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## Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A: Main Panel - Multi

- Fussy cut one $201 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 231 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ large panel.
- Fussy cut four $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares each centered on a small panel.

Fabric B: Leaves - Tan

- Cut four 2" x $2311 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Width of Fabric (WOF) strips.
- Cut two 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 2" x 8 1⁄2" strips.
- Cut three 2" $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight $2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric C: Stamps - Aqua

- Cut two $31 \not 12^{\prime \prime} \times 251 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
- Cut two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.

Fabric D: Basket Weave - Jungle

- Cut four $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times 311 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
- Cut four $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 281 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.

Fabric E: Birds - White

- Cut two $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- Cut two $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 281 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strips.

Fabric F: Batik - Aqua

- Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut three $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $3^{\prime \prime} \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (112) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric G: Leaves - Green

- Cut one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut seven $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into fifty-eight $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Backing: Photos - Multi

- Cut two $68^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to $68^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{\prime \prime}$ for the pieced back.


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## Block Assembly:

1. Sew one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 231 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to each side of one Fabric A large panel. Sew one 2" x 23 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A large panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 251 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
2. Sew one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to each side of one $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A small panel. Sew one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 11$ 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small panel to make one Block One square (Fig. 2). Trim the block to measure $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$.

3. Place one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square on the lower left corner of one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G square, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 4).
4. Follow Figure 5 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square to the lower right corner of the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G square to make one Unit 1 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make fifty-four Unit 1 squares total.
5. Place one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square on the lower right corner of one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam to make one Unit 2 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make four Unit 2 squares total.

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6. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 31 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ strip to each side of one $8 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 31 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip lengthwise to make one Unit 3 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Unit 3 strip.
7. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 28 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of one $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 281 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip lengthwise to make one Unit 4 strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second Unit 4 strip.

8. Sew together fourteen Unit 1 squares to make one Side Border Strip (Fig. 10). Pay attention to the unit orientations. Repeat to make a second Side Border Strip.

9. Sew together two Unit 2 squares and thirteen Unit 1 squares to make one Top Border Strip. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Repeat to make one Bottom Border Strip. Pay attention to the unit orientations.

## Quilt Assembly - Refer to the Quilt Layout below while assembling the quilt top:

10. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 251 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G square to each end of one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to make one Top Inner Border Strip. Repeat to make one Bottom Inner Border Strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew one Unit 3 strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one Block One square to each end of one Unit 4 strip to make one Top Middle Border Strip. Repeat to make one Bottom Middle Border Strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

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12. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one $3^{\prime \prime} \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew one Side Border Strip to each side of the Center Block. Pay attention to the strip orientation. Sew one Top Border Strip and one Bottom Border Strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top. Pay attention to the strip orientations.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together end-to-end with 45-degree seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.
