

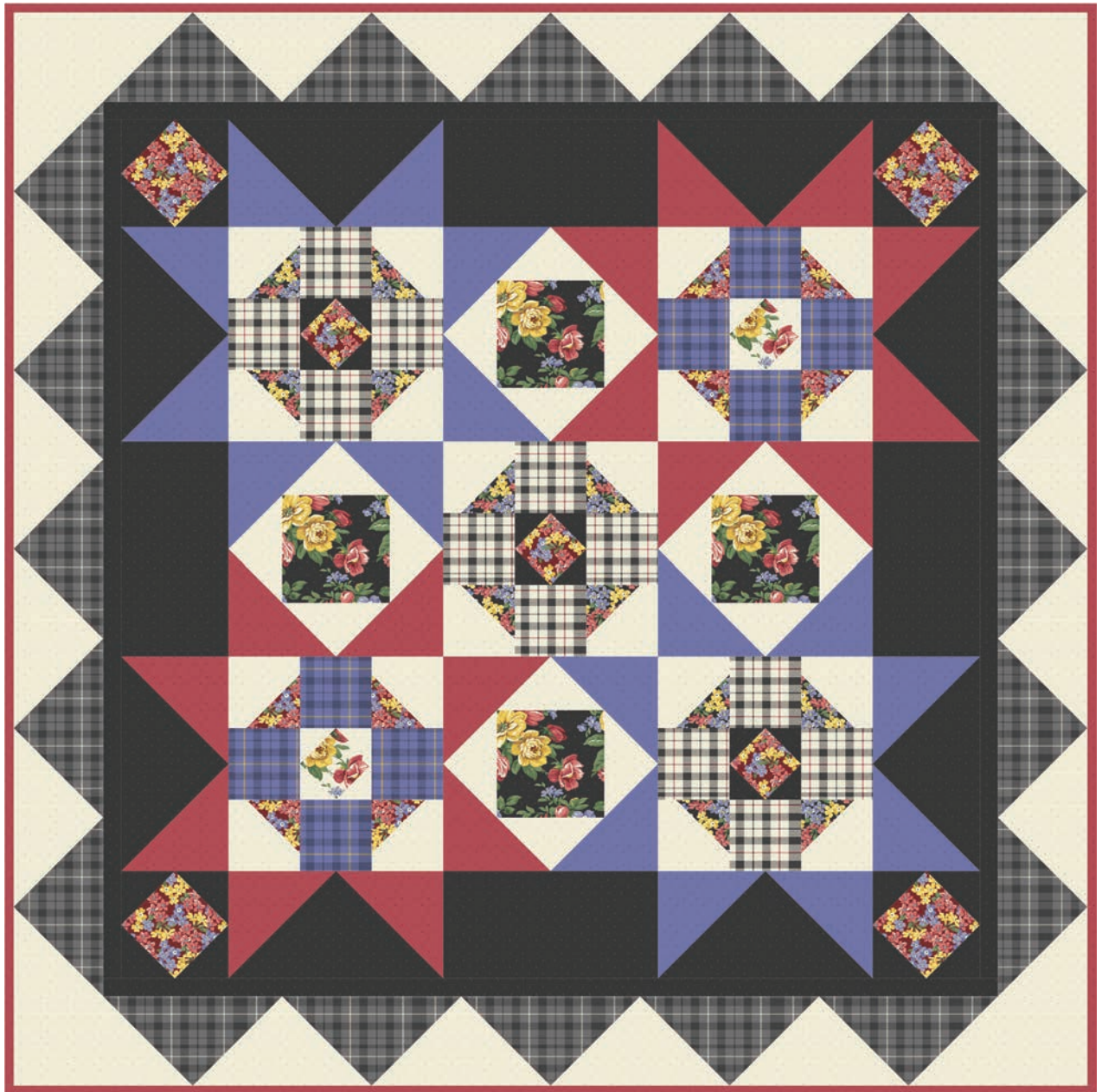



| A | | 51087-1 Cream | 1/8 | (2) 3-3/8" squares. |
| B | | 51087-3 Black | 1/4 | (1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares. |
| C | | 51088-3 Black | 1/8 | (1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares. |
| D | | 51088-5 Wine | 3/8 | (1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares. Trim down remaining strip to 3-3/8" wide and cut (3) 3-3/8" squares. (1) 4-3/4" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 4-3/4" squares. |
| E | | 51089-1 Cream | 3/8 | (2) 4-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (12) 4-1/2" squares. |
| F | | 51089-2 Periwinkle | 1/4 | (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (8) 4-1/2" squares. |
| G | | 51089-3 Black | 3/4 | (2) 11-1/4" x WOF strips; subcut (5) 11-1/4" squares, cut twice diagonally. |
| H | | 51090-1 Cream | 1-3/8 | (2) 11-1/4" x WOF strips; subcut (4) 11-1/4" squares, cut twice diagonally. Save and use remaining strip to cut (4) 5-7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal and (4) 5-1/2" squares. (3) 4-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (20) 4-1/2" squares. (1) 7-1/4" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 7-1/4" squares, cut twice on diagonal, and (4) 2-7/8" squares, cut once diagonally. |
| I | | 51090-2 Periwinkle | 1/2 | (2) 6-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (8) 6-7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal. |

