KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A		50542-1 red	7/8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• (1) 9-1/4" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 9-1/4" square and (2) 8-3/8" squares. Cut the 9-1/4" square across both diagonals to make (4) large triangles. Note: Only (2) large triangles will be used. Cut (1) 8-3/8" square across one diagonal to make (2) X-large triangles. Note: Only (1) X-large triangle will be used.</li> <li>• (1) 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 5-1/4" squares. Cut each 5-1/4" square across both diagonals to make (32) small triangles.</li> <li>• (2) 4-7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 4-7/8" squares. Cut (8) 4-7/8" squares across one diagonal to make (16) medium triangles.</li> </ul>

Cut each 5-1/4" square across both diagonals to make (32) small triangles.</li><li>• (2) 4-7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4-7/8" squares. Cut (8) squares across one diagonal to make (16) medium triangles.</li></ul>
H		50544-2 denim	1-5/8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• (1) 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 5-1/4" squares. Cut each 5-1/4" square across both diagonals to make (32) small triangles.</li><li>• (2) 4-7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4-7/8" squares. Cut (8) squares across one diagonal to make (16) medium triangles.</li><li>• (4) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips end to end with a diagonal seam and cut (2) 4-1/2 x 70-1/2" strips.</li><li>• (4) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips end to end with a diagonal seam and cut (2) 4-1/2" x 62-1/2" strips.</li></ul>

I		50542-4 chambray	1-1/4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• (2) 5-1/4" x WOF strips Sub-cut the strips into (16) 5-1/4" squares. Cut each 5-1/4" square across both diagonals to make (64) small triangles.</li> <li>• (6) 4-7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 4-7/8" squares.</li> </ul>
J		50541-1 red	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• (4) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1-1/2" x 62-1/2" strips.</li> <li>• (4) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" strips.</li> </ul> <p><b>FOR BINDING:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.</li> </ul>
		50541-4 chambray Backing	4-1/2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• (2) 78" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 78" x 78" for the pieced back.</li> </ul>

## Block Assembly

1. Place (1) **A** 8-3/8" square on top of (1) **E** 8-3/8" square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) **Unit 1** squares. Trim the (2) **Unit 1** squares to measure 8" square (Fig. 3). *Note: You will only use one of the Unit 1 blocks.*

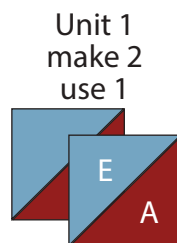

# Handkerchief

2. Repeat Step 1 and use Figures 4-6 for fabric identification to make (2) **Unit 2** squares, (2) **Unit 3** squares and (2) **Unit 4** squares. *Note: You will only use one unit each of the Unit 2, Unit 3 and Unit 4 squares.*

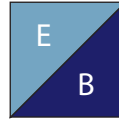

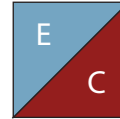

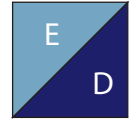

3. Sew together (1) **E** large triangle and (1) **B** large triangle to make (1) **EB** triangle. Pay attention to the triangle orientations. Sew the **EB** triangle to (1) **A** X-large triangle to make (1) **Unit 5** square (Fig. 7).

4. Sew together (1) **E** large triangle and (1) **C** large triangle to make (1) **EC** triangle. Pay attention to the triangle orientations. Sew the **EC** triangle to (1) **B** X-large triangle to make (1) **Unit 6** square (Fig. 8).

5. Sew together (1) **E** large triangle and (1) **D** large triangle to make (1) **ED** triangle. Pay attention to the triangle orientations. Sew the **ED** triangle to (1) **C** X-large triangle to make (1) **Unit 7** square (Fig. 9).

6. Sew together (1) **E** large triangle and (1) **A** large triangle to make (1) **EA** triangle. Pay attention to the triangle orientations. Sew the **EA** triangle to (1) **D** X-large triangle to make (1) **Unit 8** square (Fig. 10).

