A		51988DP-X Multi	1 panel	Trim panel to measure 54" x 42". Note: panel size may vary slightly; trim panel to 1/4" past design edges.
B		40171-48 Stone/Lavender FOR BINDING	1/2	(5) 2 1/4" x WOF strips for binding.
C		Scrap Fabric (any color)	FQ	(2) 4" x 7" rectangles.*
		Batting		60" x 48"; (1) 4" x 7" rectangle.
		Backing	2 3/4


***Optional:** The arrow marker can also be made using one layer of wool felt. Cut out the arrow template, transfer the markings to (1) 4" x 7" rectangle of felt, and cut out.

Making the Mat

1. Layer panel piece, batting and backing together to form a quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired.
2. Bind using 2 1/4" **B** strips.

Making the Marker

3. Cut out the arrow outline template. Pin it to (1) **C** 4" x 7" rectangle and trace the shape using a fabric marking pen. Layer the unmarked **C** 4" x 7" rectangle right side down, then the batting rectangle, and then marked rectangle right side up. Pin layers together. Stitch on the marked line.



4. Using a pinking shears to prevent frayed edges, cut out the arrow 1/4" past the stitching line, cutting through all (3) layers.
