Subcut <br> (6) $11 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 151 / 2^{" 1}$ strips and <br> (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 231 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips <br> INNER BORDER \#1: <br> (4) $13 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut <br> (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 26^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 371 / 2$ " strips INNER BORDER \#5: <br> (5) $13 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut <br> (2) $13 / 4 \times 391 / 2$ " strips from (2) WOF strips; piece remaining (3) WOF strips and subcut <br> (2) $13 / 4 " \times 51^{\prime \prime}$ strips |

## QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

1. Pieced Rows 1 \& 3. Arrange and sew together (2) A $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, (1) B $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, (1) C $5 \frac{1}{2^{\prime \prime}} \times 10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ rectangle, and (3) F $1 \frac{1}{2^{\prime \prime}} \times 10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ sashing rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (2) pieced rows.


MAKE (2) PIECED ROWS
2. Pieced Row 2. Arrange and sew together (2) B $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 15 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ rectangles, (1) A $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ rectangle, (1) C $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15 \frac{112 " \prime}{2 \prime}$ rectangle, and (3) F $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 15 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing rectangles to make a pieced row.


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3. Sew together pieced rows and (2) F $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 231 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips to complete quilt center.


## BORDER ASSEMBLY

Refer to Quilt Assembly Diagram on Page 4 for the following instructions.
4. Inner Border \#1. Sew (1) F $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 371 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (1) F $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.
5. Inner Border \#2. Sew (1) E $1 \frac{114 " \times 40 " ~ s t r i p ~ t o ~ t h e ~ l e f t ~ a n d ~ r i g h t ~ s i d e s ~ o f ~ q u i l t ~ c e n t e r, ~ f o l l o w e d ~ b y ~}{\text { " }}$ (1) E $11^{\prime \prime \prime} \times 27 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.
6. Inner Border \#3. Sew (1) D $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strip to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by
(1) D $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 351 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.
7. Inner Border \#4. Sew (1) E $1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 491 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by
(1) E $1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 37^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.
8. Inner Border \#5. Sew (1) F $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 51^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by
(1) F $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 391 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.
9. Outer Border. Sew (1) A 4" $\times 531 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (1) A $4^{\prime \prime} \times 461 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using G 2-1/4" strips.
