

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

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Piecing Instructions:

Note: All seam allowances are 1/4"

BLOCK 1:

1. Sew the following 20-1/2" length strips together along the long side. Square to 16-1/2" X 20-1/2", make (2).

A 2-1/2" – **G** 2-1/2" – **A** 1-1/2" – **F** 4-1/2" – **A** 2-1/2" – **H** 3-1/2" – **A** 2-1/2"

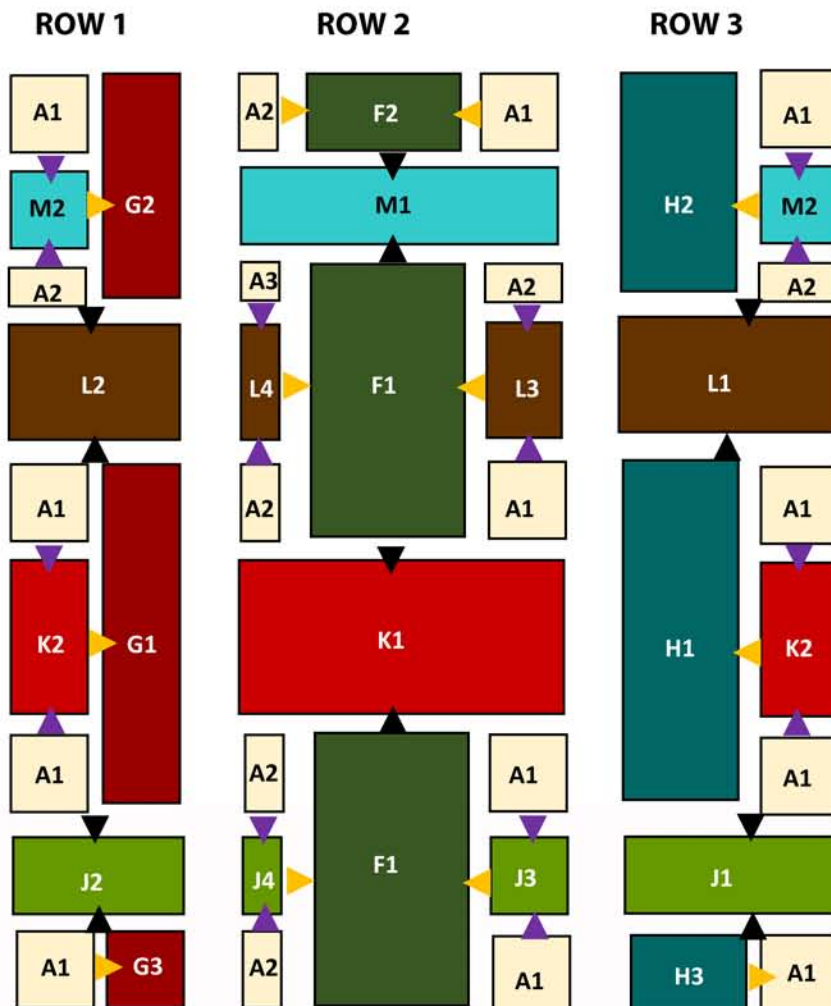
BLOCK 2:

2. Sew the following 16-1/2" length strips together along the long side. Square to 16-1/2" X 20-1/2", make (2).

A 2-1/2" – **M** 2-1/2" – **A** 1-1/2" – **L** 3-1/2" – **A** 2-1/2" – **K** 4-1/2" – **A** 2-1/2" – **J** 2-1/2" – **A** 2-1/2"

BLOCK 3:

3. Following diagram below, sew pieces together to create (3) vertical rows. In each row sew seams indicated with a purple arrow first, orange arrow second and black arrows third. Sew rows together to complete BLOCK 3, square to 16-1/2" X 20-1/2", make (1).



