| A |  | 53444-1 Black on White | 1-1/4 | Fussy cut (1) 40-1/2" $\times 36^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle along outer block lines to create a piece 9 blocks across $\times 8$ blocks tall. |
| B |  | 53449-1 Black on White | 1-1/4 | (5) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew short ends together and subcut (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ 43-1/2" strips. <br> (7) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding. |
| C |  | 53451-1 Black on White | 7/8 | (6) 4-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips, subcut (48) 4-1/2" squares. |
| D |  | 53445-2 White on Black | 7/8 | (7) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew short ends together and subcut (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 61-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ 56-1/2" strips. <br> (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, subcut (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ 40-1/2" strips. |
| E |  | FROM RUBY + BEE <br> 51583-2 <br> Capsicum | 5/8 | (1) 4-1/2" $\times$ WOF strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2 $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. <br> (3) $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew short ends together and subcut (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 43-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. <br> (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |
| F |  | FROM RUBY + BEE <br> 51583-13 Salvia | 1/4 | (1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2 $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. |
| G |  | $\begin{aligned} & \text { FROM RUBY + BEE } \\ & 51583-16 \text { Sky } \end{aligned}$ | 1/4 | (1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2 $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. |
| H |  | FROM RUBY + BEE <br> 51583-24 Pasture | 3/8 | (2) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, subcut (4) 4-1/2 $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (4) 4-1/2" squares. |
| I |  | FROM RUBY + BEE <br> 51583-33 <br> Pumpkin | 1/4 | (1) 4-1/2" $\times$ WOF strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2 $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. |

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| J |  | FROM RUBY + BEE 51583-35 Meyer Lemon | 1/4 | (1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2 $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. |
|  |  | Backing | 3-7/8 | 69" $\times 69^{\prime \prime}$ square of batting |

## MAKING THE BLOCKS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) C 4-1/2" squares. Place a marked square right sides together on the left end of (1) E 4-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Stitch on the marked line, trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, and press open. Repeat with a second marked square on the opposite end to make (1) C-E flying geese block. Make (4).

2. In the same way, make a total of (4) flying geese blocks each using the following fabric combinations.


## ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

3. Sew together (1) each F-E, G-E, H-E, I-E, J-E and C-E block as shown to make a border row. Make (4).

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4. Sew D $3^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom of the $\mathbf{A} 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to make the quilt center. Trim equal amounts off top and bottom so quilt center measures 40-1/2" square.


NOTE: Refer to the Layout Diagram on p. 4 as you add borders.
5. Sew E 2" $\times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew $\mathbf{E} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 43-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom. Quilt should measure 43-1/2" square.
6. Sew B $3^{\prime \prime} \times 43-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew B $3^{\prime \prime} \times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom.
7. Sew border rows to opposite sides of the quilt, noting orientation. Sew H 4-1/2" squares to both ends of the remaining border rows and add to the quilt top and bottom.
8. Sew $\mathbf{D} 3^{\prime \prime} \times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew $\mathbf{D} 3^{\prime \prime} \times 61-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

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FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using the (7) B 2-1/2" strips.
