B		54025DM-1 Aqua	1/2	(1) 8-3/8" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 8-3/8" squares. Cut squares once diagonally once to yield (8) HSTs. (1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares.
C		54030DM-3 Jungle	3/8	(1) 8-3/8" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 8-3/8" and (6) 3-1/2" squares. Cut the 8-3/8" squares once diagonally to yield (4) HSTs.

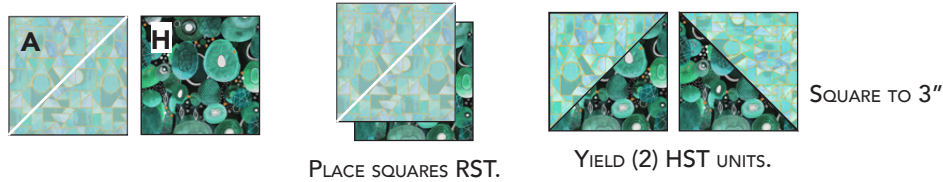

J		54028DM-1 Aqua	1/2	(1) 8-3/8" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 8-3/8" squares. Cut squares once diagonally to yield (8) HSTs. (1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares.
K		54029DM-2 Emerald	3/8	(1) 8-3/8" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 8-3/8" and (6) 3-1/2" squares. Cut the 8-3/8" squares once diagonally to yield (4) HSTs.

M		54028DM-5 Marine	1-1/8	(1) 8-3/8" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 8-3/8" and (6) 3-1/2" squares. Cut the 8-3/8" squares once diagonally to yield (4) HSTs. (7) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" strips.

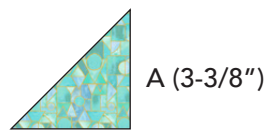
## PIECED BLOCK

1. **HST Units:** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **A** 3-1/2" square. Place marked **A** square, right side together (RST), on (1) **H** 3-1/2" square as shown. Sew 1/4" away from drawn line on both sides. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) **HST units**. Square to 3". Make (4). **NOTE:** (3) HST units will be used in (1) block. Set aside remaining HST for subsequent blocks.

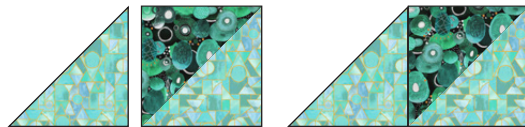


2. Arrange and sew together (3) **A/H** units and (3) precut **A** 3-3/8" HSTs into row units as shown.

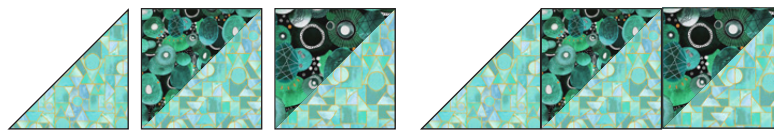
Row 1: (1) **A** HST



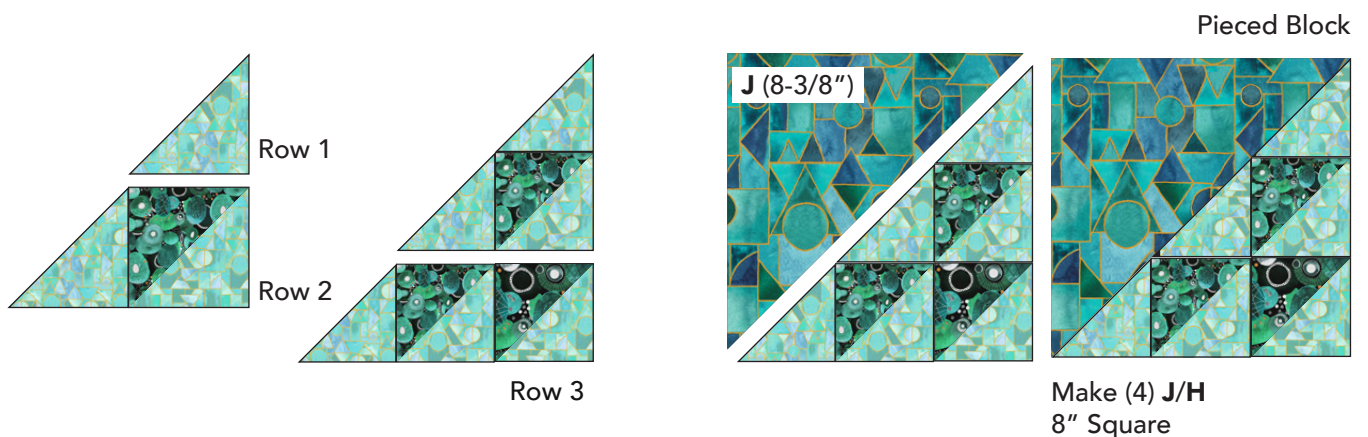
Row 2: (1) **A** HST and (1) **A/H** units.