| J |  | 51090-3 Black | 1-1/4 | <p>Inner Border: (5) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew end to end and subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips.</p> <p>(1) 2-7/8" x WOF strip; subcut (6) 2-7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal.</p> <p>(1) 12-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>(1) 3-7/8" x WOF strip; subcut (8) 3-7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal.</p> <p>(1) 13-1/4" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 13-1/4" squares, cut twice on diagonal.</p> |
| K |  | 51090-7 Rose | 1 | <p>(2) 6-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (8) 6-7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal.</p> <p>Binding: (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.</p> |

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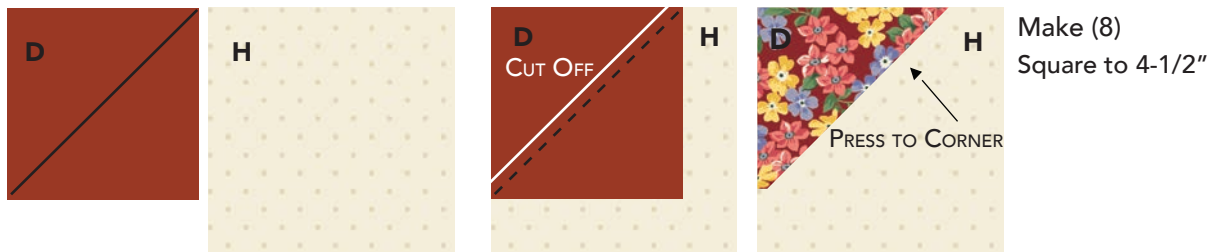
Cutting Notes: Mark and store the cut pieces according to the sizes and fabric key, as this will make it much easier when you start piecing.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Blue Cross Block:

1. Unit D/H: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **D** 3-1/2" square. Place right sides together on the corner of (1) **H** 4-1/2" square. Sew on the drawn line, trim to 1/4" seam allowance and press to the corner. Square to 4-1/2". Make (8).
2. Row 1: Sew a Unit D/H to both sides of (1) **F** 4-1/2" square, rotating the units as shown. Block should measure 12-1/2" x 4-1/2". Make (4).
3. Unit A/H: Sew the long side of (4) **H** 2-7/8" triangles to all four sides of (1) **A** 3-3/8" square. Square to 4-1/2". Make (2).
4. Row 2: Sew (1) **F** 4-1/2" square to both sides of Unit A/H. Measures 12-1/2" x 4-1/2". Make (2).

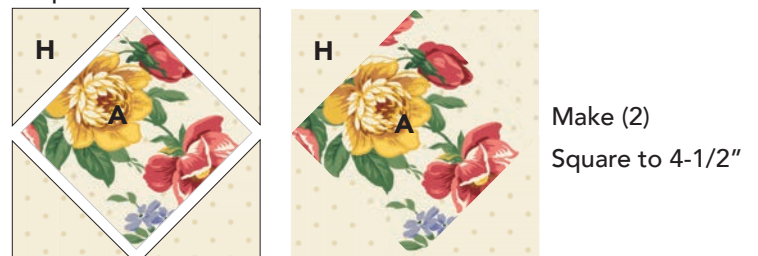

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5. Sew Row 1 on top of Row 2. Rotate and sew the remaining Row 1 to the bottom of Row 2 to complete the block. Block should measure 12-1/2". Make (2).

