
BLOCK PIECING (DARK VERSION IS SHOWN)

Unit 1

- 1. Sew (1) **B** 2" square to (1) **D** 2" square, as shown in diagram.
- 2. Add (1) **B** 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to the bottom of sewn unit to create **Unit 1**. Square to 3-1/2". Make (16).


Unit 2

3. Corner Triangles: Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) **D** 2" square. Place **D** square on top, left corner of (1) **A** 3-1/2" square, right sides together (RST), and sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from sewn line and press open. Repeat step on all four corners. Square Unit 2 to 3-1/2". Make (4).



Make (16) Square to 3-1/2'






SEW ON DRAWN LINE. TRIM 1/4" AWAY FROM SEWN LINE.




OPEN AND PRESS TO REVEAL **D** CORNER TRIANGLE. REPEAT FOR REMAINING CORNERS.

Unit 3

4. Similar to **Unit 2**'s assembly, make **Unit 3**, using (2) **D** 2" squares and (1) **C** 3-1/2" square. Square **Unit 3** to 3-1/2". Make (16).




Make (16) Square to 3-1/2"



CENTER BLOCK

NOTE ROTATION AND PLACEMENT OF PIECES FROM DIAGRAM BELOW.

- 5. Row 1 & 3: Sew (2) Unit 1 and (1) Unit 3 together. Make (2).
- 6. Row 2: Sew (2) Unit 3 and (1) Unit 2 together.
- 7. Sew Rows 1, 2, and 3 together, as shown. Square to 9-1/2". Make (4).



SIDE TRIANGLE UNITS

8. Sew together (4) A 4-1/4" QST's, (2) A 2-5/8" squares, and (1) E 3-7/8" HST into a row.



9. Sew together (2) A 4-1/4" QST's, (2) C 4-1/4" QST's, and (1) B 3-7/8" HST into a row.






10. Join the two rows sewn previously and add (1) **A** 3-7/8" HST to the bottom to make a **Side Triangle** Unit. Make (6).



11. Sew together (3) A 2-5/8" squares, (2) A 4-1/4" QST's and (1) C 4-1/4" QST into (3) diagonal rows of (3). Join the rows to make a Corner Triangle. Make (4).


12. Assemble (4) Center Blocks, (6) Side Triangles and (2) Corner Triangles in (4) diagonal rows, as shown in diagram. Then join the rows and add remaining (2) Corner Triangles. Square up runner 1/4" past block points.


BORDER ASSEMBLY

- 13. Sew (4) A 1-1/2" x WOF strips via short ends. Measure the width of quilt and cut (2) strips to that length. Sew to the long sides of the runner. Measure the height of the quilt and cut (2) strips to that length. Sew to remaining sides of the quilt.
- **14.** In the same way, use the (4) \mathbf{D} 2-1/2" x WOF strips to add to the outer border to complete quilt top.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **C** 2-1/4" strips.
