## Constructing Pieced Blocks

1. Sew together (1) $2^{\prime \prime}$ A square and (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{N}$ rectangle, and add to the right side of (1) $8^{\prime \prime}$ x $11^{\prime \prime}$ <print> rectangle.

2. Sew together (1) $2^{\prime \prime}$ A square and (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{N}$ rectangle, and add to the bottom of the sewn unit made in step 1 to complete (1) block measuring 9-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

3. Make the total number of blocks indicated in the following fabrics:
(3) Blocks: B, C, D, E, F, G
(2) Blocks: I, J, K
(1) Block: H

Quilt Center Assembly
4. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (5) pieced blocks and (4) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A sashing rectangles to make a pieced row.
5. Sew together pieced rows and (4) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 53-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A sashing strips to complete quilt center.

## Quilt Top Assembly

6. Inner border. Sew (1) 4 " $\times 68-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (1) $4^{\prime \prime} \times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
7. Outer border. Sew (1) $4^{\prime \prime} \times 75-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{M}$ strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (1) $4^{\prime \prime} \times 67-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} M$ strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using L 2-1/4" strips.
