


#### PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

#### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY:**


**1.** Begin block assembly by folding each **Fabric A** Template A piece and each Template B piece **(Fabrics F-I)** in half as shown in the diagram. Gently press the templates using an iron to make a crease marking the exact center of each template.

**2.** Pair each **Fabric A** Template A piece with a Template B piece from **Fabrics F-I**, RST. Align the pressed creases from both templates, and pin in place. Then, pin either end of the templates together to keep fabrics aligned while sewing. Please note that templates will appear bunched up at this step but will become smooth as sewing progresses.

**3.** Before sewing, put your sewing machine in the needle down position. Begin sewing Template A and Template B pieces together, using a slightly smaller stitch length. When sewing curved seams, stitch slowly and stop frequently to adjust fabrics. Ensure both templates are placed evenly within the ¼" seam allowance. Use your fingers to smooth fabrics to prevent puckers. Follow the natural curve of the templates, allowing the sewing machine to guide fabrics through slowly. Once Templates A and B are sewn, press toward Template A.



**4.** Repeat to create (16) curved units each from **Fabrics F, G, H** and **I.** All curved units will use **Fabric A** Template A pieces. Trim curved units to measure 5 ½" x 5 ½" unfinished.




**5.** Gather (4) **A/F** curved units, (4) 5 ½" **Fabric A** squares and (1) 5 ½" **Fabric D** square. Arrange Block Colorway 1 as shown. Note the orientation of the curved units.

**6.** Sew Block Colorway 1 together, pressing seams toward the **Fabric A** squares. Once complete, Block Colorway 1 should measure 15 ½" x 15 ½" unfinished.


7. Repeat to create (4) Block Colorway 1.





**8.** Repeat block assembly described in Steps 5-6 to create Block Colorways 2-4. Create (4) of each additional block colorway. Use the guide below:

- a. Block Colorway 2: A/G curved units + 5 ½" Fabric A squares + 5 ½" Fabric E square.
- **b.** Block Colorway 3: **A/H** curved units + 5 ½" **Fabric A** squares + 5 ½" **Fabric J** square.
- **c.** Block Colorway 4: **A/I** curved units + 5 ½" **Fabric A** squares + 5 ½" **Fabric C** square.
- **9.** There should be (16) blocks, each measuring  $15 \frac{1}{2}$  x  $15 \frac{1}{2}$  unfinished.



### **QUILT ASSEMBLY:**


**10.** Arrange Block Colorways 1-4 in a 4 x 4 grid, placing (1) 2" x 15 ½" **Fabric B** sashing strip vertically in between each block. Create sashing rows using (4) 2" x 15 ½" **Fabric B** sashing strips and (3) 2" **Fabric K** cornerstone squares. Place sashing rows in between each block row.

11. Sew block rows together, pressing toward the sashing strips.

**12.** Sew sashing rows together, pressing toward the sashing strips.

**13.** Sew block and sashing rows together to complete quilt top assembly. The quilt top should measure 65" x 65" unfinished.





### FINISHING THE QUILT:

**14.** Sandwich quilt top with batting and backing. Baste quilt layers together using your preferred method. Quilt as desired.

**15.** Create binding using (7) **Fabric J** 2 ¼" x WOF strips.

**16.** Attach binding using your preferred method.
