

3/8 yard - 41612-1 Blue

1/4 yard - 41610-3 Red

1 ½ yards – 41608-2 White

1/4 yard - 41609-1 Blue

3/4 yard - 41613-1 Blue

1 1/4 yards - 41612-2 White

⁷/₈ yard − 41608-1 Blue

3/8 yard – 41612-3 Red

½ yard – 41611-1 Blue

4 yards – 41612-X White

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A: States - Red

• Cut one 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into nine 4 ½" squares.

Fabric B: Tonal Stars – Red

- Cut one 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 2 ½" squares.
- Cut two 2 ½" x WOF strips.

Fabric C: Multi Stars - Blue

- Cut one 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 4 ½" squares.
- Cut one 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips and four 2 ½" squares.



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Fabric D: Words - Red

• Cut two 2 ½" x WOF strips.

Fabric F: Fireworks - White

- Cut two 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- Cut four 4 ½" x 24 ½" WOF strips.
- Cut two 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into four 4 ½" x 16 ½" strips.
- Cut one 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 4 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

Fabric F: States - Blue

• Cut one 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 4 ½" squares.

Fabric G: Tonal Stars - Blue

- Cut four 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixty-four 2 ½" squares.
- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric H: Tonal Stars - White

- Cut four 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixty-four 2 ½" squares.
- Cut four 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixty-four 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- Cut one 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 4 1/2" squares.
- Cut two 2 ½" x WOF strips.

Fabric I: Fireworks - Blue

- Cut three 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut three 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric J: Multi Stars - Red

• Cut four 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixty-four 2 ½" squares.

Fabric K: Stripe – Blue

• Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Backing: Multi Stars - White


• Cut two 67" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 67" x 67" for the pieced back.




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Block Assembly:

- 1. Sew one 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip and one 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strip together lengthwise to make one BH strip set (Fig. 1). Sub-cut the BH strip set into eight 2 ½" x 4 ½" BH strips (Fig. 2).
- 2. Sew one 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strip and one 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strip together lengthwise to make one DH strip set (Fig. 3). Sub-cut the DH strip set into eight 2 ½" x 4 ½" DH strips (Fig. 4).




- 3. Sew one 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip and one 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strip together lengthwise to make one BE strip set (Fig. 5). Sub-cut the BE strip set into twelve 2 ½" x 4 ½" BE strips (Fig. 6).
- 4. Sew one 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strip and one 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strip together lengthwise to make one DE strip set (Fig. 7). Sub-cut the DE strip set into twelve 2 ½" x 4 ½" DE strips (Fig. 8).





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5. Sew one BE strip and one DE strip together to make one $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " BED square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make twelve BED squares total. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.



6. Sew one BH strip and one DH strip together to make one 4 ½" BHD square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make eight BHD squares total. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.

7. Sew two BHD squares and two 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H squares together to make one Block One (Fig. 11). Repeat to make four Block Ones total.



8. Place one 2 ½" Fabric G square on the left side of one 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 12). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 12). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 13). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

9. Place another 2 ½" Fabric G square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 14). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 14). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 15). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make one GHG unit.



10. Repeat Steps 8-9 to make thirty-two GHG units total.



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11. Repeat Steps 8-9 using thirty-two 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strips and sixty-four 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J squares to make thirty-two JHJ units (Fig. 16).





- 12. Sew one GHG unit to each side of one 4 ½" Fabric F square. Sew one 2 ½" Fabric H square to each end of one GHG unit. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F square to make one Block Two (Fig. 17). Repeat to make eight Block Twos total.
- 13. Sew one JHJ unit to each side of one 4 ½" Fabric A square. Sew one 2 ½" Fabric H square to each end of one JHJ unit. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make one Block Three (Fig. 18). Repeat to make eight Block Threes total.



14. Repeat Steps 8-9 using four 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strips and eight 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C squares to make four CEC units (Fig. 19).



15. Repeat Steps 8-9 using four 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strips and eight 2 ½" Fabric B squares to make four BCB units (Fig. 20).





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- 16. Sew one BCB unit to each side of one 4 ½" Fabric A square. Sew one 2 ½" Fabric C square to each end of one BCB unit. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make one A block (Fig. 21).
- 17. Sew one CEC unit to each side of the A block. Sew one BED square to each end of one CEC unit. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the A block (Fig. 22).





Follow Figure 23 for Steps 18-19.

- 18. Sew one 4 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the A block. Sew one BED square to each end of one 4 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric E strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the A block.
- 19. Sew one 4 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the A block. Sew one BED square to each end of one 4 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric E strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the A block to make the Center Block.






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Quilt Assembly - Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top:

- 20. Sew one Block Two, two Block Threes and one Block Two together in that order to make one strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew one strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 21. Sew one Block One, one Block Two, two Block Threes and one Block Two and one Block One together in that order to make one strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 22. Sew one 2" x 48 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2" x 51 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 23. Sew one 4 ½" x 51 ½"

 Fabric I strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 4 ½" x 59 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 24. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 25. Sew the six 2 ½" x WOF Fabric K strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
- 26. Bind as desired.
