A		50000-2	1/2	Outer border: (4) 3 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (2) 3 1/2" x 29 1/2" and (2) 3 1/2" x 35 1/2" strips.
B		50009-10	1/2	Blocks: (4) 2" x WOF. Subcut (72) 2" x 2" squares. Inner border: (4) 1 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (2) 1 1/2" x 27 1/2" and (2) 1 1/2" x 29 1/2" strips.
C		50010-8	3/8	Binding: (4) 2 1/4" x WOF strips.

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Constructing pieced blocks

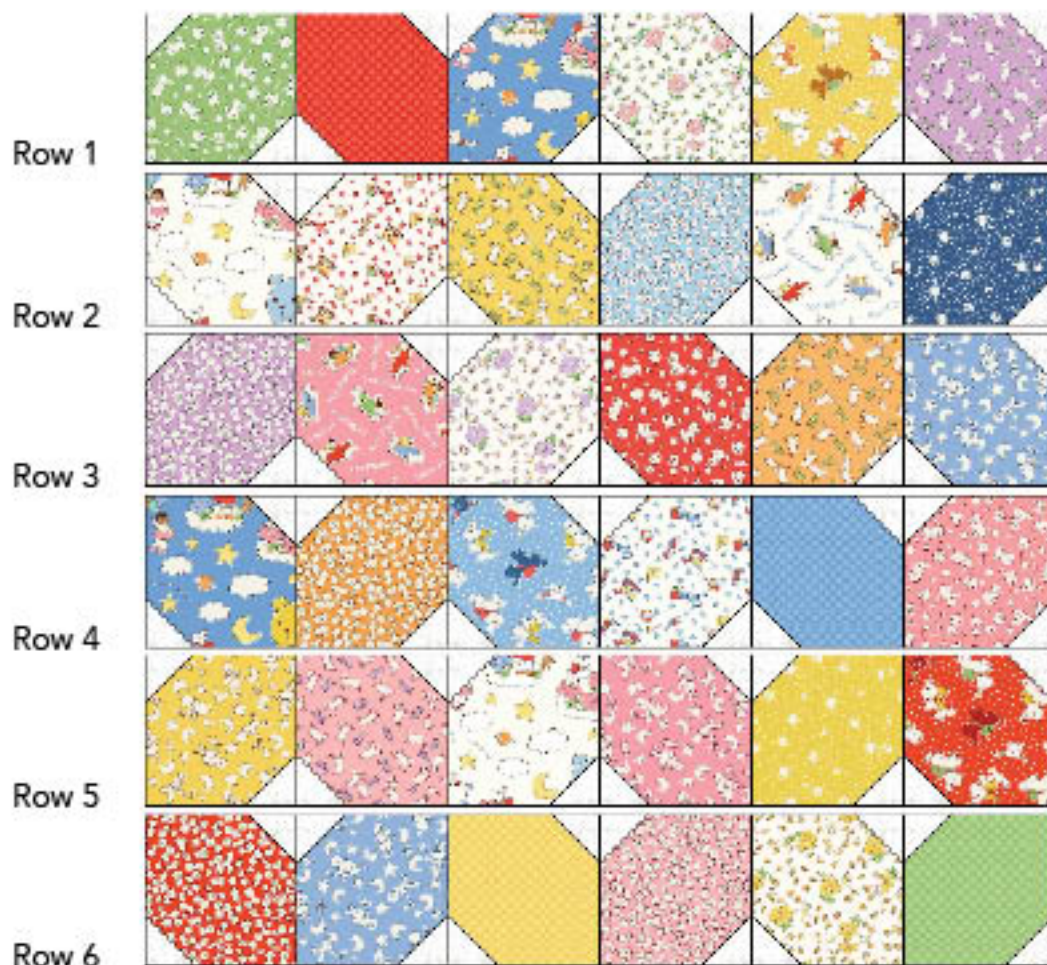
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" x 2" **B** square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 5" x 5" print charm square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **B** corner triangle. Repeat with another 2" x 2" **B** square diagonally opposite from the first corner triangle on the same print charm square to complete 1 pieced block. Block should measure 5" x 5" raw edge to raw edge.



2. Make a total of (36) pieced blocks. Quilters may select charm squares of their choice instead of following the fabric placement provided by designer. 1 charm square pack consists of (42); only (36) charm squares are used.

Quilt Center Assembly

1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (6) pieced blocks, noting orientations of blocks.



2. Sew pieced rows together to complete quilt center.



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Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner border. Sew (2) $1\frac{1}{2}''$ x $27\frac{1}{2}''$ **B** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $1\frac{1}{2}''$ x $29\frac{1}{2}''$ **B** strips to the remaining opposite sides.
2. Outer border. Sew (2) $3\frac{1}{2}''$ x $29\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $3\frac{1}{2}''$ x $35\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** strips to the remaining opposite sides to complete quilt top.



Quilting Instructions

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt using the (4) $2\frac{1}{4}''$ x WOF **C** strips
