A		42390-4 Grey	7/8	For HST units: 5 (4-7/8" x WOF). Subcut 40 (4-7/8") squares.
B		42385-X Multi	3/4	For HST units: 4 (4-7/8" x WOF). Subcut 32 (4-7/8") squares.
C		42388-1 White	2	For HST units: 8 (4-7/8" x WOF). Subcut 59 (4-7/8" squares. For border pieces: 4 (3-1/2" x WOF). Piece strips and subcut 1 (3-1/2" x 63-1/2") and 1 (3-1/2" x 72-1/2") strips. 3 (4-1/2" x WOF). Subcut 1 (4-1/2" x 36-1/2") from 1 strip. Piece remaining 2 strips and subcut 1 (4-1/2" x 48-1/2") strip
D		42387-3 Charcoal	3/4	For HST units: 4 (4-7/8" x WOF). Subcut 25 (4-7/8") squares.
E		42387-4 Grey	1	For HST units: 2 (4-7/8" x WOF). Subcut 15 (4-7/8") squares. For Binding: Cut 8 (2-1/4" x WOF) strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.
F		42387-2 Yellow	3/8	For HST units: 2 (4-7/8" x WOF). Subcut 14 (4-7/8") squares.
G		42388-2 Yellow	3/4	For HST units: 4 (4-7/8" x WOF). Subcut 32 (4-7/8") squares.
H		42391-2 Yellow	5/8	For HST units: 3 (4-7/8" x WOF). Subcut 19 (4-7/8") squares.
J		42386-1 White	5/8	For HST units: 3 (4-7/8" x WOF). Subcut 17 (4-7/8") squares.
K		42386-2 Yellow	3/8	For HST units: 2 (4-7/8" x WOF). Subcut 11 (4-7/8") squares.

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## Constructing HST units

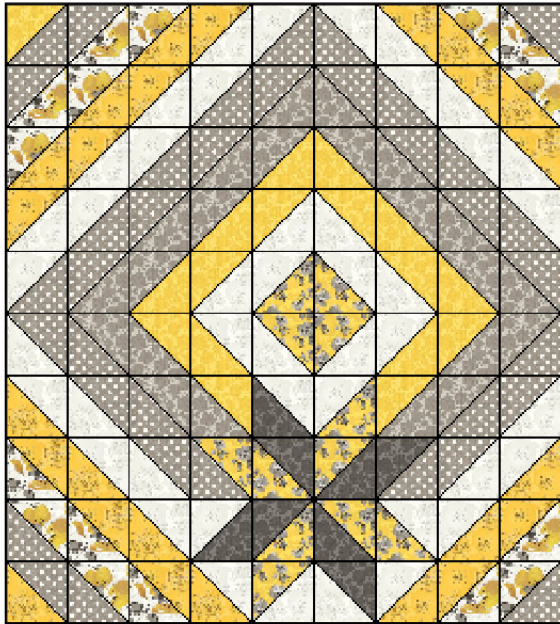
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (4 7/8" x 4 7/8") square of appropriate fabric. Place square, right sides together, on another (4 7/8" x 4 7/8") square of another fabric. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. Open and press to yield 2 HST units. Square units to 4-1/2".
2. Refer to accompanied HST chart on pgs 6 & 7 to make the number of HST units in appropriate fabrics. Please note that odd number HST units will result in 1 leftover HST unit.

## Quilt Top Assembly

**Note: In order to avoid multiple long seams, the quilt top is constructed by sections, although it is perfectly alright for quilters to construct quilt center using the row by row method. Construction of quilt top is not difficult, but does require quilter to account for the exact placement of the different HST units.**

