinished size is $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.

## 4-PATCH UNIT

12. Sew (1) 2" strip from both B and J together WOF. Sew (5) strip sets. Press seams toward B.
13. Subcut strip sets into (96) $2^{\prime \prime}$ units.
14. Create 4 -patch units by sewing (2) $2^{\prime \prime}$ units together as shown. Make (48) BJ 4-Patch Units.

## FLYING GEESE UNIT

15. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) E 2" squares. Place (1) E 2" square RST on (1) end of $\mathbf{A}^{\prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew along the line and trim to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press seams outward. Repeat on opposite end forming a Flying Geese Unit. Make (48), trim to 2" x 3-1/2".

## BUTTON BLOCK UNITS

16. Sew (2) AE flying geese units on each side of (1) H 3-1/2" square. Press seams toward $\mathbf{H}$. Make (12) AE-H units.
17. Sew (2) J 2" squares on each side of (1) AE flying geese unit. Press seams toward J. Make (24).
18. Sew (1) AE-J unit to the top and bottom of (1) AE-H unit as shown below. Make 12 Blocks.

19. Sew (2) BJ 4-patch units to each side of (1) A 6-1/2" $\times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Press seams toward $\mathbf{A}$. Make (24) BJ-A strips.
20. Sew (2) A 6-1/2" $\times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to each side of (1) Button Block Center, as shown in diagram below. Press seams toward A. Make (12) A-Button Block Centers.
21. Sew (1) BJ-A strip to top and bottom of (1) $\boldsymbol{A}$-Button Block Center. Make (12) Button Blocks. Square to 12-1/2".

## AJ SASHING STRIP

22. Create horizontal sashing strips with (5) A 12-1/2" $\times 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (4) J $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Start and end each row with $\mathbf{A}$ rectangle. Press seams toward A. Make (4) rows.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

23. Rows 1-5: Join Spool Blocks and A 12-1/2" x $2^{\prime \prime}$ strips as shown in the diagram below. Refer to Quilt Diagram (pg. 7) to complete remaining Rows 2-5. Press seams toward $\mathbf{A}$.
24. Sew AJ Sashing Strips to bottoms of Rows 1-4 as shown in Quilt Diagram (pg.7). Nestle sashing and corner stone seams as you go. Then sew Rows together to complete quilt top.

## BORDER A

26. Sew (2) A $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips together using a diagonal seam. Make (4) long strips. Subcut (2) strips to 66-1/2" and (2) strips to 69-1/2" .
27. Sew A $2^{\prime \prime} \times 66-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to both sides of the quilt top. Press seams toward border.
28. Sew A $2^{\prime \prime} \times 69-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press seams toward border.

QUILT DIAGRAM

ROW 1


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using D 2-1/4" strips.
