Fabric A: Map Panel - Multi

- Fussy cut one $421 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 23^{\prime \prime}$ panel, centered on the map.

Fabric B: Tonal Stars - Red

- Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 23^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
- Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 461 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut three $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.


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Fabric C: Multi Stars - White

- Cut three $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut two 5" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into four 5" x $121 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric D: States - Blue

- Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into six $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric E: Words - Red

- Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric F: Tonal Stars - Blue

- Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut three $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.
- Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twenty-four $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric G: Tonal Stars - White

- Cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut six $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.

Fabric H: Multi Stars - Red

- Cut three $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times$ WOF strips.

Fabric I: Stripe - Blue

- Cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 491 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric J: Fireworks - Blue

- Cut four $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 66^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut three $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 591 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Backing: Multi Stars - Blue

- Cut two 67" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 67 " $\times 84$ " for the pieced back.


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## Block Assembly:

1. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 23^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $42 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 23^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A panel. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 46 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $45 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 251 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

4. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip to the bottom of the one GF strip to make (1) GF block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make twelve GF blocks total.

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5. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime}$ bottom of one GF strip with Fabric F strip of the GF strip to the left to make one FG block (Fig. 5). Repeat to make twelve FG blocks total.

6. Place one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E square on the left side of one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.

7. Place another $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric E square on the right side of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 9). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance to make one EFE unit.

8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make twenty-four EFE units total.
9. Repeat Steps 6-7 using twenty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strips and forty-eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F squares to make twenty-four FGF units (Fig. 10).
10. Sew one EFE unit to the top of one FGF unit to make one F block (Fig. 11). Repeat to make twenty-four F blocks total.

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11. Sew one $F$ block to each side of one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ square. Sew one GF block to the left side of $F$ block. Sew one FG block to the right side of the F block to make one strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric $D$ square to make one $D$ block (Fig. 12). Repeat to make six D blocks total.

## Quilt Assembly - Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top:

12. Sew three D blocks and two $5^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strips together, alternating them, to make strip. Sew one $1 \frac{3}{4 \prime \prime} \times 451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to the bottom of the D block strip. Sew one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to the bottom of the Fabric B strip to make one strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips as they are opposite of each other.
13. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 491 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
14. Sew one $5 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times 66^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 591 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
15. Layer and quilt as desired.
16. Sew the seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
17. Bind as desired.

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