Row 3: (1) **A** HST and (2) **A/H** unit.



3. Sew together row units as shown. Add (1) precut **J** 8-3/8" HST to the long side of the row unit to complete (1) **Pieced Block**. Block measures 8" square. Make (4).





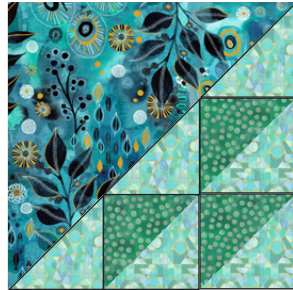

4. Make (4) of each Pieced Block by repeating Steps 1-3. Use the following fabric combinations.

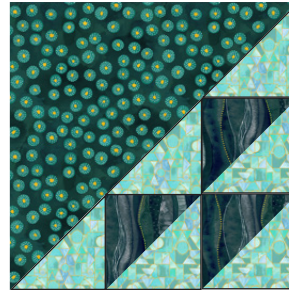

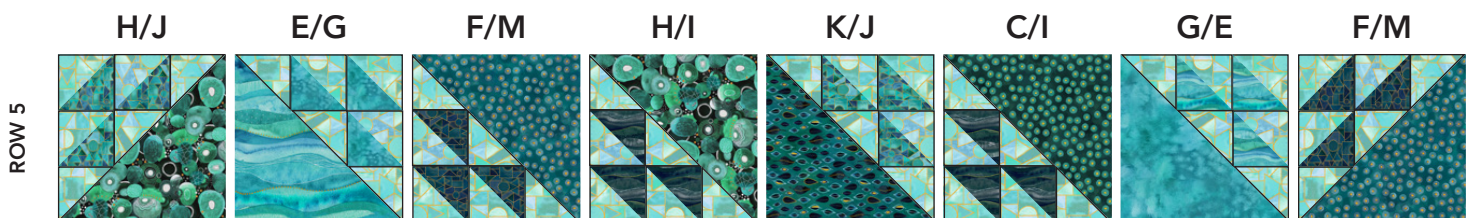
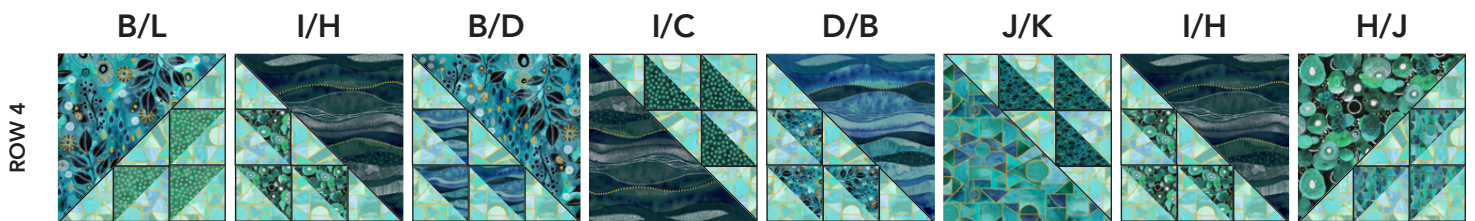
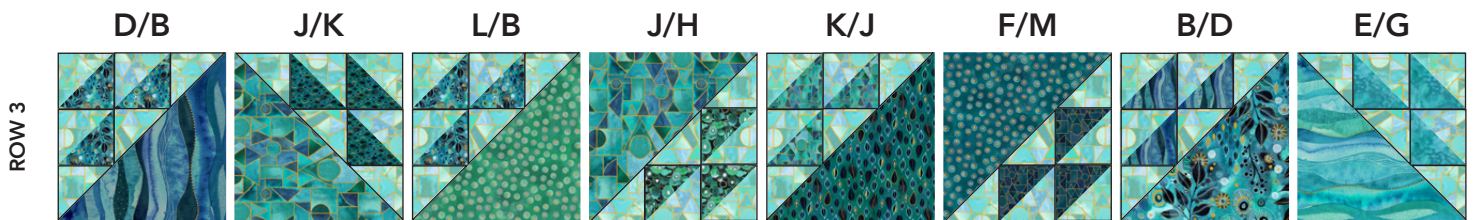
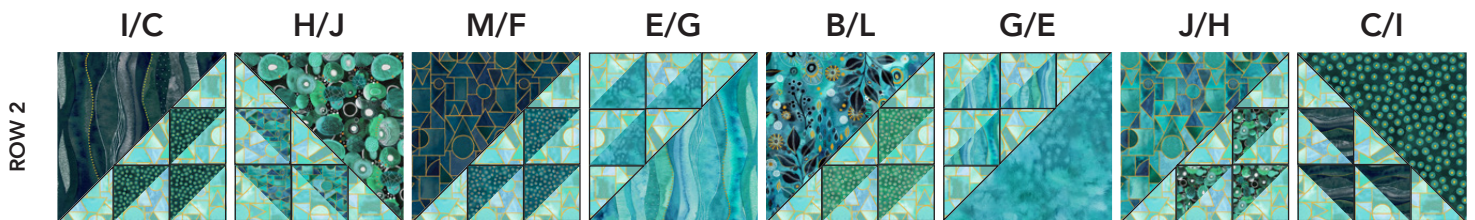
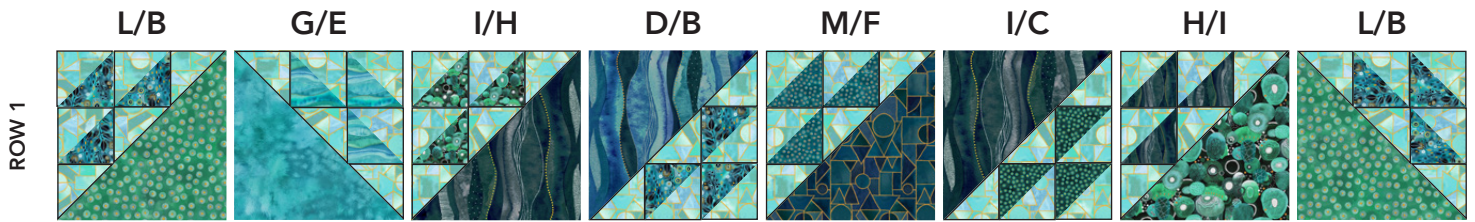