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BLOCK 4:

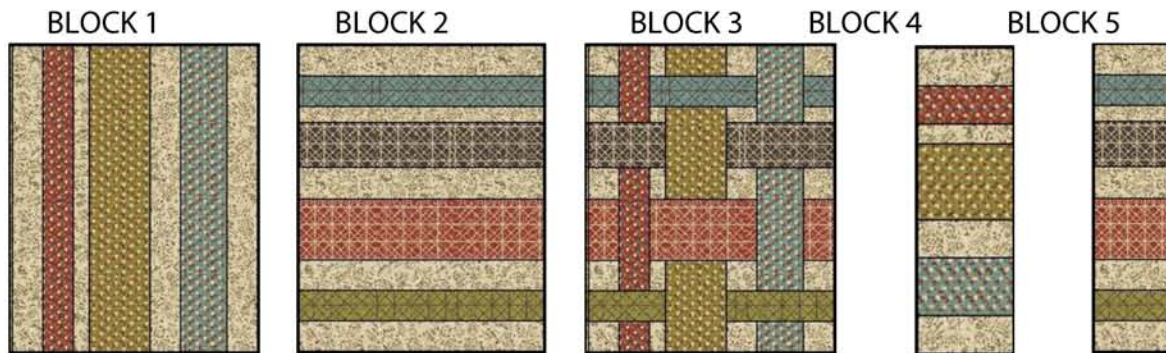
4. Sew the following 5-1/2" length strips together along the long side. Square to 5-1/2" X 16-1/2", make (2).

A 2-1/2" – **G** 2-1/2" – **A** 1-1/2" – **F** 4-1/2" – **A** 2-1/2" – **H** 3-1/2" – **A** 2-1/2"

BLOCK 5:

5. Sew the following 5-1/2" length strips together along the long side. Square to 5-1/2" X 20-1/2", make (2).

A 2-1/2" – **M** 2-1/2" – **A** 1-1/2" – **L** 3-1/2" – **A** 2-1/2" – **K** 4-1/2" – **A** 2-1/2" – **J** 2-1/2" – **A** 2-1/2"



Assembly Instructions: (Refer to quilt diagram for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

Quilt Assembly:

6. Sew blocks into horizontal rows, then sew rows together.
ROW 1: **B** 16-1/2" x 20-1/2" rectangle – **BLOCK 1** – **C** 16-1/2" X 20-1/2" rectangle
ROW 2: **BLOCK 2** – **BLOCK 3** – **BLOCK 2**
ROW 3: **C** 16-1/2" x 20-1/2" rectangle – **BLOCK 1** – **B** 16-1/2" X 20-1/2" rectangle

Border Unit Assembly:

RIGHT SIDE BORDER UNIT:

7. Sew the following together along the 5-1/2" side (listed from top to bottom), then sew (1) **E** 2-1/2" X 67-1/2" strip to left side.
D 5-1/2" X 20-1/2" strip – **BLOCK 5** – **D** 5-1/2" X 20-1/2" strip – **I** 2-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip – **D** 5-1/2" square

LEFT SIDE BORDER UNIT:

8. Sew the following together along the 5-1/2" side (listed from top to bottom), then sew (1) **E** 2-1/2" X 67-1/2" strip to right side.
D 5-1/2" square – **I** 2-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip – **D** 5-1/2" X 20-1/2" strip – **BLOCK 5** – **D** 5-1/2" X 20-1/2" strip

TOP BORDER UNIT:

9. Sew the following together along the 5-1/2" side (listed from left to right), then sew (1) **I** 2-1/2" X 55-1/2" strip to bottom.
D 5-1/2" X 16-1/2" strip – **BLOCK 4** – **D** 5-1/2" X 16-1/2" strip – **E** 2-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip – **D** 5-1/2" square

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BOTTOM BORDER UNIT

10. Sew the following together along the 5-1/2" side (listed from left to right), then sew (1) **I** 2-1/2" X 55-1/2" strip to top.

D 5-1/2" square - **E** 2-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip - **D** 5-1/2" X 16-1/2" strip - **BLOCK 4** - **D** 5-1/2" X 16-1/2" strip

Border Assembly:

11. Sew Right Border Unit to right side of quilt, stopping 4" from end of quilt center, creating a partial seam (this will be closed in a later step). Press with seam allowances towards the **E** strip. (See **red** arrow on quilt diagram)
12. Sew Top Border Unit to top of quilt. Press with seam allowances towards the **I** strip. (See **blue** arrow on quilt diagram)
13. Sew Left Border Unit to left side of quilt. Press with seam allowances towards the **E** strip. (See **green** arrow on quilt diagram)
14. Sew Bottom Border Unit to bottom of quilt. Press with seam allowances towards the **I** strip. (See **purple** arrow on quilt diagram)
15. Finish partial Right Border Unit seam created in step 11, then press. (See black arrow on quilt diagram)

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
