



A	J V K A	53444-1 Black on White	1-1/4	Fussy cut (1) 40-1/2" x 36" rectangle along outer block lines to create a piece 9 blocks across x 8 blocks tall.
В		53449-1 Black on White	1-1/4	(5) 3" x WOF strips. Sew short ends together and subcut (2) 3" x 48-1/2" and (2) 3" x 43-1/2" strips. (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.
С	1	53451-1 Black on White	7/8	(6) 4-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (48) 4-1/2" squares.



#### **MAKING THE BLOCKS**

**1.** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) **C** 4-1/2" squares. Place a marked square right sides together on the left end of (1) **E** 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Stitch on the marked line, trim the seam allowance to 1/4", and press open. Repeat with a second marked square on the opposite end to make (1) **C-E** flying geese block. Make (4).



**2.** In the same way, make a total of (4) flying geese blocks each using the following fabric combinations.



Make 4 each

#### **ASSEMBLING THE QUILT**

**3.** Sew together (1) each **F-E**, **G-E**, **H-E**, **I-E**, **J-E** and **C-E** block as shown to make a border row. Make (4).


**4.** Sew **D** 3"  $\times$  40-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the **A** 40-1/2"  $\times$  36" rectangle to make the quilt center. Trim equal amounts off top and bottom so quilt center measures 40-1/2" square.



**NOTE:** Refer to the Layout Diagram on p. 4 as you add borders.

- **5.** Sew **E** 2" x 40-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew **E** 2" x 43-1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Quilt should measure 43-1/2" square.
- **6.** Sew **B** 3"  $\times$  43-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew **B** 3"  $\times$  48-1/2" strips to the top and bottom.
- **7.** Sew border rows to opposite sides of the quilt, noting orientation. Sew **H** 4-1/2" squares to both ends of the remaining border rows and add to the quilt top and bottom.
- **8.** Sew **D** 3" x 56-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew **D** 3" x 61-1/2" strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.





**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using the (7) **B** 2-1/2" strips.