Blue Cross Block

Black Cross Block:

- 6. Unit C/H: Repeat Step 1, using (1) **C** 3-1/2" square and (1) **H** 4-1/2" square. Make (12).
- 7. Row 1: Repeat Step 2, sewing a Unit C/H to both sides of (1) **E** 4-1/2" square. Make (6).
- 8. Unit D/J: Repeat Step 3 using (4) **J** triangles and (1) **D** 3-3/8" square. Make (3).
- 9. Row 2: Repeat Step 4 sewing **E** 4-1/2" squares to the sides of Unit D/J. Make (3).



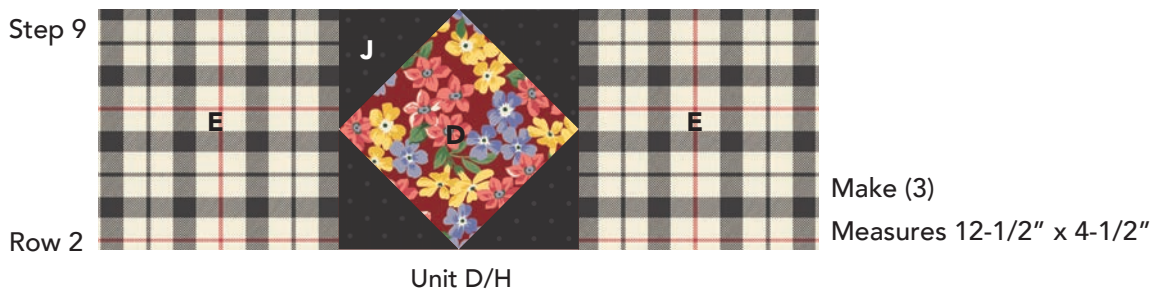

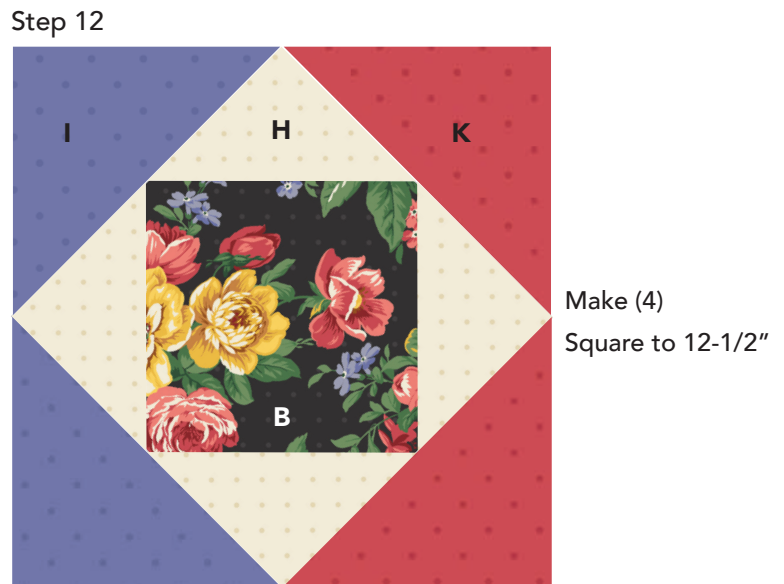
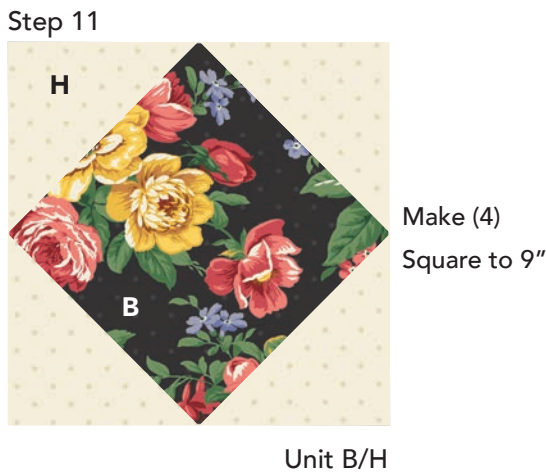
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- 10.** Repeat Step 5 using the rows in Step 7 and 9 to complete the block.
Block should measure 12-1/2". Make (3).



