

Fabric Picture	Quantity	Fabric Number	Placement of Fabric	Cutting
	5/8 yard	40325-X Multi	Border	Cut four 2 3/4" strips. Recut into eight 16 ½" pieces. Cut three 1 ½" strips. Recut into eight 13 ½" pieces.
	3/8 yard	40329-2 Light Denim	Border	Cut seven 1 ½" strips. Recut into eight 14 ½" pieces, eight 9" pieces, four 7" pieces.
	1/4 yard	40326M-1 Denim	Star	Cut four stars.
	1/4 yard	40328-3 Red	Star Background	Cut one 7" strip. Recut into four 7" squares.
	1/4 yard	40331-3 Red	Star	Cut four stars.
	1/4 yard	White	Star Background	Cut one 7" strip. Recut into four 7" squares.
	5/8 yard	40327M-X Multi	Binding	Cut six 2 1/4" strips. Join with diagonal seams.
****	1 yard	40326M-2 Light Denim	Backing	Cut two 15" strips and divide each in half to make four backing pieces.



Assembly Directions

- 1. Using your favorite applique method make star blocks as pictured.
- For each placemat join two stars with a 7" border strip press seams toward darker fabric. Add borders to top and bottom of the blocks and press seams toward darker fabric. Add side borders and press.
- Add outside 2 ¾" borders to the top and bottom, press toward darker fabric. Add
 1 ½" outside borders to the sides and press.
- 4. Make quilt sandwiches and quilt as desired. Bind and enjoy!