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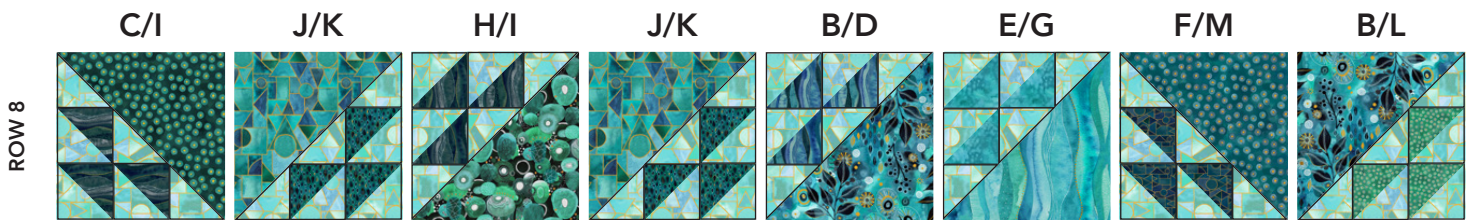
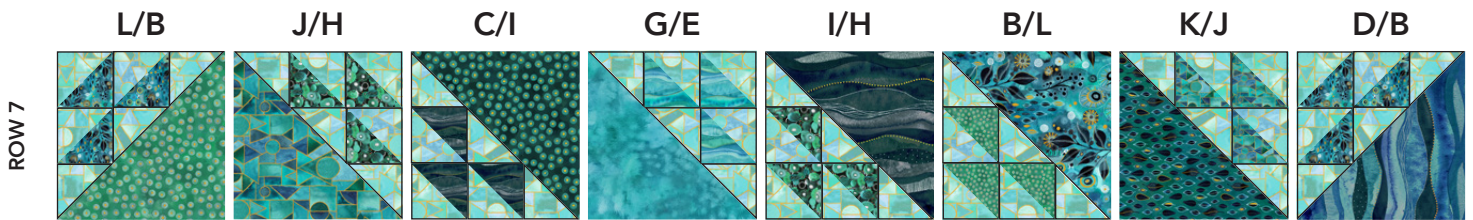
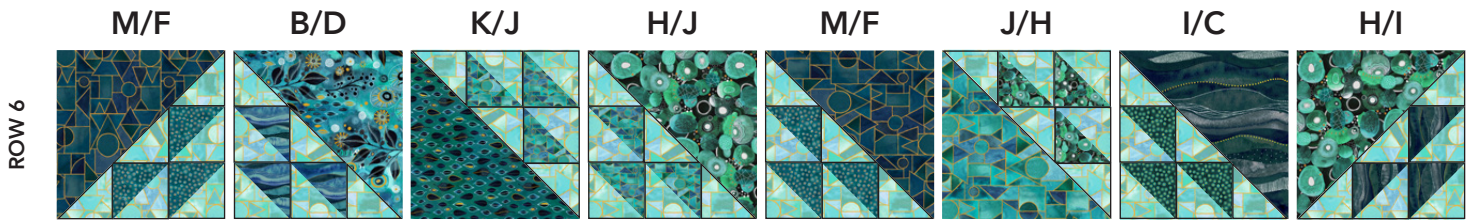
## QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

- 5. Pieced Rows:** Arrange and sew together (8) Pieced Blocks to make (1) Pieced Row. Refer to quilt image and row diagrams for block placement and block orientation. Make (8) rows.
- 6.** Sew together Pieced Rows to complete quilt center.

## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Refer to Quilt Assembly diagram on Page 7 for following steps.

- 7. Inner Border:** Sew (2) **N** 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" strips to the long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **N** 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- 8. Outer Border:** Sew (2) **M** 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" strips to the long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **M** 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



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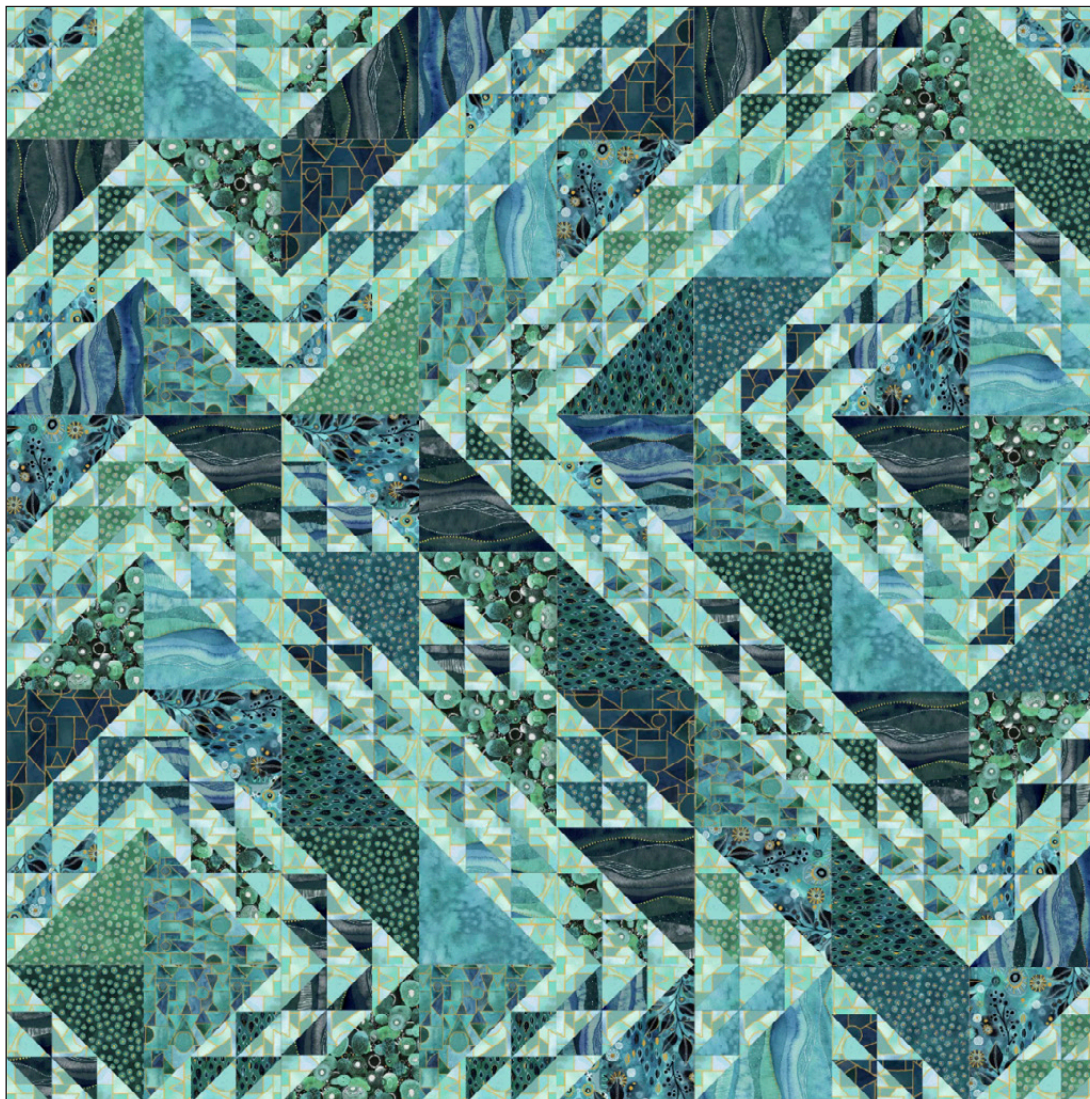
## QUILT ASSEMBLY

**M** 3-1/2" x 72-1/2"

**N** 3-1/2" x 66-1/2"

**M** 3-1/2" x 66-1/2"

**N** 3-1/2" x 60-1/2"



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **N** 2-1/4" strips.
