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## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Thread to match fabrics Basic sewing supplies

Sewing machine
Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

## BLOCKS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (64) $\mathbf{K} 2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
2. Place (1) $\mathbf{K} 2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square on (1) $\mathbf{J} 2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square with right sides together matching edges. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the diagonal line. Make (4).
3. Cut along the diagonal line to make (2) J/K HST (half square triangles). HST should measure 2-1/2" including seam allowance. Make (8).

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4. Sew (1) J/K HST to (1) $\mathbf{H} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square noting orientation of triangles. Make (1).

5. Sew (1) J/K HST to (1) I 2-1/2" square noting orientation of triangles. Make (1).

6. Sew rectangle units from Steps 4-5 together to make a corner square, matching seams. Make (4).

7. Sew (1) E 5-1/4" triangle to (1) J 5-1/4" triangle, noting orientation of triangles. Make (1).
8. Sew (1) E 5-1/4" triangle to (1) G 5-1/4" triangle, noting orientation of triangles. Make (1).

9. Sew $\mathbf{E} / \mathbf{J}$ triangle unit to $\mathbf{E} / \mathbf{G}$ triangle unit to make a square side unit, measuring 4-1/2" square. Make (4).

10. Arrange (1) A 4-1/2" square, (4) corner units and (4) side units in (3) rows as shown, noting the orientation of units. Sew the units in each row together.
11. Sew the rows together, matching seams, to make block 1 , measuring $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make (8).
12. Following steps 2-11, make (8) blocks using the fabrics shown to make block 2. Make (8).

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## PATCHWORK BORDER

13. Sew (1) $\mathbf{H} 4^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to (1) $\mathbf{K} 4^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to make (1) $\mathbf{H} / \mathbf{K}$ triangle unit. Make (10).
14. Sew (1) $\mathbf{G} 4^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to (1) $\mathbf{K} 4^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to make (1) $\mathbf{G} / \mathbf{K}$
 triangle unit. Make (9).
15. Sew (1) $\mathbf{G} 4^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to (1) $\mathbf{K} 2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to make (1) end
 unit noting orientation of triangles. Make (4).
16. Sew together (10) $\mathbf{H} / \mathbf{K}$ triangle units alternating with (9) $\mathbf{G} / \mathbf{K}$ triangle units. Sew (1) end unit to end of strip. Sew (1) K 2-1/4" triangle to first H/K triangle unit. Make (4).


## QUILT ASSEMBLY

17. Following the Quilt Layout on page 5, arrange the blocks in (4) rows of (4) blocks each alternating blocks 1 and blocks 2 .
18. Sew together (5) $\mathbf{K} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips alternating with (4) blocks to make each block row. Note position of blocks in each row. Make (4).
19. Sew together (5) $\mathbf{D} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares alternating with (4) $\mathbf{K} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to make the sashing rows. Make (5).
20. Sew together (5) sashing rows alternating with (4) block rows so blocks 1 and 2 alternate.

## BORDERS

21. Sew (1) H $2^{\prime \prime} \times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of quilt. Sew (1) H $2^{\prime \prime} \times 61-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to top and bottom of quilt.
22. Sew (1) A (2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 61-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of quilt. Sew (1) A $5^{\prime \prime} \times 70-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to top and bottom of quilt.
23. Sew (1) patchwork border to each side of quilt. Sew (2) $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{D}$ squares to ends for (2) patchwork borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using A 2-1/4" strips.