7. Sew together (1) **A** large triangle and (1) **B** large triangle to make (1) **AB** triangle. Pay attention to the triangle orientations. Sew together (1) **D** large triangle and (1) **C** large triangle to make (1) **DC** triangle. Pay attention to the triangle orientations. Sew the **AB** triangle to the **DC** triangle to make (1) **Unit 9** square (Fig. 11).

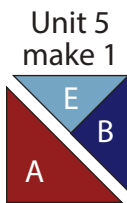

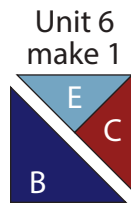

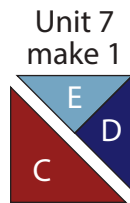

8. Follow Figure 12 to sew together (1) **Unit 1**, (1) **Unit 5** and (1) **Unit 2** to make the top row. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew together (1) **Unit 8**, (1) **Unit 9** and (1) **Unit 6** to make the middle row. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew together (1) **Unit 4**, (1) **Unit 7** and (1) **Unit 3** to make the bottom row. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew the rows together to make (1) **Unit 10** square (Fig. 12).

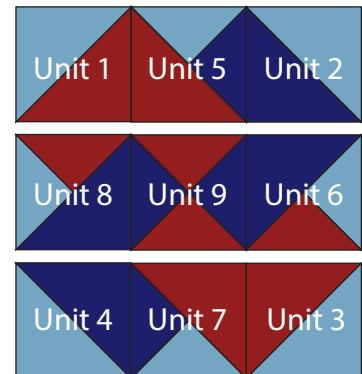


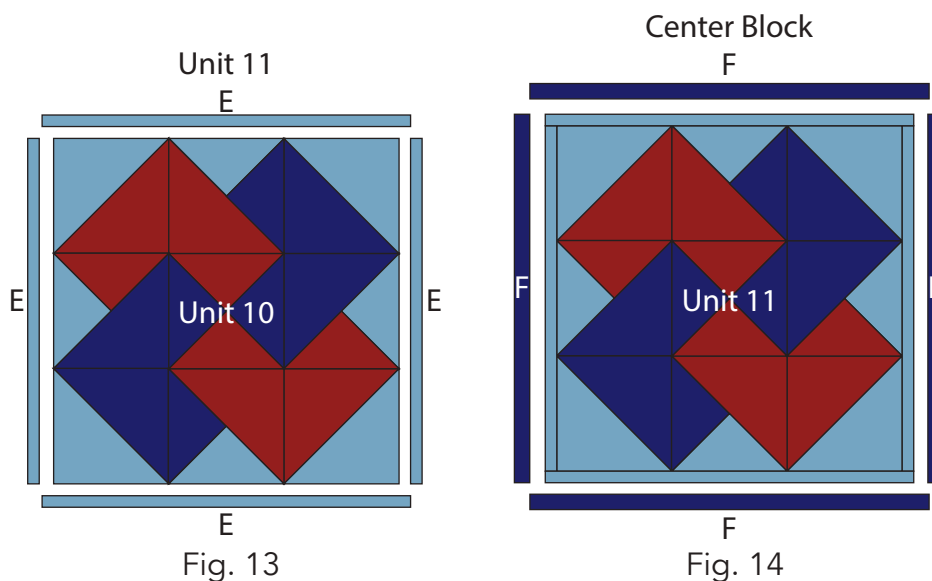

# Handkerchief

9. Sew (1) **E** 1-1/4" x 23" strip to each side of the **Unit 10** block. Sew (1) **E** 1-1/4" x 24-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Unit 10** square to make (1) **Unit 11** square (Fig. 13).

10. Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" strip to each side of the **Unit 11** block. Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x 26-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Unit 11** block to make the **Center Block** (Fig. 14).

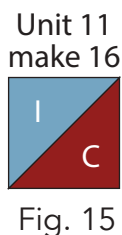


11. Repeat Step 1 with (8) **I** 4-7/8" squares and (8) **C** 4-7/8" squares to make (16) **Unit 11** squares (Fig. 15). Trim the units to measure 4-1/2" square.