Square in a Square Block

- 11.** Unit B/H: Sew the long side of a **H** 7-1/4" triangle to all four sides of (1) **B** 6-1/2" square.
Square to 9". Make (4).
- 12.** Sew the long sides of (1) **I** 6-7/8" triangle to two adjacent sides of Unit B/H. Sew the long sides of (1) **K** 6-7/8" triangle to the last two sides to complete the block. Square to 12-1/2". Make (4).





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QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

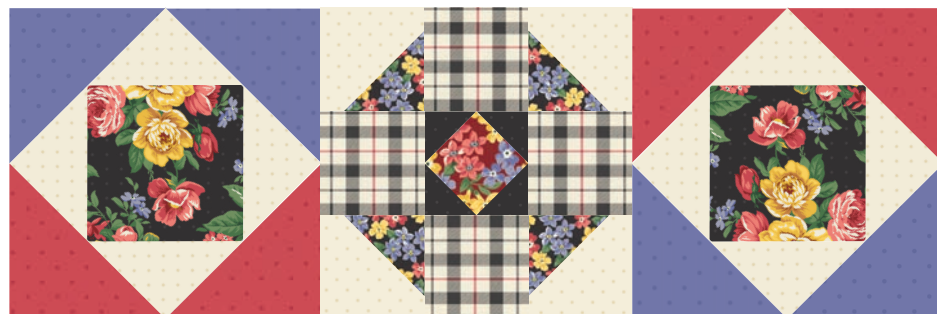
- 13.** Sew a Black Crossed Block to the blue side (I) of a Square in a Square Block. Sew a Blue Crossed Block to the red side (K) to complete Row 1 of the quilt as shown. Measures 36-1/2" x 12-1/2". Make (2).
- 14.** Rotate the red side (K) of a Square in a Square Block to the bottom and sew a Black Crossed Block to the right side. Rotate another Square in a Square Block with (K) facing up and sew to the end of the Black Crossed Block as shown to complete Row 2. Measures 36-1/2" x 12-1/2".
- 15.** Sew Quilt Row 1 to the top of Quilt Row 2. Rotate the remaining Row 1 and sew to the bottom of Row 2 to complete the Quilt Center.

