

Tick Tock

Cutting Notes: Mark and store your cutting pieces according to the block they have been assigned to, as this will make it much easier when you start piecing. Be sure to read the entire pattern before you begin. This pattern involves appliqué techniques.

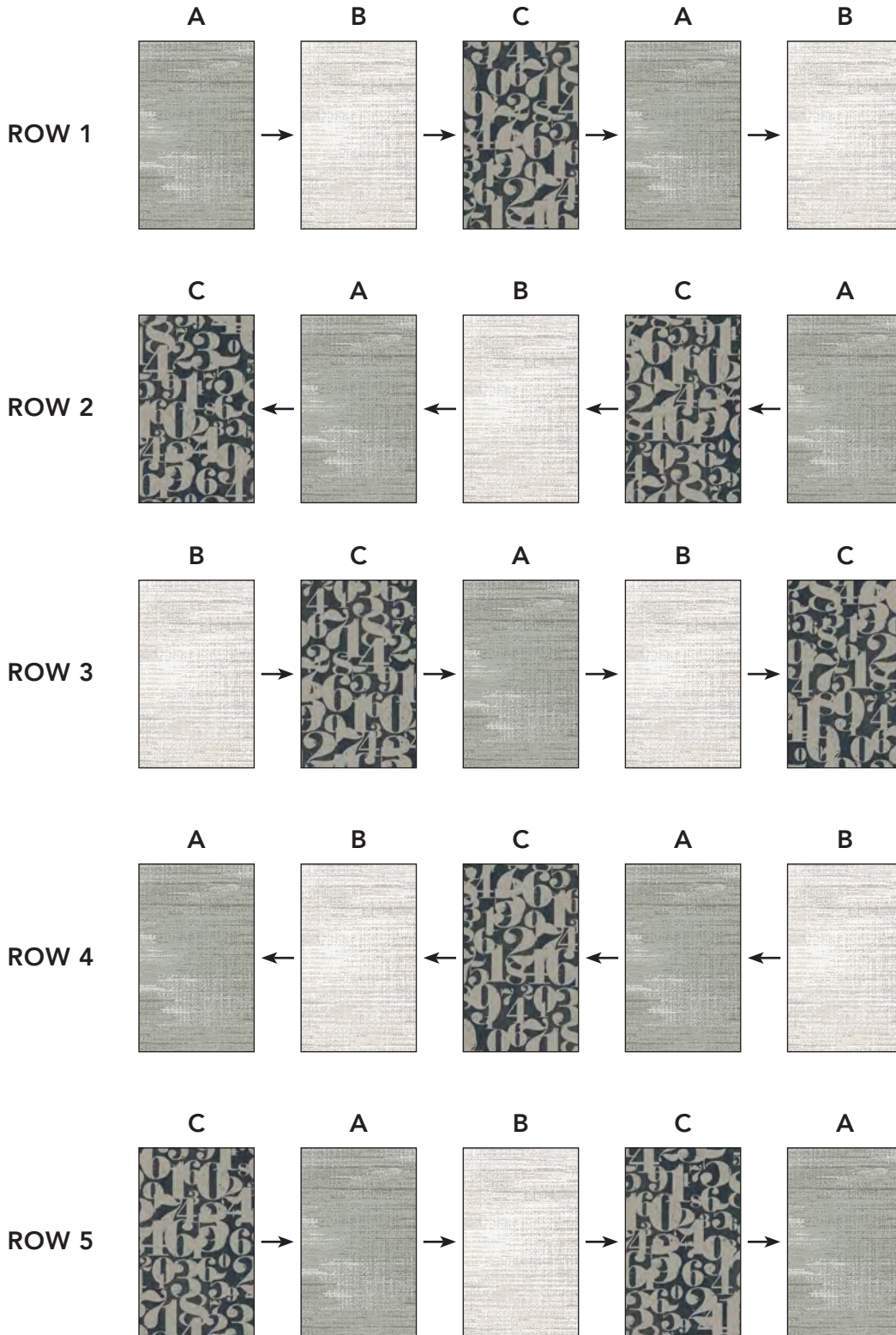

Quilt Center

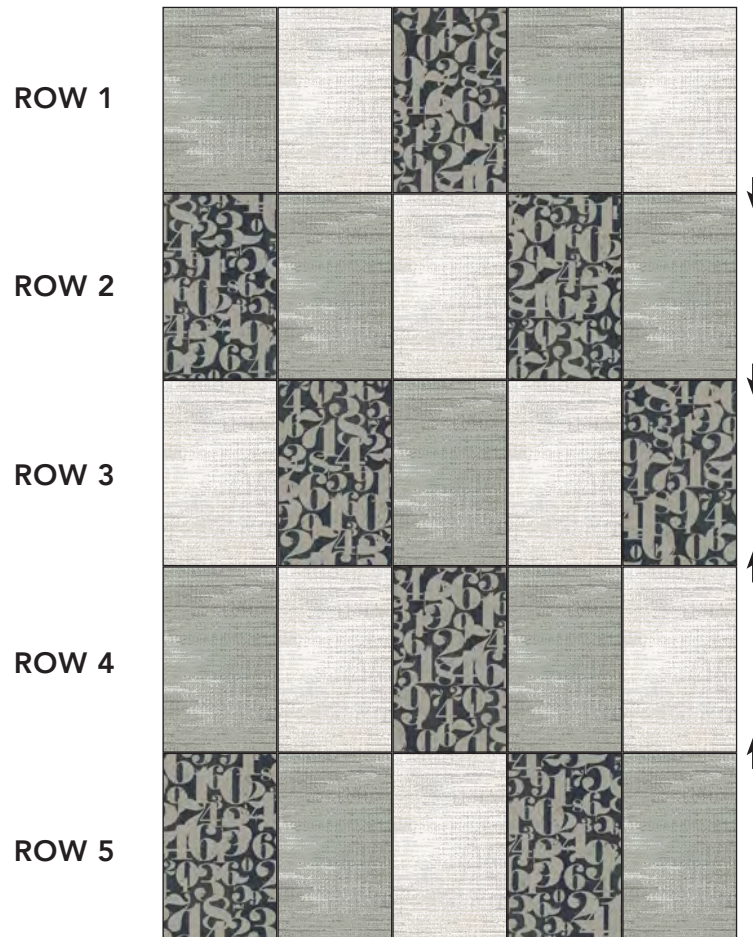
1. Using **Fabrics A, B, and C** 4½" x 7" rectangles, assemble row units as shown below. Row Units should measure 7" x 20½". Make a total of (5) Row Units.





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2. Sew rows together to complete quilt center as shown below. Quilt Center should measure 20½" x 33".



Clock Appliqué

3. When appliquéing clock faces, use your preferred appliqué method. *Heat 'n Bond* adhesive is recommended - follow the manufacturer's directions. Appliqué (2) **Fabric H** Template 4 clock hands, (1) **Fabric H** Template 3 circle and (1) **Fabric G** Template 1 circle as shown.



4. Appliqué clock face onto **Fabric F** Template 6 as shown.





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5. Appliqué (2) **Fabric H** Template 2 clock hands, (1) **Fabric H** Template 3 circle and (1) **Fabric G** Template 6 circle as shown.



6. Appliqué clock face onto **Fabric E** Template 7 as shown.



7. Appliqué (2) **Fabric H** Template 5 clock hands, (1) **Fabric H** Template 3 circle and (1) **Fabric G** Template 8 circle as shown.



8. Appliqué clock face onto **Fabric D** Template 9 as shown.





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Quilt Assembly

9. Place clock faces as shown below, fuse and appliqué using your preferred method. Quilt Center should measure 20½" x 33".



10. Sew (1) 2½" x 33" strip to the left and right sides of Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 24½" x 33".





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11. Sew (1) 2½" x 24½" strip to the top and bottom of Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 24½" x 37".



Finishing

12. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich.
13. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired.
14. Bind with **Fabric H** to finish quilt.



