For turned under edge appliqué: freezer paper or other template paper.

For raw edge appliqué: paper backed fusible webbing.


#### FLOWER BLOCKS / For Turned Edge Appliqué:


**1.** Arrange (6) **F** Petals alternating with (6) **J** Petals as shown. Sew (2) Petals together, using an exact 1/4" seam, along the long straight edges beginning the stitching at the corner of the seamline.

**2.** Join (12) Petals to form a ring in the same manner. Press under the seam allowance along the outer straight edges of the petals.











**3.** Center a paper template on (1) **B** Center. Fold the edge of the fabric over the edge of the paper template. Baste or press in place.



#### FLOWER BLOCKS / For Raw Edge Appliqué:

- **4.** Arrange (6) **F** Petals alternating with (6) **J** Petals as shown. Fuse narrow strips of paper backed fusible webbing to the short outer edges. Sew (2) Petals together, using an exact 1/4" seam, along the long straight edges.
- 5. Join (12) Petals to form a ring unit.
- 6. Fuse (1) paper-backed fusible webbing ring to the edge of (1) B Center.




#### For Both Applique Methods:

**7.** Pin or fuse the petal ring unit centered on (1) **G** 10-1/2" square. Sew the outer edges in place using your preferred method.


**8.** Pin or fuse the **B** Center centered on the petal ring. Sew along the outer edge using your preferred method. Make 2.


**Note:** Flower blocks are labeled F1-F4, to indicated placement on Quilt Layout.






**9.** Followng steps 1-5, make blocks using a the fabrics shown. Make 2 each.











#### **BUTTERFLY BLOCK**


**10.** Trace the butterfly placement pattern to (1) **G** 10-1/2" square at an angle so butterflies are about 1-1/4" from side edges and about 1" from top and bottom edges. Make 8.



- 11. Using your preferred method of appliqué, prepare (1) **B** fore wing and (1) **B** fore wing reversed, (1) **C** fore wing and (1) **C** fore wing reversed, (1) **F** hind wing and (1) **F** hind wing reversed, (1) **M** hind wing reversed and (2) **N** bodies.
- 12. Pin or fuse the **F** and **M** hind wings in place. Sew in place along the edges.
- **13.** Pin or fuse the **B** and **C** fore wings in place. Sew in place along the edges.
- **14.** Pin or fuse the **N** body in place. Sew in place along the edge. Embroider the antennae using matching thread or embroidery floss.










**15.** Following steps 9-11, make butterfly blocks using the fabrics indicated. Make 1 each.




#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

- **16.** Following the Quilt Layout on page 6, arrange the flower blocks alternating with the butterfly blocks. Sew together (5) **H** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips alternating with the blocks to make the block rows. Make 4 rows.
- **17.** Sew together (5) **F** 1-1/2" squares alternating with (4) **H** 1-1/2"  $\times$  10-1/2" strips to make the sashing rows. Make 5.
- **18.** Sew together (5) sashing rows alternating with (4) block rows.
- **19.** Sew (1)  $\mathbf{A}$  2-1/2" x 45-1/2" border to each side of quilt. Sew (1)  $\mathbf{A}$  2-1/2" x 49-1/2 border to the top and to the bottom of quilt.
- **20.** Sew (1) **J** 1-1/2"  $\times$  49-1/2" border to each side of quilt. Sew (1) **J** 1-1/2"  $\times$  51-1/2" border to the top and to the bottom of quilt.




#### **QUILT LAYOUT**




**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using  $\bf L$  2-1/4" strips.