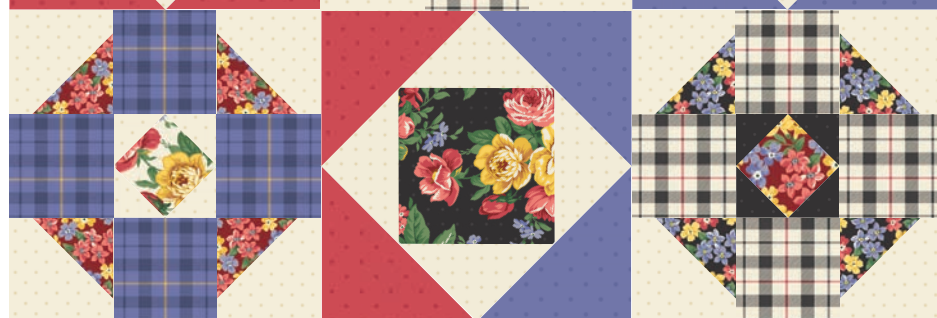

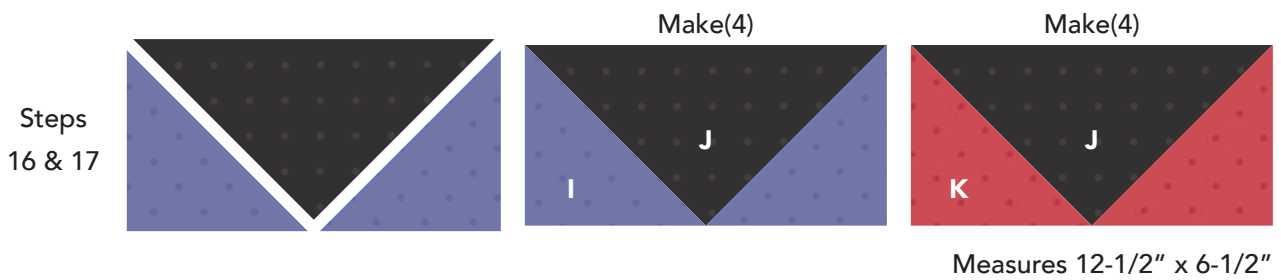




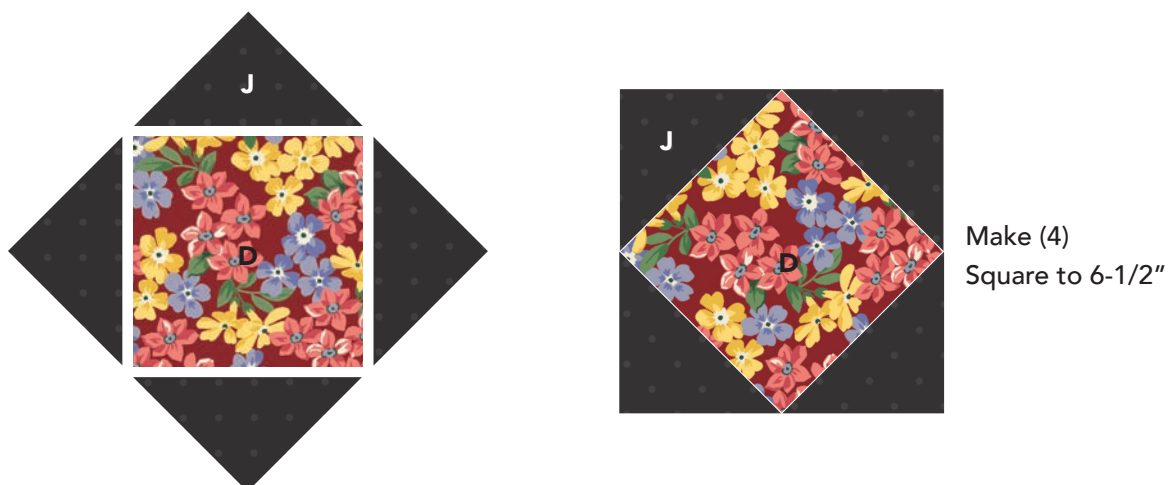
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INNER BORDER

- 16. Flying Geese Unit I/J: Sew the long diagonal side of (2) **I** 6-7/8" triangles to the short sides of (1) **J** 13-1/4" triangle. Should measure 12-1/2" x 6-1/2". Make (4).
- 17. Flying Geese Unit K/J: Repeat Step 16 using (2) **K** 6-7/8" triangles and (1) **J** 13-1/4" triangle.
- 18. Border Row: Sew a Flying Geese Unit I/J to the left short end of (1) **J** 12-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle, followed by a Flying Geese Unit K/J to the right end of **J**. Measures 36-1/2" x 6-1/2". Make (2).
- 19. Repeat Step 18, but reverse the Flying Geese Units as shown. Make (2).