1. Quilt center sections. Arrange and sew together HST units to make quilt center sections.

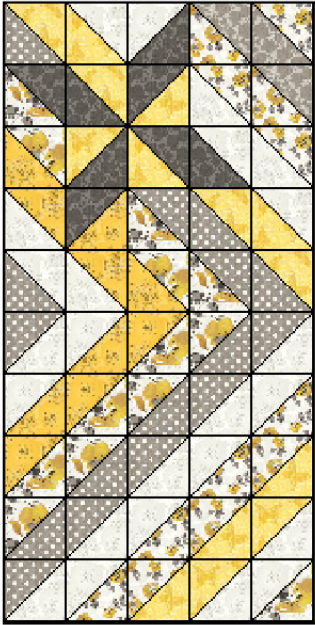

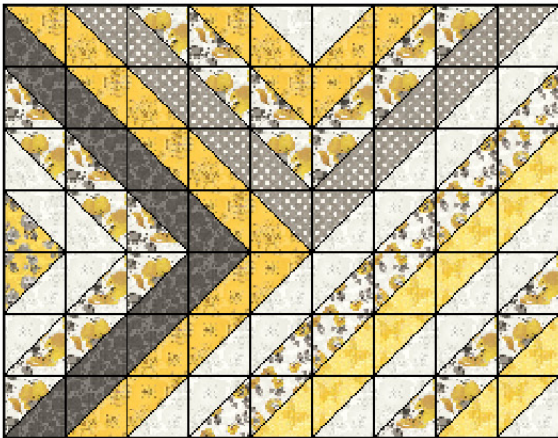

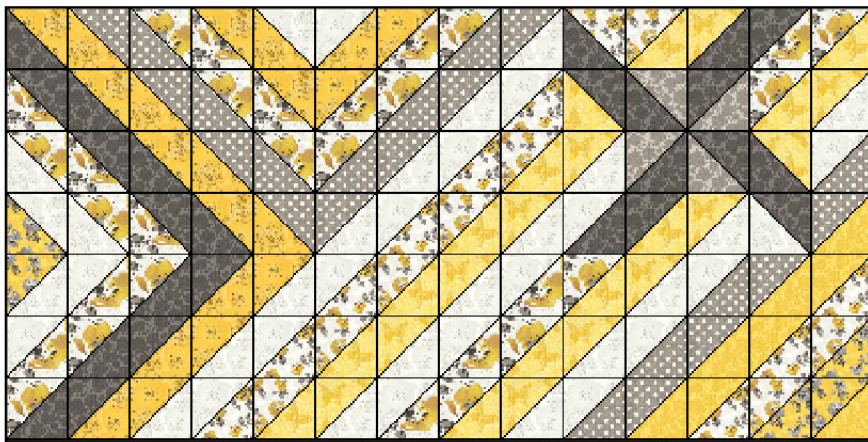

# Wind Chimes

Sew Sections 1 and 2 to complete top half of quilt center, and Sections 3 and 4 to complete bottom half of quilt center.



Sew both halves to complete quilt center.

## 2. Outer border.

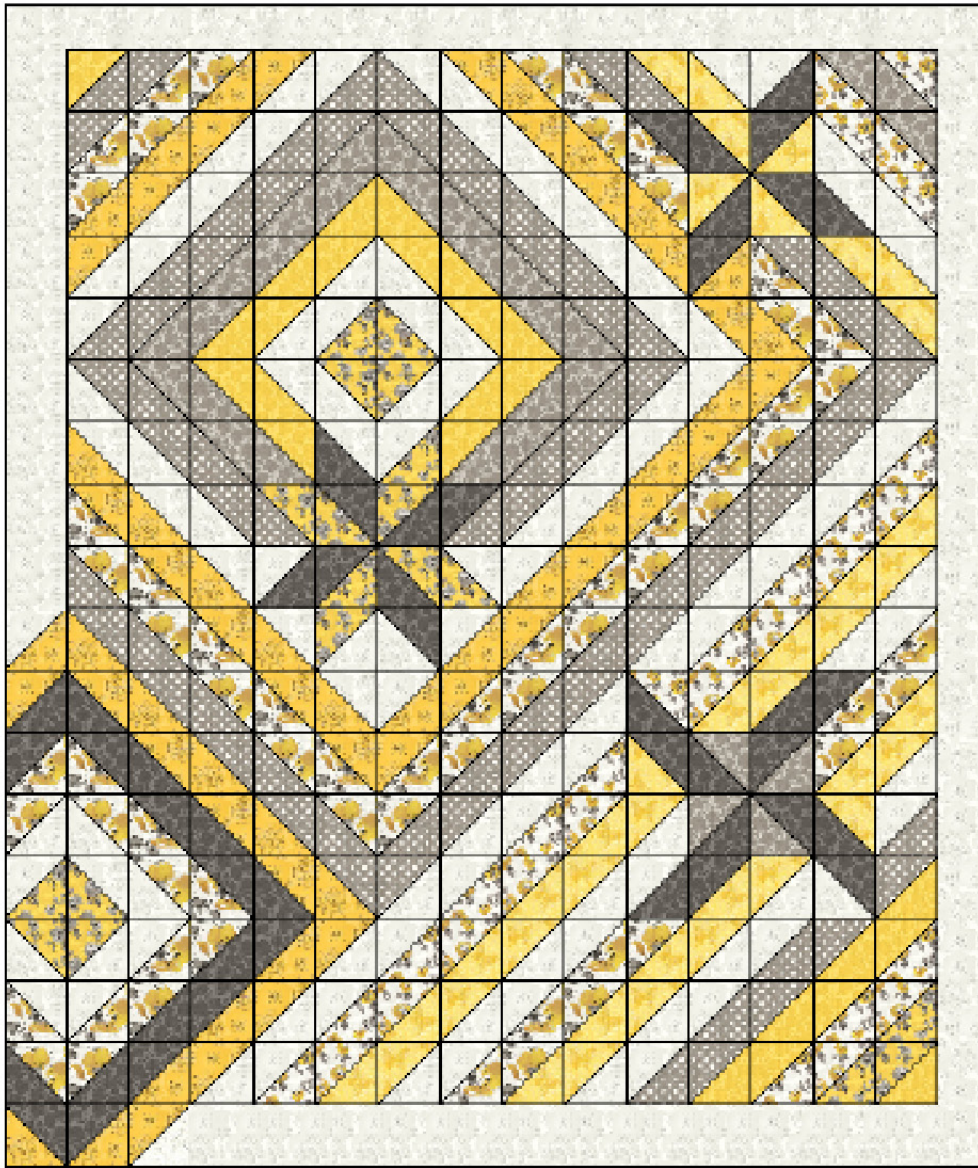
Arrange and sew 8 HST units and 1 (4 1/2" x 36 1/2") **C** strip together, and add to the left side of quilt center.

Arrange and sew 3 HST units and 1 (4 1/2" x 48 1/2") **C** strip together, and add to the bottom of quilt center.

Sew 1 (3 1/2" x 72 1/2") **C** strip to the right side of quilt center, followed by 1 (3 1/2" x 63 1/2") strip to the top of quilt center to complete quilt top.



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## Quilting Instructions:

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