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QUILT ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM

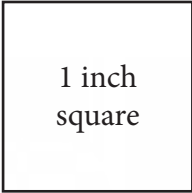




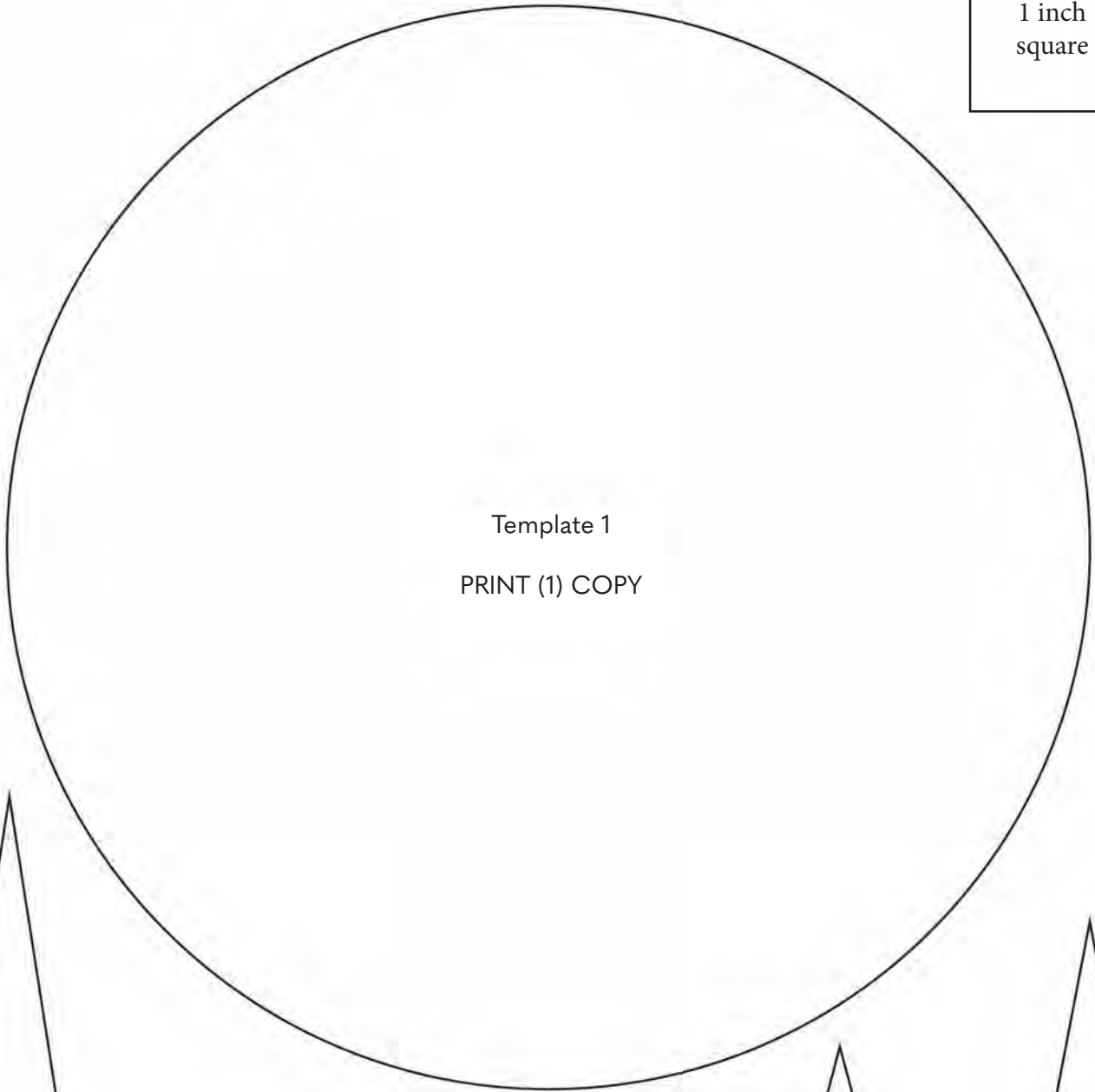
