| C |  | 53667-3 Multi | 1/2 | (2) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut (12) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |
| D |  | 53670-3 Multi | 3/8 | (2) 4-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips; subcut (40) 1-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |
| E |  | 53672-3 Multi | 1/2 | (4) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut (48) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |

## STAR BLOCK

1. Sew the short sides of (1) I 3-3/8" triangle to both sides of (1) K 6-1/4" triangle to make a Flying Geese unit. Square to $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make (4).

2. Sew (1) E 3" square to both short ends of a Flying Geese unit to make Row 1 of the block. Make (2).

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3. Sew a Flying Geese unit to both sides of (1) C 5-1/2" square to make Row 2 of the block.

4. Sew a Row 1 from Step 2 to the top of Row 2. Rotate and sew the remaining Row 1 to the bottom of the block to complete. Square to 10-1/2". Make (12).

## LOG CABIN BLOCK

5. Sew the long side of (1) H 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the left side of (1) J $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew (1) G $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right side as shown.

6. Sew (1) M 1-1/2" square to both short ends of (1) H 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sew to the top of the unit from Step 5.


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7. Sew (1) $\mathbf{M} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to both short ends of (1) G 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sew to the bottom of the unit in Step 5. This completes Round 1 of the block. Square up to 4-1/2".

8. Sew (1) A $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the left side of Round 1 . Sew (1) D $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right side.

9. Sew (1) M 1-1/2" square to both short ends of (1) A 1-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sew to the top of the unit from Step 8.

10. Sew (1) M 1-1/2" square to both short ends of (1) D 1-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sew to the bottom of the unit from Step 9 to complete Round 2. Square up to 6-1/2".


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11. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the left side of Round 2 . Sew (1) H $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right side.

12. Sew (1) M 1-1/2" square to both short ends of (1) B 1-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sew to the top of Round 2.

13. Sew (1) $\mathbf{M} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to both short ends of (1) H $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sew to the bottom of the unit from Step 12 to complete Round 3. Square up to 8-1/2".

14. Sew (1) $\mathbf{N} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the left side of Round 3 . Sew (1) L $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right side.
15. Sew (1) M 1-1/2" square to both short ends of (1) $\mathbf{N} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip as shown. Sew to the top of Round 3.

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16. Sew (1) M 1-1/2" square to both short ends of (1) $L 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip as shown. Sew to the bottom of the unit from Step 15 to complete the block. Square up to 10-1/2". Make (20).


Measures 10-1/2" square unfinished
The quilt center is set on point, so it will be sewn together in diagonal rows using side setting and corner setting triangles from Fabric K. Following diagram on Page 7 for placement and rotation of each block, sew each row in the order stated from left to right.
Note: that the Log Cabin blocks are all turned the same direction.
17. Row 1: Sew the short side of a K Side Setting Triangle to both sides of a Log Cabin. Sew a K Corner Setting triangle to the top of the Log Cabin.
18. Row 2: Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star block, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle.
19. Row 3: Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle.
20. Row 4: Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Corner Square Triangle.
21. Row 5: Corner Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle.
22. Row 6: Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle.
23. Row 7: Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle.
24. Row 8: Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle. Sew a Corner Setting Triangle to the bottom of the Log Cabin Block.
25. Trim edges of quilt center $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ past block points.

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Inner Border
26. Sew the $1^{\prime \prime} \times 71-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ I strips to the left and right sides of the quilt. Sew the $1^{\prime \prime} \times 58^{\prime \prime}$ I strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

## Outer Border

27. Sew the $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} F$ strips to the left and right sides of the quilt. Sew the $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 66^{\prime \prime}$ $F$ strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using F 2-1/2" strips.
