| O |  | White | 3/4 | (10) $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, sew ends together; subcut <br> (6) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and <br> (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. |

## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Thread to match fabrics
Sewing machine
Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
Basic sewing supplies

## SQUARE BLOCKS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (180) $\mathbf{K} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares using a marking pen. Use (20) squares for Square Blocks. Set aside the rest for
 Flying Geese blocks.
2. Lay (1) $\mathbf{K}$ square on one corner of (1) $\mathbf{B} 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the fabric 1/4" from the stitching as indicated by the solid line. Press the $\mathbf{K}$ piece open.
3. Sew $\mathbf{K}$ squares to remaining (3) corners of $\mathbf{B}$ square, trim and press. Unit should measure 6-1/2" square, including seam allowance. Make 1.
4. Repeat steps 2-3 using F, I, M and N 6-1/2" squares.

## RECTANGULAR FLYING GEESE BLOCKS

5. Lay (1) $\mathbf{K}$ square to one end of (1) A 3-1/2 $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the fabric $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the stitching as
 indicated by the solid line. Press the $\mathbf{K}$ piece open.
6. Sew (1) $\mathbf{K}$ square to the other end of the $\mathbf{A}$ rectangle, trim and press in the same manner to make a flying geese unit. Unit should measure $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, including seam allowance. Make 7.

7. Repeat steps 5-6 using the fabrics shown below. Make the number of blocks indicated.

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## VERTICAL ROW ASSEMBLY

8. Following the Quilt Layout on page 5, arrange and sew together (1) square block and (16) flying geese blocks into (5) vertical rows. Note proper orientation and placement of blocks. Vertical rows should measure 6-1/2" $\times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, including seam allowance.
9. Sew the (5) vertical rows together alternating with (4) O $2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to make the quilt center as shown in Quilt Layout. Quilt center should measure 36-1/2" x 54-1/2".

## BORDERS

10. Sew (1) O $2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (2) H $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to ends of (2) O $2^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
11. Sew (1) F 1-1/2" $\times 57-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of quilt. Sew (2) F $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of quilt.
12. Sew (1) J $4^{\prime \prime} \times 59-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border strips to each side of quilt center. Sew (2) J $4^{\prime \prime} \times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using M 2-1/4" strips.