12. Repeat Step 1 with (8) **I** 4-7/8" squares and (8) **H** 4-7/8" squares to make (16) **Unit 12** blocks (Fig. 16). Trim the units to measure 4-1/2" square.

13. Repeat Step 1 with (8) **I** 4-7/8" squares and (8) **A** 4-7/8" squares to make (16) **Unit 13** blocks (Fig. 17). Trim the units to measure 4-1/2" square.

14. Repeat Step 1 with (8) **I** 4-7/8" squares and (8) **G** 4-7/8" squares to make (16) **Unit 14** blocks (Fig. 18). Trim the units to measure 4-1/2" square.

**15.** Sew together (1) **I** small triangle and (1) **H** small triangle to make (1) **IH** triangle. Sew the **IH** triangle to (1) **C** medium triangle to make (1) **Unit 15** square (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (16) **Unit 15** squares total.

**16.** Sew together (1) **I** small triangle and (1) **A** small triangle to make (1) **IA** triangle. Sew the **IA** triangle to (1) **H** medium triangle to make (1) **Unit 16** square (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (16) **Unit 16** squares total.

**17.** Sew together (1) **I** small triangle and (1) **G** small triangle to make (1) **IG** triangle. Sew the **IG** triangle to (1) **A** medium triangle to make (1) **Unit 17** square (Fig. 21). Repeat to make (16) **Unit 17** squares total.

**18.** Sew together (1) **I** small triangle and (1) **C** small triangle to make (1) **IC** triangle. Sew the **IC** triangle to (1) **G** medium triangle to make (1) **Unit 18** square (Fig. 22). Repeat to make (16) **Unit 18** squares total.

**19.** Sew together (1) **C** small triangle and (1) **H** small triangle to make (1) **CH** triangle. Sew together (1) **G** small triangle and (1) **A** small triangle to make (1) **GA** triangle. Sew the **CH** triangle to the **GA** triangle to make (1) **Unit 19** square (Fig. 23). Repeat to make (16) **Unit 19** squares total.

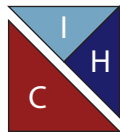

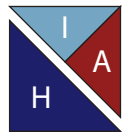

**20.** Sew together (1) **Unit 11**, (1) **Unit 15** and (1) **Unit 12** to make the top row. Sew together (1) **Unit 18**, (1) **Unit 19**, and (1) **Unit 16** to make the middle row. Sew together (1) **Unit 14**, (1) **Unit 17** and (1) **Unit 13** to make the bottom row. Sew the rows together to make (1) **Block One** square (Fig. 24). Repeat to make (16) **Block One** squares total.

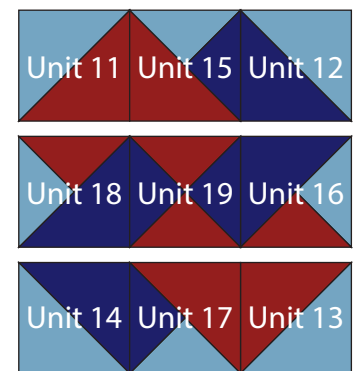

# Handkerchief

## Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Diagram while assembling the quilt top.)*

21. Sew (1) **C** 4-1/2" x 26-1/2" strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1) **C** 4-1/2" x 34-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.
22. Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.
23. Sew together (3) **Block One** squares one on top of another to make (1) **Side Border** strip. Repeat to make a second **Side Border** strip. Sew (1) **Side Border** to each side of the **Center Block**.
24. Sew together (5) **Block One** squares side by side to make (1) **Top Border** strip. Repeat to make (1) **Bottom Border** strip. Sew the borders to the top and bottom of the **Center Block**.
25. Sew (1) **J** 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **J** 1-1/2" x 62-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.
26. Sew (1) **H** 4-1/2" x 62-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **H** 4-1/2" x 70-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

## Finishing

27. Layer and quilt as desired.
28. Sew the (7) **J** 2-1/2" x WOF strips together end-to-end with 45-degree seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
29. Bind as desired.
