




#### **SMALL INNER BLOCKS ASSEMBLY**


1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) A 1-1/2" square. Lay A square right sides together on a corner of (1) Print One 2-1/2" square (refer to pg. 5 for Print One fabric). Sew on drawn line. Trim leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat step to complete remaining corners. Make (4) Small Corner Blocks. Set aside.



- **2.** Sew together (1) **A** 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle and (1) **Print One** 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle. Make (4) units.
- **3.** Sew (2) **A-Print One** Units to the opposite sides of (1) 2-1/2" Print One square to make a Block Center Row Unit as shown in diagram below. Note proper rotation of **A**-Print One units.





**4.** Sew (2) **Small Corner Blocks** to the opposite sides of (1) **A-Print One** Unit to make top and bottom Block Rows. Make (2). *Note proper rotation of A-Print One units.* 





**5.** Sew together Block Row Units as shown in diagram below. Square Block Center to 6-1/2". Note proper rotation of top and bottom Block Rows.







#### **OUTER BLOCK CENTER**

- **6.** Sew together (1) **A** and (1) **Print Two** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles (refer to pg. 5 for Print Two fabric).
- **7.** Similar to Step's 1 Small Corner Block assembly, make Large Corner Blocks using (4) **A** 3-1/2" squares and (1) **Print Two** 6-1/2" square. Make a total of (4) **Large Corner Blocks**.






**8.** Sew (1) **A-Print Two** units to opposite sides of Small Inner Block to make a Center Row unit. Note proper rotation of **A-Print Two** units.







9. Sew (2) Large Corner Blocks to opposite sides of (1) A-Print Two. Make (2) Block Row Units.



10. Sew together Block Row units as shown below to complete Large Outer Block. Square to 18-1/2".



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#### **QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY**


**12.** Referring to quilt image, arrange and sew together (4) pieced blocks to make a pieced row. Make (4) pieced rows.





#### **BORDER ASSEMBLY**

- **13.** Inner border. Sew (2) A 3" x 72-1/2" strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) A 3" x 77-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.
- **14.** Outer border. Sew (2) **K** 4" x 77-1/2" strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **K** 4" x 84-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **K** 2-1/4" strips.