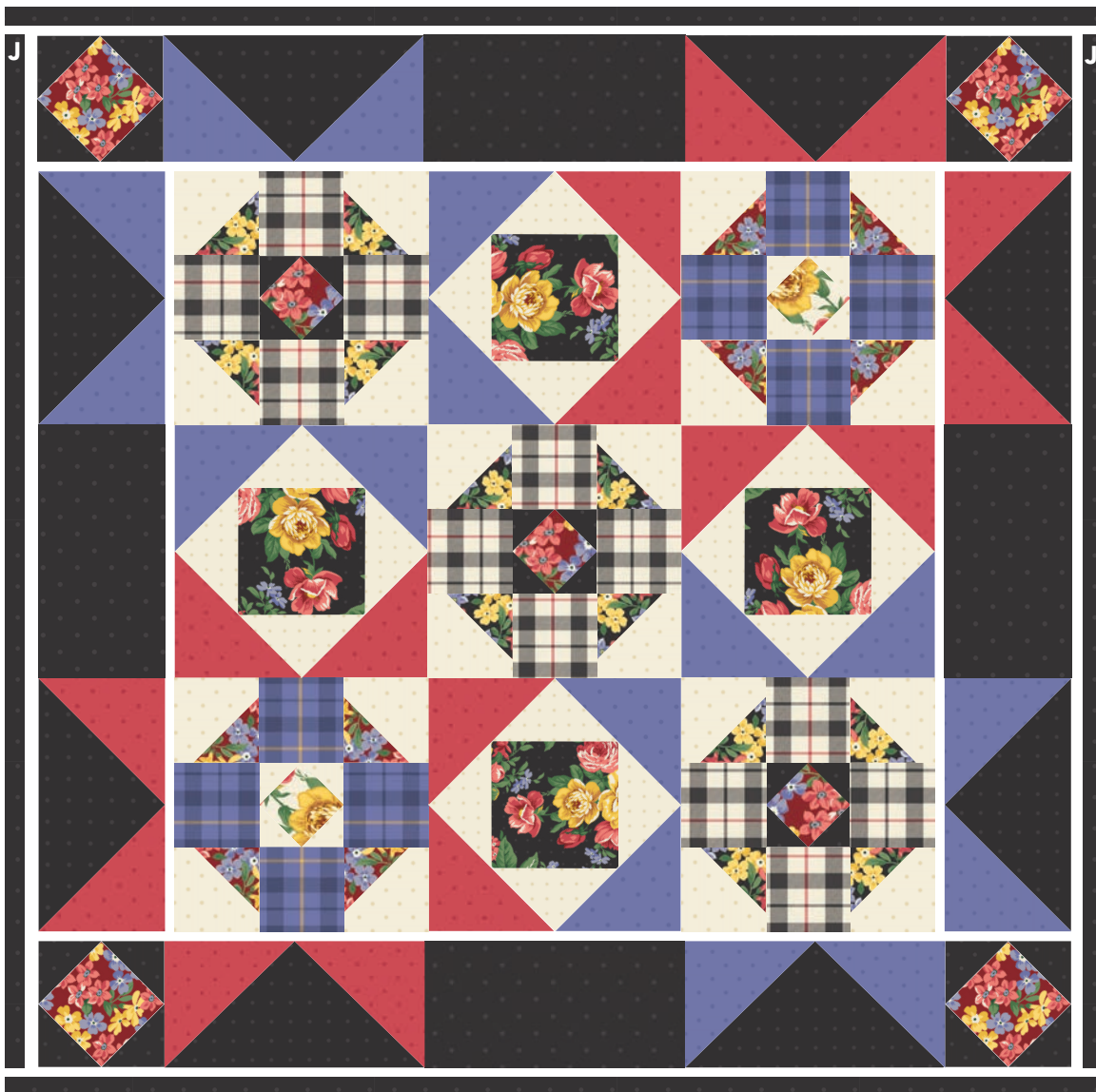
- 20. Cornerstone Block: Sew the long side of (1) **J** 3-7/8" triangle to all four sides of (1) **D** 4-3/4" square. Square to 6-1/2". Make (4).





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21. Sew a row from **Step 19** to both sides of the **Quilt Center**, rotating to make sure the black center point faces inward as shown.
22. Sew a **Cornerstone Block** to both short ends of a **Flying Geese Row** from **Step 18**. Make (2).
23. Sew the **Flying Geese Row** from **Step 22** to the top and bottom of the **Quilt**, again with the black center points facing inward.
24. Sew (1) **J** 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" strip to both sides of the **Quilt Center**. Sew (1) **J** 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.





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OUTER BORDER

25. Sew the short sides of (5) **G** 11-1/4" triangles in a row, alternating with (4) **H** 11-1/4" triangles as shown. Then sew the long side of (1) **H** 5-7/8" triangle to the ends of the rows. Make (4).
26. Sew (1) **H** 5-1/2" square to both ends of (2) border rows from Step 25.
27. Sew (2) triangle rows from Step 25 to both sides of the quilt, making sure the black plaid points face outwards.
28. Sew the (2) border rows from Step 26 to the top and bottom to complete the top of the quilt top.

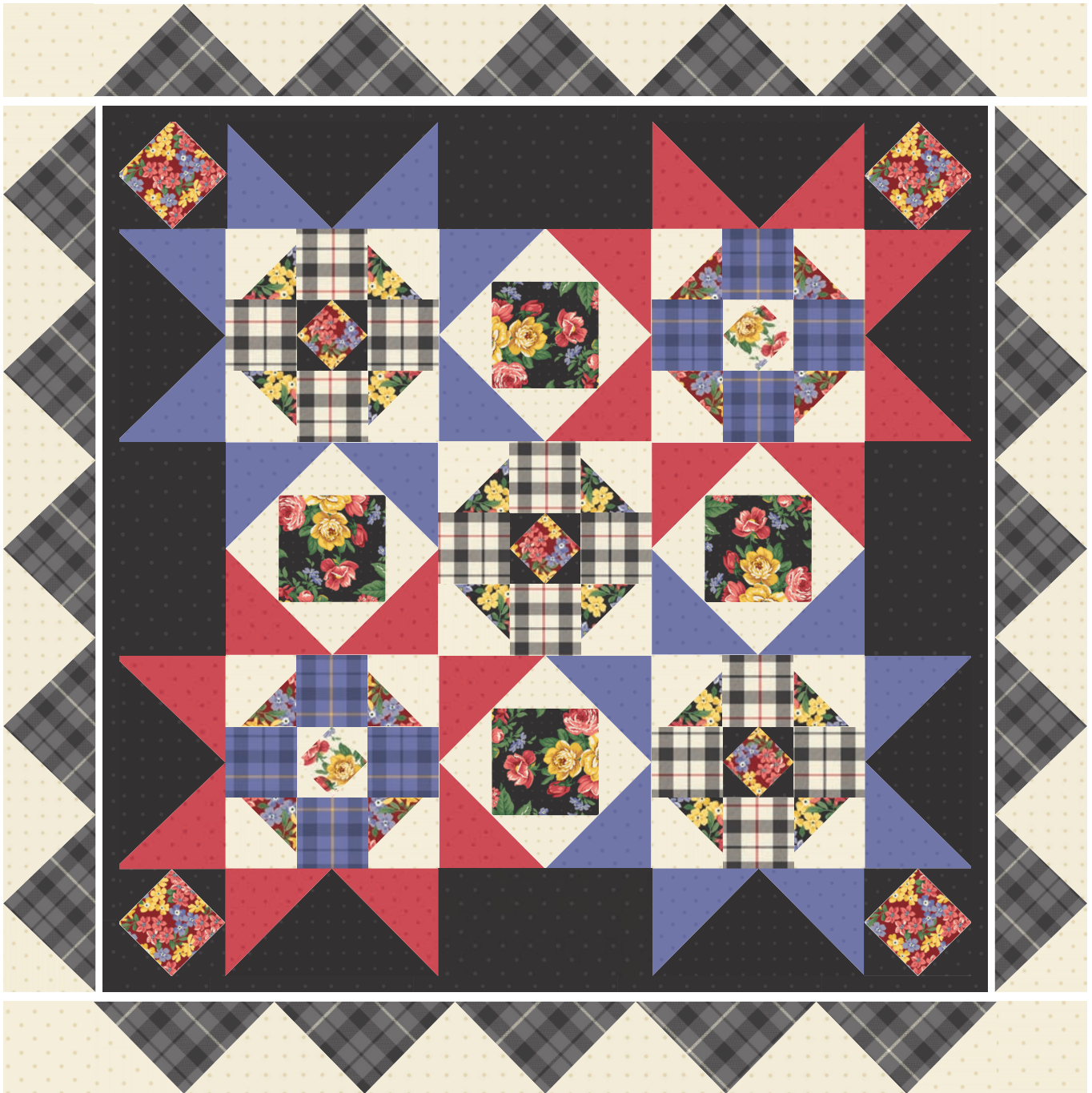

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **K** 2-1/2" strips.
